INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Before beginning your first game, please follow these steps to prepare your Starter Deck:

1. **Unpack Contents:** Carefully open the product box and remove all components. Your Starter Deck [ST 16] Green Uta includes:
 - Constructed Deck x 1 (51 cards)
 - DON!! Cards x 10

- Playsheet x 1
 - PREMIUM BOOSTER PACK [PRB-01] x1
2. **Review Cards:** Familiarize yourself with the cards in your constructed deck. The deck is ready to play, but understanding your Leader card, character cards, event cards, and stage cards is crucial.
 3. **Prepare DON!! Cards:** The 10 DON!! cards are used as resources during gameplay. Keep them separate from your main deck.
 4. **Unfold Playsheet:** The playsheet provides a visual guide for card placement during a game. Unfold it and place it on a flat surface.
 5. **Open Booster Pack:** The PREMIUM BOOSTER PACK [PRB-01] contains additional cards that can be used to customize and strengthen your deck after you've learned the basic gameplay.

OPERATING (GAMEPLAY BASICS)

The One Piece Card Game is a strategic card game where two players battle using their constructed decks. This section outlines the fundamental steps of gameplay. For detailed rules, refer to the official One Piece Card Game rulebook.

Game Objective:

The primary objective is to reduce your opponent's Life points to zero by attacking their Leader card.

Turn Structure:

Each turn consists of several phases:

1. **Refresh Phase:** Stand all your rested cards (Leader, Characters, DON!! cards).
2. **Draw Phase:** Draw one card from your deck.
3. **DON!! Phase:** Add two DON!! cards from your DON!! deck to your hand.
4. **Main Phase:** This is where most actions occur. You can:
 - Play Character cards from your hand by paying their cost in DON!! cards.
 - Play Event cards from your hand by paying their cost.
 - Attach DON!! cards to your Leader or Character cards to increase their power.
 - Attack your opponent's Leader or rested Character cards.
5. **End Phase:** Your turn ends.

Key Concepts:

- **Leader Card:** Your main card, representing your character. It has Life points and a unique ability.
- **Character Cards:** Units you play to attack and defend.
- **DON!! Cards:** Resources used to play cards and boost power.
- **Life:** Represents your Leader's health. When attacked, you take a card from your Life area.
- **Counter:** Cards with a [Counter] ability can be used during an opponent's attack to increase your defending card's power.

Practice playing with the included playsheet to understand card zones and flow of play.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your One Piece Card Game cards will ensure their longevity and maintain their condition for future games.

- **Storage:** Store cards in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Use card sleeves and deck boxes to protect them from dust, spills, and bending.

- **Handling:** Always handle cards by their edges to avoid creasing, bending, or leaving fingerprints on the card surface.
- **Cleaning:** If cards become slightly dirty, gently wipe them with a clean, dry, soft cloth. Avoid using water or cleaning solutions, as these can damage the card material.
- **Playsheet Care:** Keep the playsheet flat when not in use to prevent creases. If it becomes dirty, wipe it with a damp cloth and allow it to air dry completely before folding.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Encountering issues during gameplay is common, especially for new players. Here are some common questions and their solutions:

- **Q: I'm confused about a card's ability.**
A: Refer to the official One Piece Card Game rulebook or the official website for detailed explanations of card effects and keywords. Online communities and forums can also provide clarification.
- **Q: What if I run out of cards in my deck?**
A: If you need to draw a card but your deck is empty, you lose the game. Manage your deck carefully.
- **Q: Can I use cards from other Starter Decks or Booster Packs with this deck?**
A: Yes, the One Piece Card Game is designed for deck customization. You can combine cards from different sets to create unique strategies, adhering to deck-building rules.
- **Q: My cards are bending/warping.**
A: This can happen due to humidity or improper storage. Store cards in sleeves and a deck box in a stable environment. If warping is minor, placing them under a heavy, flat object for a period might help.
