## User Manual: Bluetooth Tracker for Android

Model: HK-CW-007

### 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your new Bluetooth Tracker. Designed to seamlessly integrate with Google Find My Device, this smart locator helps you keep track of your valuable items such as keys, wallets, luggage, and even pets.

The tracker is compact, lightweight, and compatible with most Android phones, including Samsung, Google, Xiaomi, Oppo, and Vivo, without requiring additional app downloads.

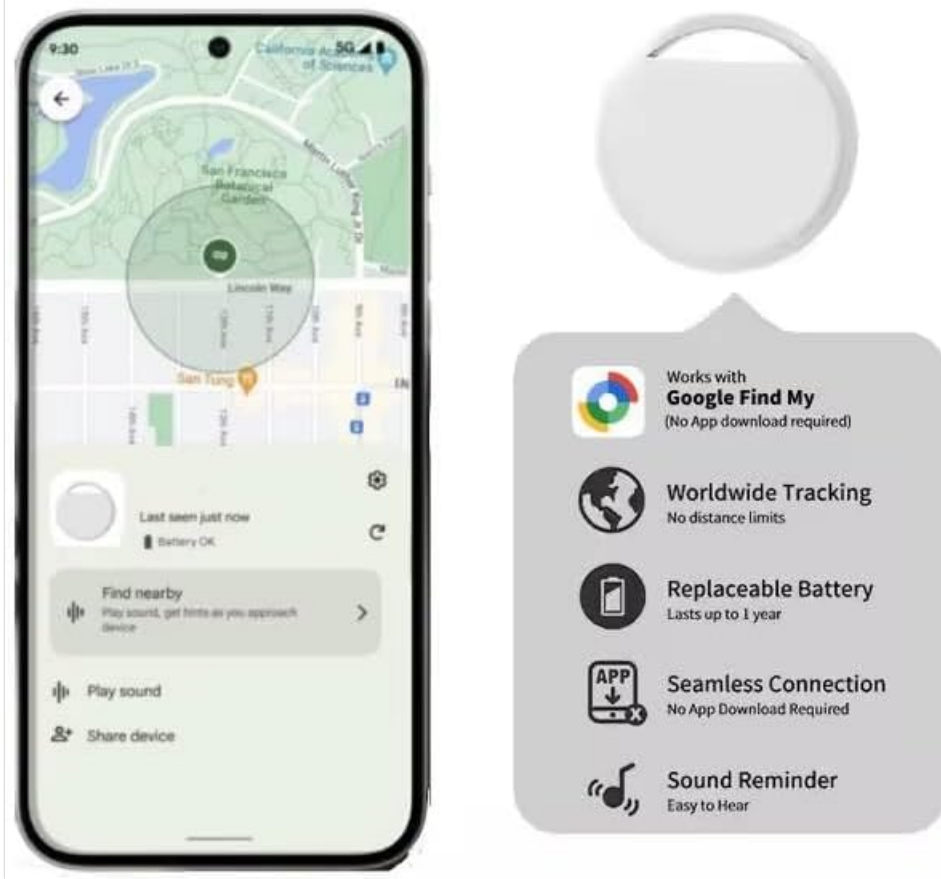

## 2. SETUP

### 2.1. Battery Installation

The tracker uses one CR2032 coin cell battery. The battery is typically pre-installed. If you need to replace it:

1. Locate the small groove or opening on the side of the tracker.
2. Gently pry open the tracker casing using a thin tool (e.g., a small flat-head screwdriver or guitar pick).
3. Remove the old CR2032 battery.
4. Insert a new CR2032 battery with the positive (+) side facing up.
5. Carefully snap the two halves of the tracker casing back together until it clicks securely.

### 2.2. Pairing with Google Find My Device

Your Bluetooth tracker is designed for seamless integration with the Google Find My Device network. No separate app download is required.

1. Ensure your Android phone's Bluetooth is turned on.
2. Make sure your phone is connected to the internet (Wi-Fi or mobile data).
3. Activate the tracker by pressing its button (if it has one) or ensuring it's powered on. The tracker should enter pairing mode, indicated by a specific sound or light (refer to product packaging for specific indicator).
4. Open the Google Find My Device app on your Android phone. If you don't have it, it's usually pre-installed or can be

accessed via your Google account settings.

5. The app should automatically detect nearby compatible trackers. Follow the on-screen prompts to add your new tracker to your account.
6. Once paired, you can name your tracker (e.g., "Keys," "Wallet," "Pet Collar") for easy identification.

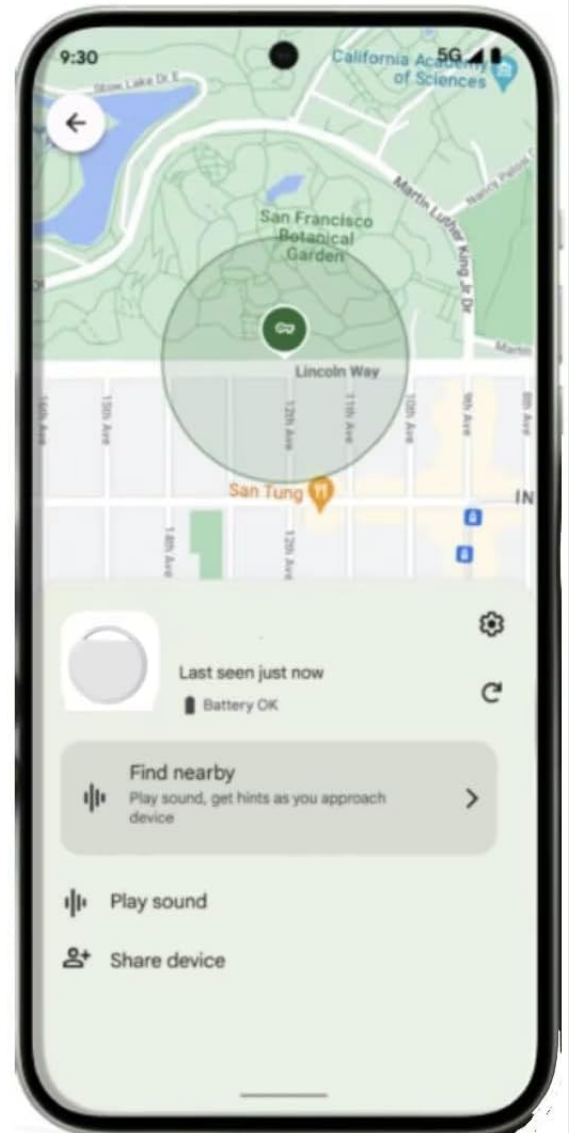


Image: The tracker in both black and white variants, alongside a smartphone screen demonstrating how the Google Find My Device app displays the tracker's location and offers options to locate it.

### 3. OPERATING THE TRACKER

#### 3.1. Locating Your Items

Once your tracker is paired, you can use your Android phone to find your items:

- **Map Location:** Open the Google Find My Device app. Your tracker's last known location will be displayed on a map. This is particularly useful for items left far away.
- **Play Sound:** If your item is nearby, select the "Play Sound" option in the app. The tracker will emit a loud ring, helping you pinpoint its exact location.
- **Find Nearby / Precision Finding:** Some Android devices and trackers support a "Find Nearby" or "Precision Finding" feature, which can guide you closer to the tracker using visual cues or signal strength indicators within the app.

the tracker will beep

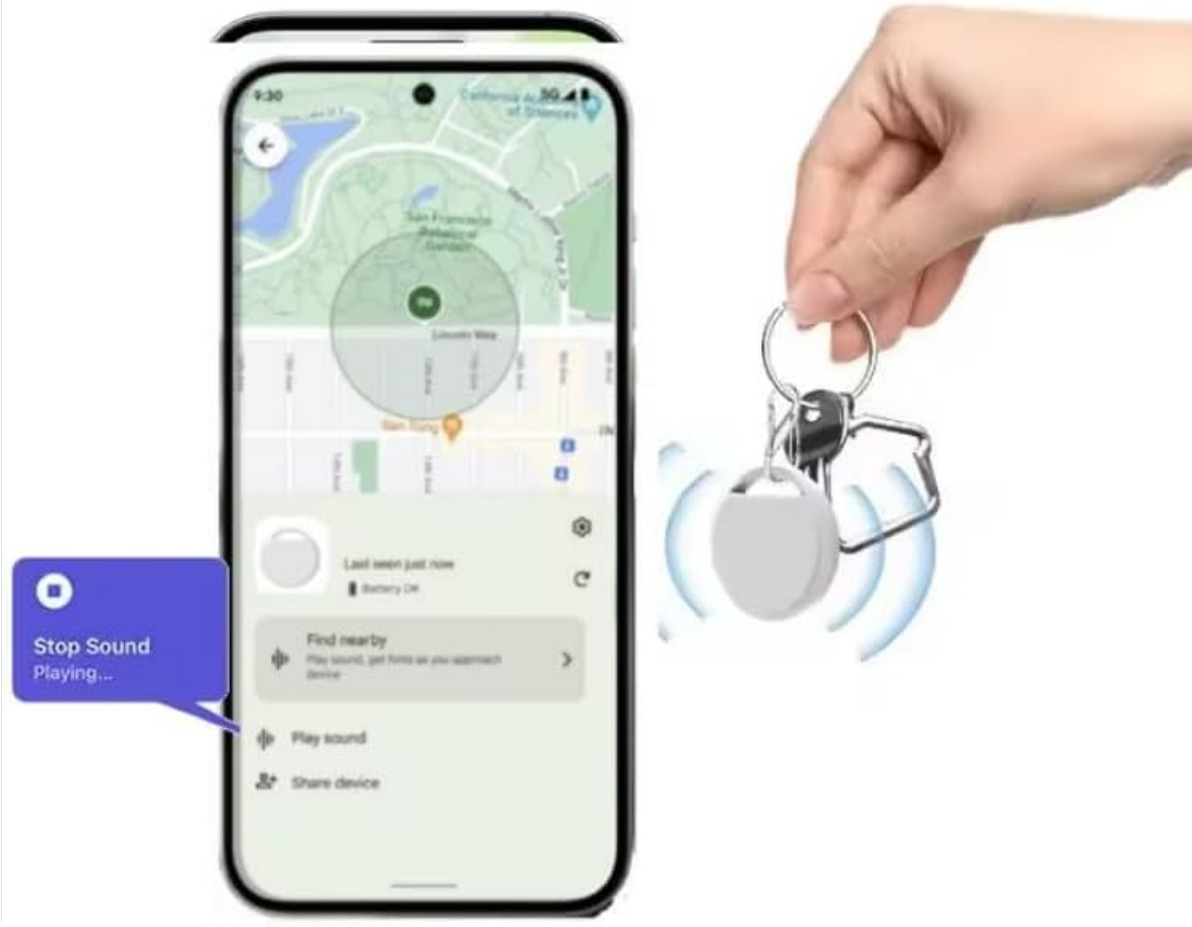
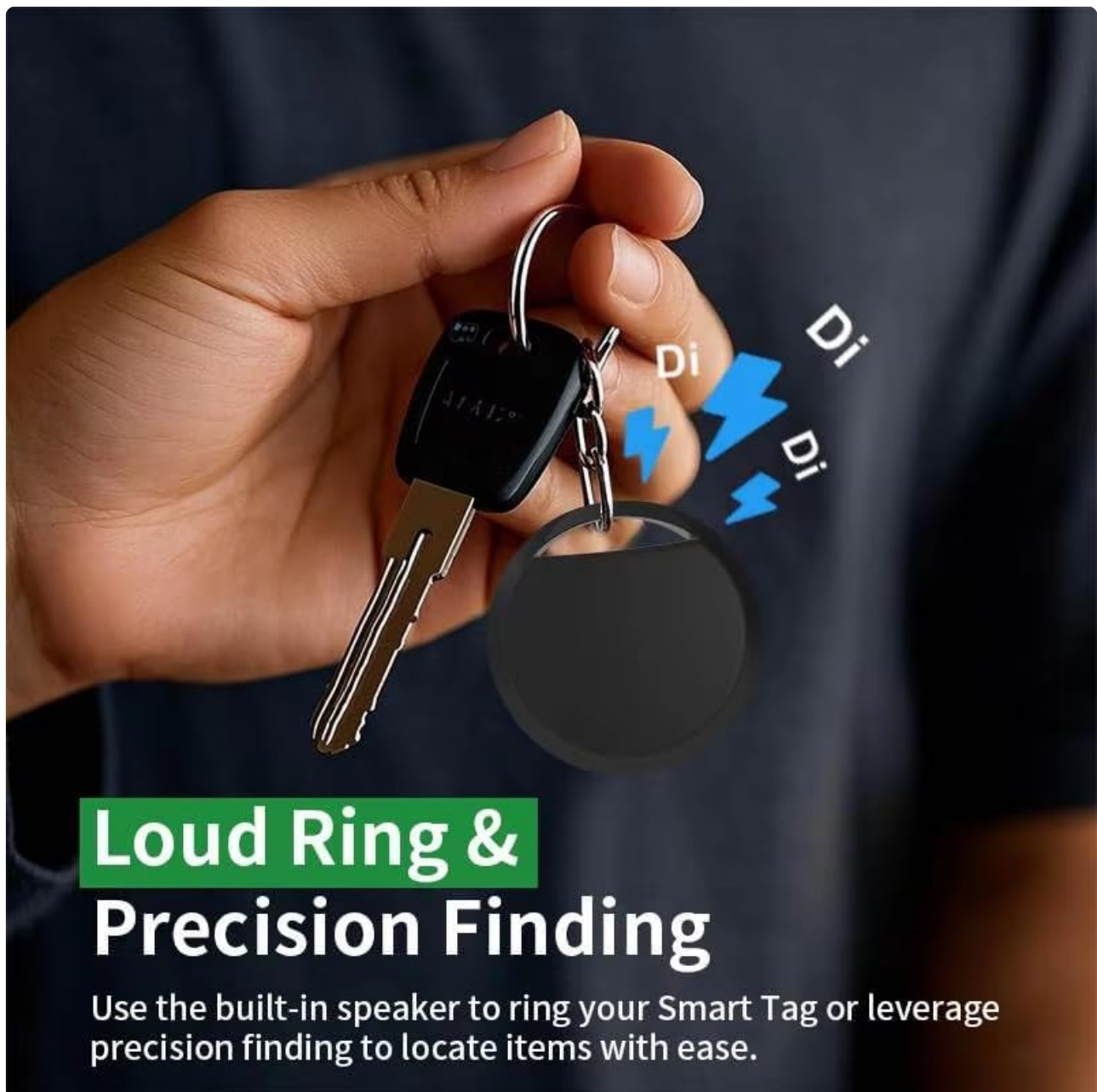


Image: Demonstrates the "Voice Prompt" feature, where clicking "play sound" on the phone app makes the tracker beep, aiding in finding nearby items.



## Loud Ring & Precision Finding

Use the built-in speaker to ring your Smart Tag or leverage precision finding to locate items with ease.

### 3.2. Left-Behind Remind

The tracker can notify you if you leave an item behind. When the tracker moves out of range of your phone, you may receive an alert on your device, indicating the item is no longer detected nearby and showing its last known location.



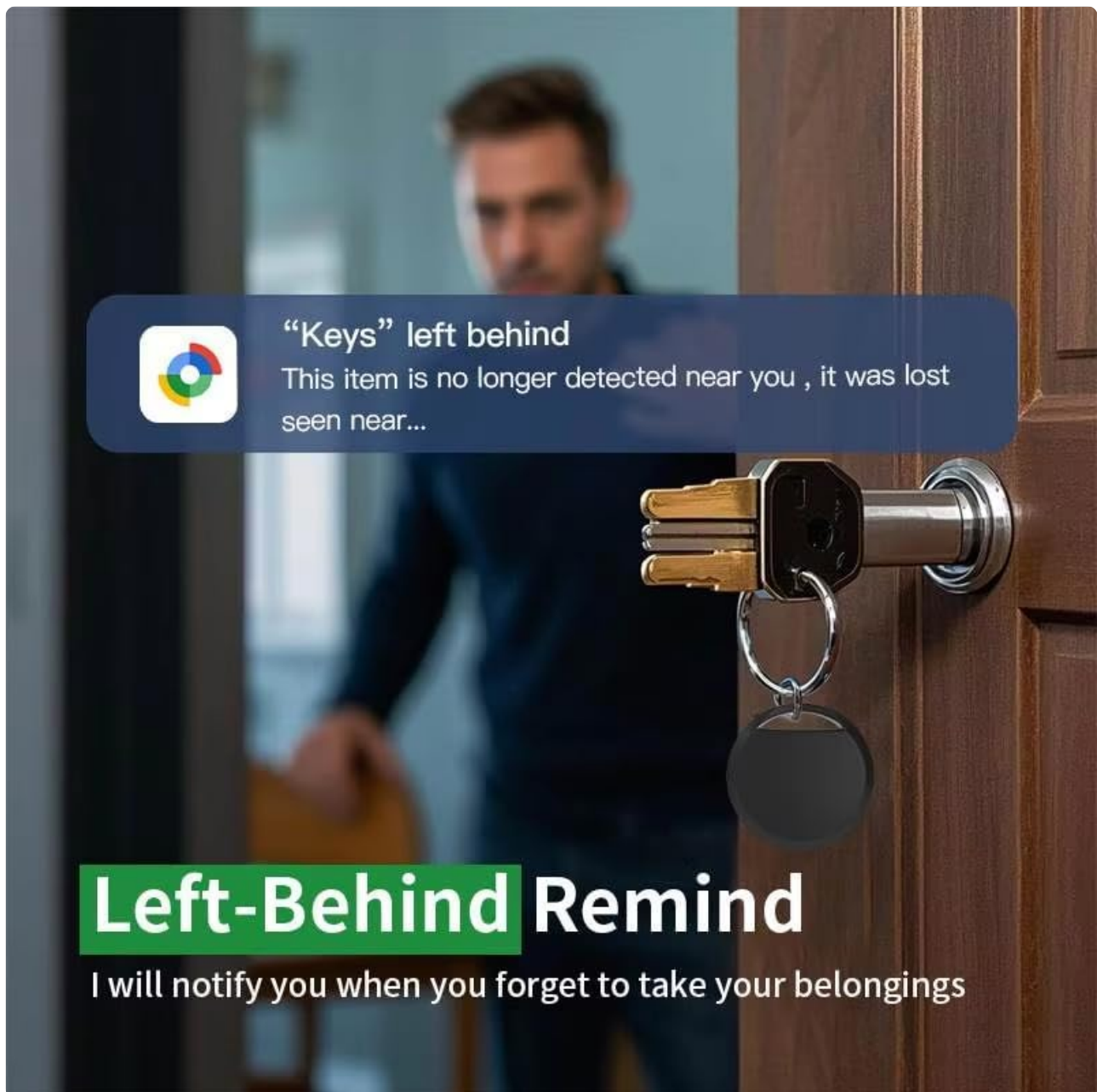


Image: Illustrates the "Left-Behind Remind" function, where the user is notified if they forget their belongings, showing a notification for "Keys" left behind.

### 3.3. Worldwide Tracking

Leveraging the Google Find My Device network, your tracker can be located globally. If your item is lost and comes within range of any Android device on the Find My Device network, its location will be updated, allowing you to track it from anywhere with no distance limits.

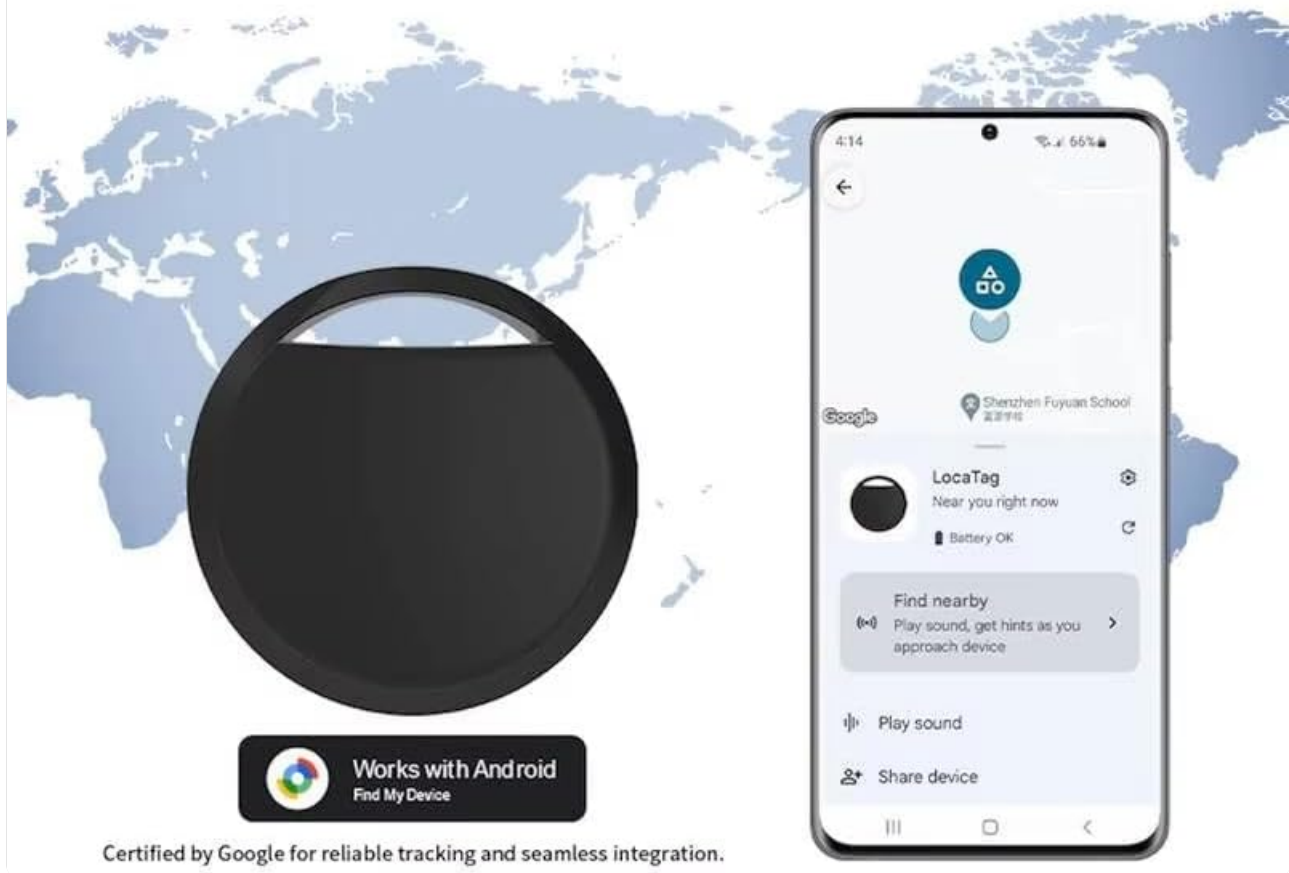


Image: Depicts the global precise positioning tracking feature, showing the tracker and a phone displaying its location on a world map, supported by the Google system.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

### 4.1. Battery Replacement

The CR2032 battery typically lasts up to one year. When the battery is low, you may receive a notification in the Google Find My Device app. Replace the battery as described in Section 2.1 to ensure continuous operation.

### 4.2. Cleaning

To clean your tracker, gently wipe it with a soft, dry, or slightly damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the device. Ensure the tracker is completely dry before re-attaching it to items.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Bluetooth tracker, try the following steps:

- **Tracker Not Found / Not Connecting:**
  - Ensure your phone's Bluetooth is enabled.
  - Check if the tracker's battery is dead or low. Replace it if necessary.



- Make sure the tracker is within Bluetooth range of your phone (typically up to 30 feet indoors).
- Restart your phone's Bluetooth or the phone itself.
- Try re-pairing the tracker through the Google Find My Device app.

- **Sound Not Playing:**

- Ensure the tracker is within range and connected.
- Check the volume settings on your phone.
- Verify the tracker's battery level.

- **Inaccurate Location:**

- Ensure your phone has a stable internet connection (Wi-Fi or mobile data) and GPS is enabled.
- Location accuracy depends on the density of the Google Find My Device network. In sparse areas, the last known location might be less precise.

- **Battery Drains Quickly:**

- Ensure you are using a fresh, high-quality CR2032 battery.
- Extreme temperatures can affect battery life.
