SKIUDCT N19 Bluetooth Headset User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use and maintenance of your SKIUDCT N19 Bluetooth Headset. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

The SKIUDCT N19 is a wireless single-ear Bluetooth headset designed for clear communication and audio playback, featuring Bluetooth 5.3 connectivity, dual ENC noise-canceling microphones, and an IP7 waterproof rating.

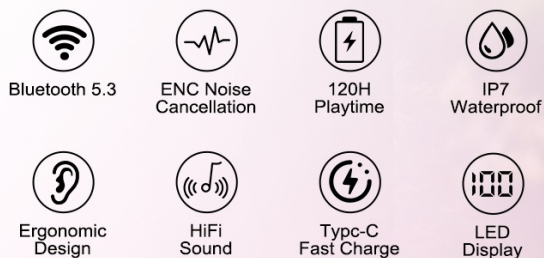

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3.1 Headset Components

Sensitive Buttons for Easy Operation

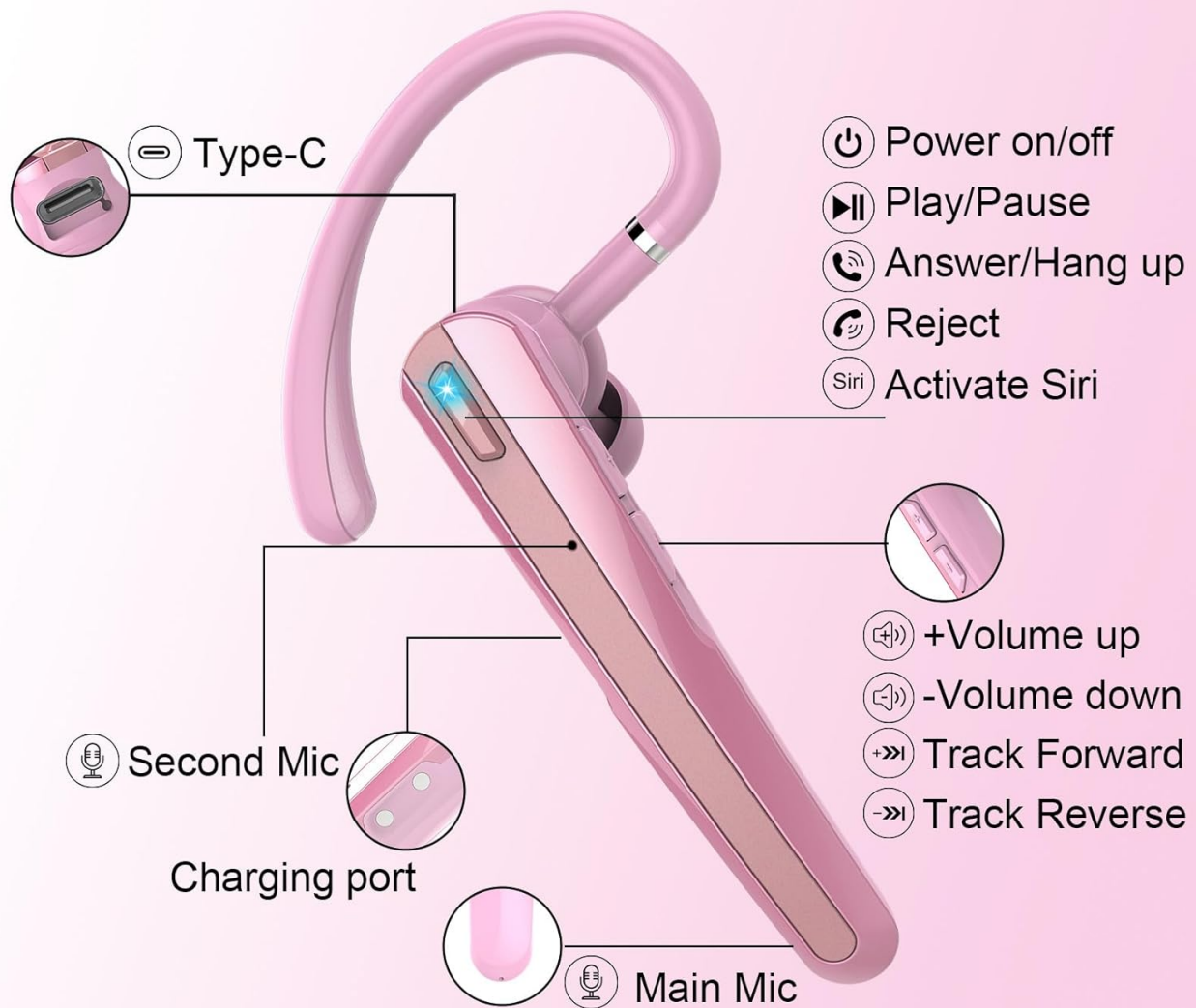

- **Power Button:** Controls power on/off, play/pause, answer/hang up calls, reject calls, and activate voice assistant.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjusts volume, skips tracks.
- **Main Microphone:** Primary microphone for vocal voice collection.
- **Second Microphone:** Assists in noise reduction.
- **Charging Port:** USB Type-C port for charging the headset.
- **LED Indicator:** Displays connection status and battery level.

3.2 Key Features

- **Ultra-Clear Call Technology:** Features a 13mm composite dynamic unit for balanced sound and a high-performance audio decoding chip compatible with AAC and SBC formats.
- **Dual ENC and CVC 8.0 Noise Cancellation:** Effectively reduces ambient noise for clearer calls.
- **Bluetooth 5.3:** Provides a faster, more stable connection with lower power consumption.
- **LED Display Charging Case:** Shows real-time battery status of the charging box.

- **Long Battery Life:** Up to 120 hours of standby time with the charging case.
- **Ergonomic Design:** 180° rotating ear hooks and 270° adjustable cantilever for comfortable fit, suitable for left or right ear. Includes three sizes of earplugs.
- **IP7 Waterproof Rating:** Resists sweat, rain, and other liquids.

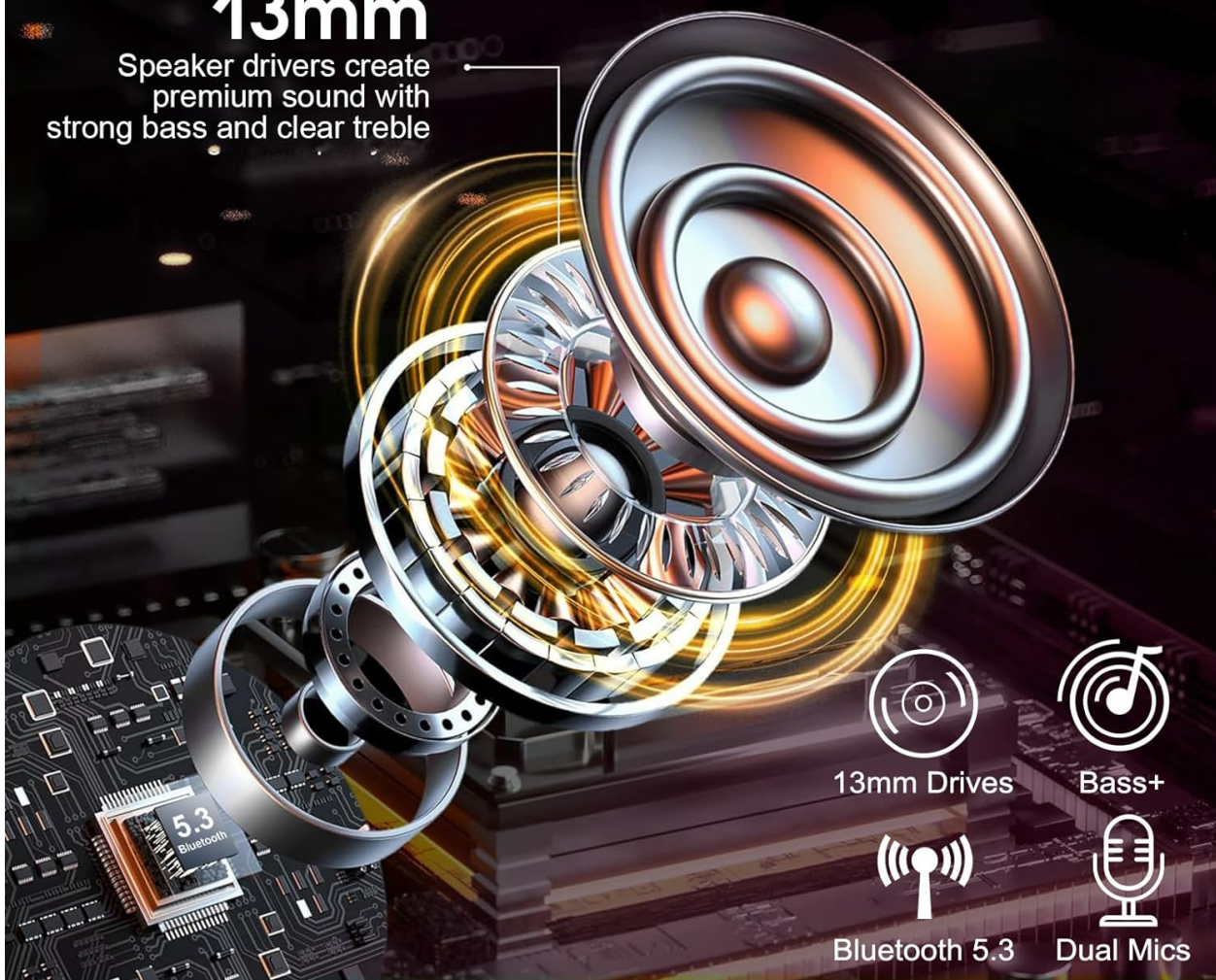

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Headset and Case

Before first use, fully charge the headset and charging case.

1. Place the headset into the charging case.
2. Connect the USB-C charging cable to the charging port on the case and a power source.
3. The LED display on the charging case will show the current battery percentage. The headset will fully charge in approximately 1.5 hours.

4.2 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headset is charged.
2. Take the headset out of the charging case. It will automatically power on and enter pairing mode (the LED indicator will flash).

3. On your device (smartphone, laptop, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "N19" from the list of devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator on the headset will stop flashing, and a voice prompt will confirm the connection.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Multi-function Button Controls

- **Power On:** Press the Power button for 2 seconds.
- **Power Off:** Press the Power button for 5 seconds.
- **Play/Pause:** Tap the Power button twice.
- **Answer Call:** Tap the Power button once.
- **Reject Call/Hang Up:** Press the Power button for 2 seconds.
- **Volume Up:** Tap the '+' button once.
- **Volume Down:** Tap the '-' button once.
- **Next Track:** Press the '+' button for 2 seconds.
- **Previous Track:** Press the '-' button for 2 seconds.
- **Activate Voice Assistant (Siri/Google Assistant):** Tap the Power button three times.

6. WEARING INSTRUCTIONS

For optimal comfort and sound quality, adjust the headset to fit your ear properly.

1. Insert the ear tip into your ear canal.
2. Position the ear hook over the back of your ear.
3. Adjust the ear hook (180° rotation) and cantilever (270° adjustment) for a secure and comfortable fit. The headset can be worn on either the left or right ear.
4. Experiment with the three different sizes of ear tips (S/M/L) to find the best fit for your ear canals.

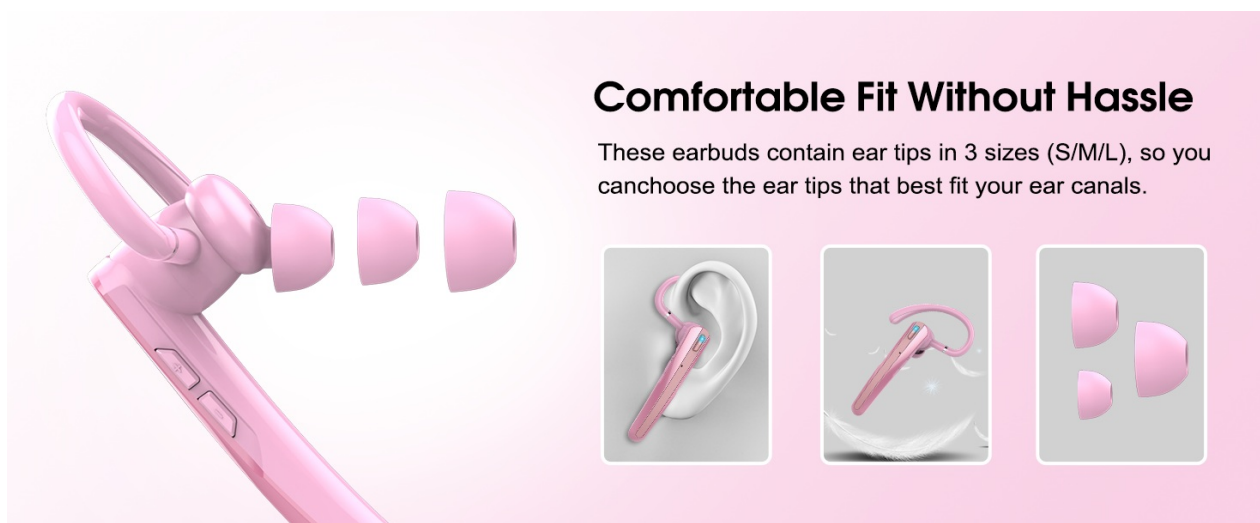

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning

- Regularly clean the ear tips and headset with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

- Ensure the charging contacts are clean and dry before placing the headset in the charging case.

7.2 Waterproof Rating

The SKIUDCT N19 headset has an IP7 waterproof rating, meaning it can withstand immersion in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes. It is resistant to sweat and rain, but it is not recommended for swimming or prolonged submersion.

7.3 Storage

When not in use, store the headset in its charging case to protect it from dust and damage, and to keep it charged.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headset does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headset and charging case.
Cannot pair with device.	Bluetooth is off on device; headset not in pairing mode; too far from device.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Take headset out of case to enter pairing mode. Move headset closer to device (within 10 meters).
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low; headset not connected; incorrect audio output selected.	Adjust volume on headset and device. Re-pair the headset. Check audio output settings on your device.
Call quality is poor.	Weak signal; environmental noise; microphone obstruction.	Move to an area with better signal. Ensure microphone is not covered.
Charging case LED display is off.	Charging case battery is depleted.	Connect the charging case to a power source using the USB-C cable.
