The Q3 supports high-quality video recording. Access video mode via the dedicated switch or menu option. For connectivity, use the Leica FOTOS app for wireless transfer and remote control, or connect directly via USB-C for data transfer.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning the Lens:** Use a soft brush or air blower to remove dust, followed by a microfiber cloth and lens cleaning solution if necessary. Avoid touching the lens surface with bare hands.
- **Cleaning the Sensor:** Sensor cleaning should be performed by authorized service personnel or with extreme caution using specialized tools.
- **Battery Care:** Store batteries in a cool, dry place. Avoid overcharging or fully discharging them frequently.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the camera in a dry, dust-free environment, preferably with a

desiccant to prevent moisture buildup.

- **Environmental Protection:** Protect the camera from extreme temperatures, humidity, dust, and direct impact.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not turn on.	Battery is depleted or incorrectly inserted.	Charge the battery fully. Reinsert the battery correctly.
Images are blurry.	Incorrect focus, camera shake, or low shutter speed.	Check focus mode and point. Use a faster shutter speed or tripod. Ensure lens is clean.
Memory card error.	Card is full, corrupted, or incompatible.	Replace with an empty card. Format the card (this will erase all data). Use a recommended card type.
Flash does not fire.	Flash is disabled, or in a mode where it won't fire.	Check flash settings in the menu. Ensure it's not in silent or specific scene modes.

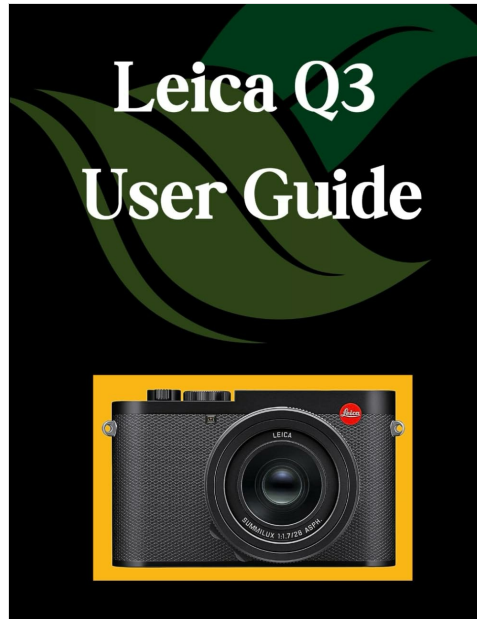


Image 1: Front cover of the 'Leica Q3 User Guide' book. This image displays the title and design of the instructional manual itself.

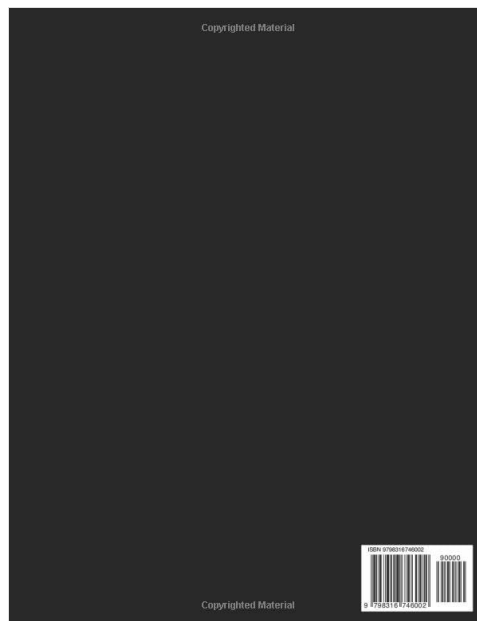


Image 2: Back cover of the 'Leica Q3 User Guide' book. This image shows the rear design, including the ISBN barcode and publisher information of the manual.
