INTRODUCTION

SETUP

OPERATING (WEARING)

- **Intended Use:** These sneakers are suitable for everyday walking and light activities. They are not designed for rigorous athletic performance, heavy-duty work, or extreme weather conditions.
- **Rotation:** If possible, rotate your footwear. Wearing different pairs of shoes allows each pair to air out and recover, contributing to their longevity.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will help maintain the appearance and integrity of your leather sneakers. As the outer and sole materials are leather, specific care is required.

- **Cleaning:**
 - For light dirt, wipe the leather surface with a soft, damp cloth.
 - For more stubborn stains, use a specialized leather cleaner according to the product's instructions. Test on an inconspicuous area first.
 - Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or submerging the shoes in water, as this can damage the leather.
 - Clean the rubber soles with a brush and mild soap solution.
- **Drying:** If the sneakers get wet, allow them to air dry naturally at room temperature. Do not use direct heat sources like radiators or hairdryers, as this can cause the leather to crack or shrink. Stuff with newspaper to absorb moisture and help retain shape.
- **Conditioning:** Periodically apply a quality leather conditioner to keep the leather supple and prevent drying and cracking. Follow the conditioner manufacturer's instructions.
- **Storage:** Store your sneakers in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Use shoe trees to help maintain their shape and absorb moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Squeaking Noise:**

Squeaking can sometimes occur due to friction between parts of the shoe or between the shoe and the walking surface. Check if the insole is properly seated. A light application of talcum powder under the insole can sometimes resolve this. If the squeak persists, it may indicate a manufacturing issue.
- **Discomfort/Blister:**

Ensure the shoes are properly broken in. New leather shoes may require a short period of wear to conform to your foot. Verify that your socks are appropriate and that the lacing is not too tight or too loose. If discomfort persists, the shoe size or fit may not be ideal for your foot shape.
- **Stains on Leather:**

Address stains promptly. For oil-based stains, a small amount of cornstarch or talcum powder can absorb the oil before gentle cleaning. For water stains, a damp cloth can sometimes help even out the color. Always use leather-specific cleaning products for best results.
