PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Connect the provided Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power source.

- A 10-minute charge provides approximately 6 hours of playtime.

- A full charge offers up to 65 hours of playtime with ANC off.

2. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light illuminates.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light turns off.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5 seconds until the indicator light flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for "Oraimo BoomPop N".
4. Select "Oraimo BoomPop N" from the list of available devices to connect.
5. Once connected, the indicator light will flash blue slowly.

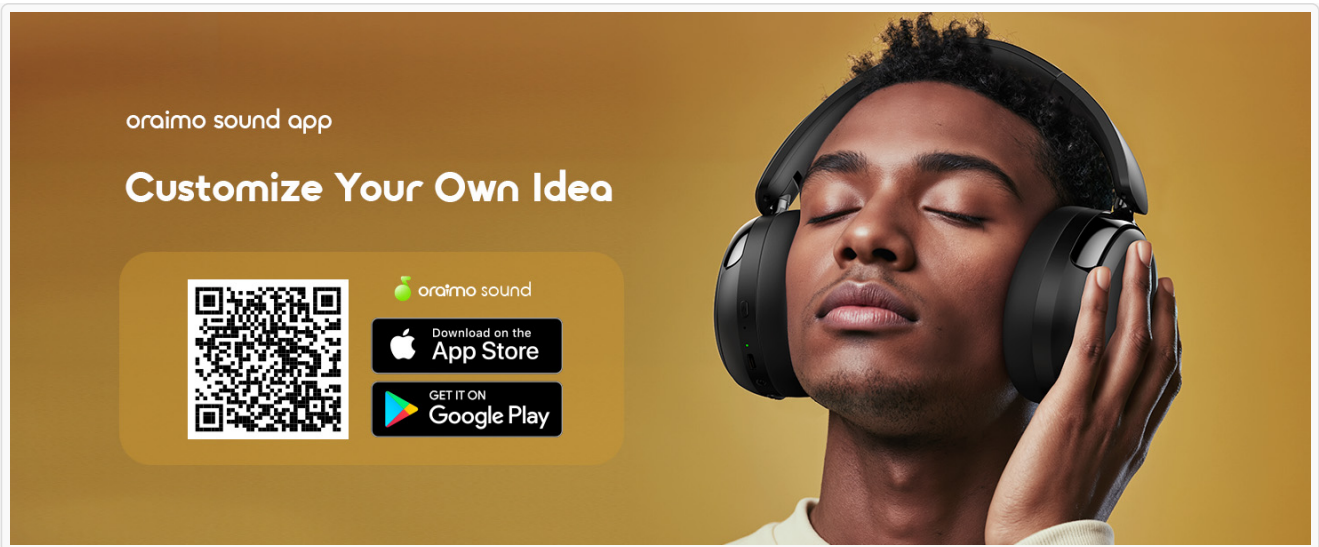

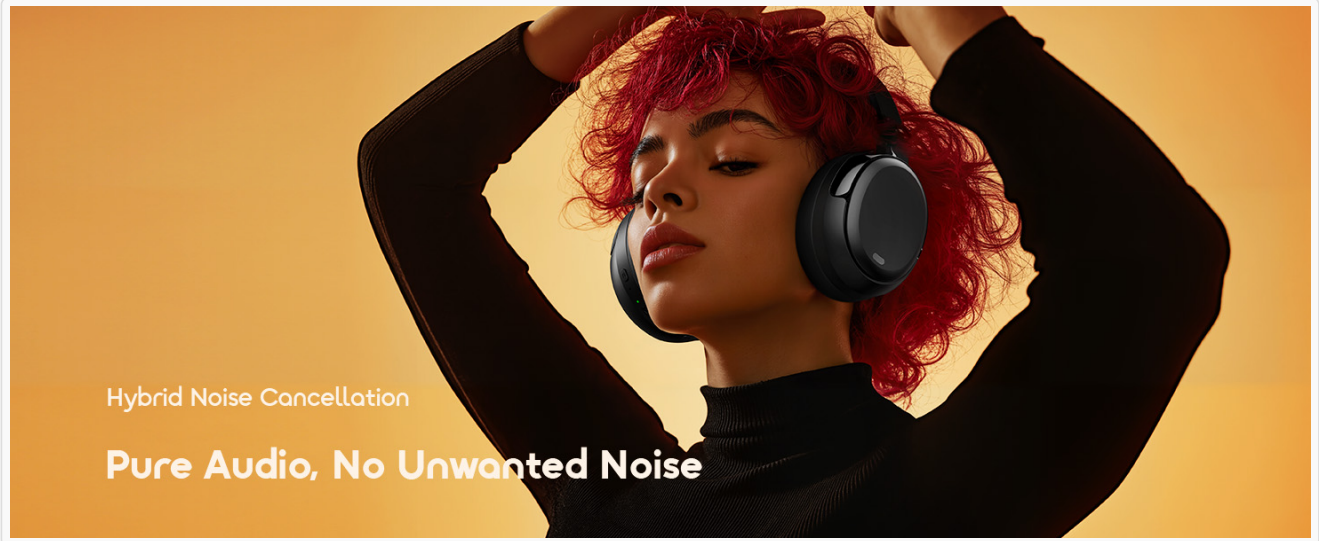

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Active Noise Cancellation (ANC)

The headphones feature Hybrid ANC technology to reduce ambient noise by up to 95%. This is ideal for environments with constant background sounds like airplanes or public transport.

2. EQ Modes and Sound Quality

The headphones offer 3 EQ modes and feature Havy Bass sound tuning for deep, rich bass. The AAC/SBC audio decoder enhances audio frequency for clearer sound.

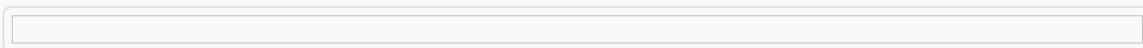

3. Call Functions

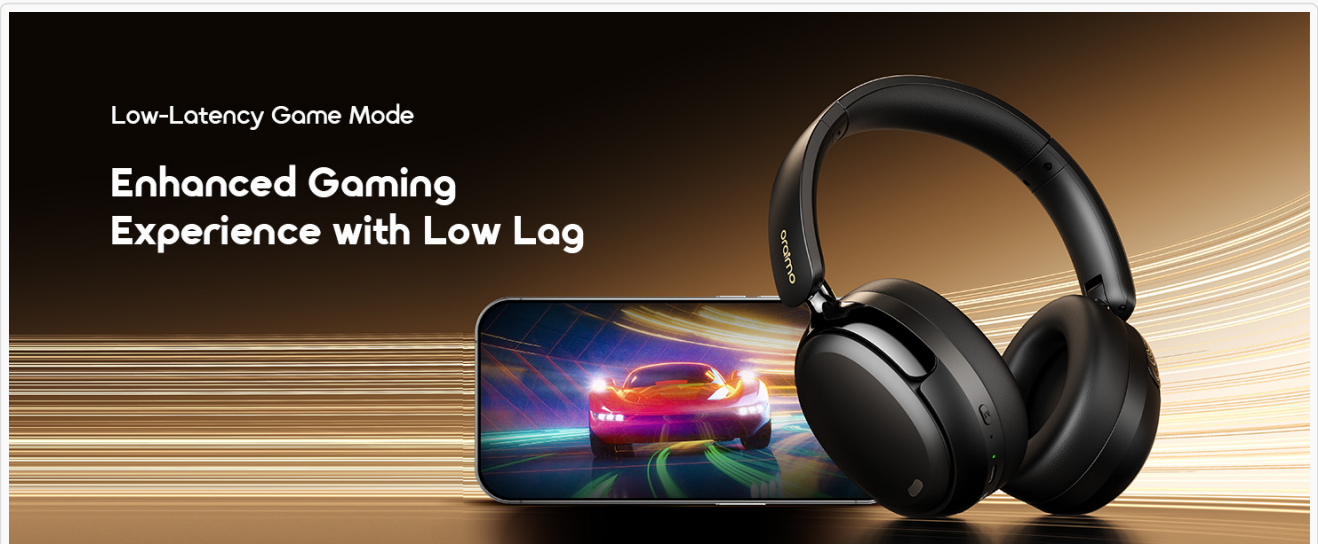

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; device too far.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Enable Bluetooth on your device. Move device closer to headphones.
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low; incorrect audio output selected; headphones not connected.	Increase volume on headphones and device. Check device's audio output settings. Reconnect headphones.
ANC not effective.	ANC not activated; specific noise frequencies.	Ensure ANC is turned on. ANC is most effective against low-frequency, constant noise.
