SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Connecting to a PC

To connect your JniTyOpt monitor to a PC, follow these steps:

1. Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port on your PC.
2. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI interface (Display) on the JniTyOpt monitor.
3. Connect the Micro USB cable from your PC's USB port to the Micro USB connector (Touch) on the monitor for

touch functionality and power.

4. Ensure the monitor receives 5V power via the Micro-USB port. This can be from your PC, a phone charger, or a power bank.

Connecting to Raspberry Pi and Other Devices

The monitor is compatible with various devices, including Raspberry Pi models. Use the appropriate cables for connection:

- For Raspberry Pi: Connect via HDMI for display and Micro USB for touch and power.
- For other devices: Utilize the HDMI input for display and Micro USB for power and touch (if supported by the device).

Interface Overview

Familiarize yourself with the monitor's interfaces and control buttons:

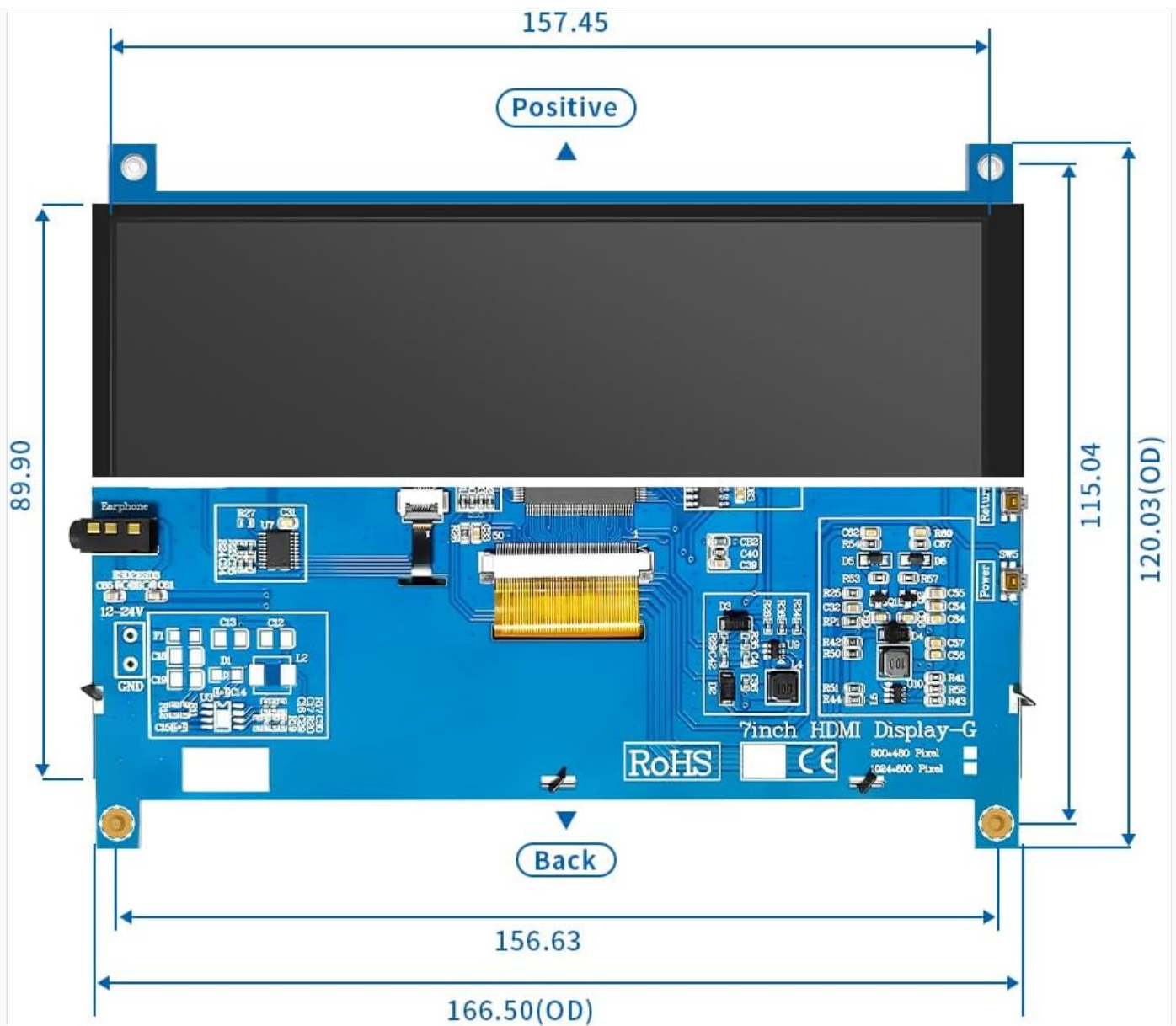


Figure 4: Monitor Interfaces. This image provides a labeled view of the monitor's rear panel, indicating the HDMI interface (Display), Micro USB connectors (Touch), Earphone jack, Menu button (OSD/Select), Left/Up (Backlight shortcut), Right/Down (Backlight shortcut), Return, and Power button.

- **1: Display:** HDMI interface for connecting to motherboards and LCD monitors.
- **2-3: Touch:** Micro USB connectors for touch functionality.
- **4: Earphone:** 3.5mm Audio output interface.
- **5: Menu:** Opens the OSD (On-Screen Display) / Select key (only valid in the OSD Settings menu).
- **6: Left/Up:** Direction Left/Up (Backlight shortcut key).
- **7: Right/Down:** Direction Right/Down (Backlight shortcut key).
- **8: Return:** Return (Only valid in the OSD Settings menu).
- **9: Power:** Turns on or off display and backlight to save power consumption.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On/Off

Press the Power button (9) on the monitor's rear panel to turn the display on or off. This also controls the backlight to conserve power.

Adjusting Display Settings

Use the physical buttons on the monitor to adjust settings:

- Press the **Menu** button (5) to access the On-Screen Display (OSD) menu.
- Use the **Left/Up** (6) and **Right/Down** (7) buttons to navigate through menu options.
- Press the **Menu** button (5) again to select an option or confirm a setting.
- Use the **Return** button (8) to go back to the previous menu or exit the OSD.
- For quick brightness adjustments, use the **Left/Up** (6) and **Right/Down** (7) buttons outside the OSD menu.

Touch Functionality

The 5-point capacitive touch feature is plug-and-play. Ensure the Micro USB cable is connected from your device to the monitor's Touch port (2 or 3) for this functionality to work. No additional drivers are typically required for Windows or Raspberry Pi.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your JniTyOpt monitor, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the monitor in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Use the original packaging or a protective sleeve to prevent scratches and damage.
- **Handling:** Handle the monitor with care. Avoid dropping it or subjecting it to strong impacts. Do not place heavy objects on top of the monitor.
- **Power:** Always use the recommended 5V Micro-USB power source. Disconnect power during electrical storms or when unused for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your JniTyOpt monitor, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No display/No signal	Incorrect cable connection, insufficient power, incorrect input source selected.	Ensure HDMI cable is securely connected to both the monitor and the device. Verify the monitor is receiving adequate 5V power via the Micro-USB port. Check your device's display settings to ensure it's outputting to the external monitor. Use the monitor's OSD menu to select the correct input source (e.g., HDMI).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Touch function not working	USB touch cable not connected, device not supporting USB touch, driver issue.	Ensure the Micro USB cable for touch is connected from your device to the monitor. Confirm your operating system (e.g., Windows, Raspberry Pi OS) supports USB touch input. For Windows, calibrate touch screen settings if necessary.
Screen is too dim/bright	Brightness settings are not optimized.	Use the Left/Up (6) and Right/Down (7) buttons on the monitor to adjust brightness. Access the OSD menu for more detailed brightness, contrast, and backlight settings.
Image quality issues (blurry, distorted)	Incorrect resolution, faulty cable, graphics driver issue.	Ensure your device's output resolution is set to 1024x600 for optimal display. Try a different HDMI cable to rule out cable defects. Update your device's graphics drivers.
