# Depuley 66" Ceiling Fan with Lights User Manual

Model: WS-FPZ197-66C

## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, install, or operate this product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious personal injury.

- Ensure all electrical connections comply with local codes, ordinances, and the National Electrical Code (NEC).
- Consult a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with electrical wiring.
- Turn off power at the circuit breaker before beginning installation to prevent possible electrical shock.
- The mounting structure must be capable of supporting the fan's weight (approximately 22.7 lbs).
- Do not bend the blade holders during installation or cleaning.
- Keep hands clear of the fan blades when the fan is operating.
- This fan is suitable for both indoor and outdoor (covered patio) use. Ensure proper protection from direct water exposure for outdoor installations.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact Depuley customer service.

### 3. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

---

#### 3.1 Planning and Preparation

- Choose a suitable location for the fan, ensuring at least 7 feet (2.13 meters) clearance from the floor to the blade and 18 inches (0.46 meters) from the blade to any wall or obstruction.
- Ensure the electrical box is securely mounted and capable of supporting the fan's weight.


#### 3.2 Mounting the Fan

1. Turn off power at the circuit breaker.
2. Attach the mounting bracket to the electrical box.
3. Assemble the downrod and canopy.
4. Carefully lift the fan assembly and hang it from the mounting bracket.
5. Make electrical connections according to the wiring diagram provided in the full installation guide (not included)

in this summary).

### 3.3 Attaching the Blades

The fan blades feature two color options: a classic black finish and a warm wood grain tone. Select the desired side before attachment.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Remote Control Operation

The included remote control allows for convenient operation of the fan and light functions.

- **Fan Speed:** Adjust between 6 speeds (1-6) for optimal airflow.
- **Reversible Function:** Press the 'F/R' button to change the direction of blade rotation.
- **Timer:** Set a 2-hour timer for automatic fan shutdown.
- **Light Control:** Turn the light on/off, adjust brightness, and change color temperature (3000K warm white, 4000K natural white, 6500K cool white).

## 4.2 App Control

This fan also supports control via a dedicated mobile application. Refer to the full instruction manual for detailed pairing and app usage instructions.

## 4.3 Reversible Airflow

The fan features a reversible DC motor for year-round comfort.

- **Summer Mode (Downdraft):** Blades rotate counter-clockwise, pushing air downwards to create a cooling breeze.
- **Winter Mode (Updraft):** Blades rotate clockwise, drawing air upwards to circulate warm air trapped near the ceiling.

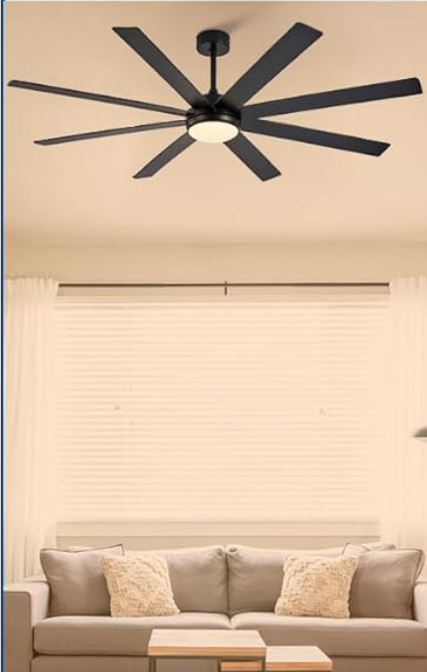
#### **4.4 Dimmable Lighting with Memory Function**

The integrated LED light offers adjustable brightness and three color temperatures (3000K, 4000K, 6500K). The fan automatically saves your preferred fan speed and light settings after power-off.

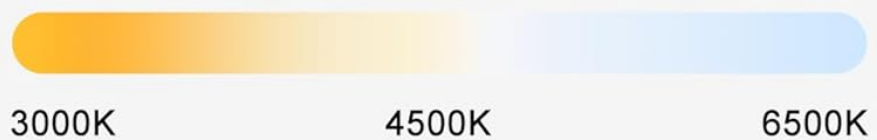
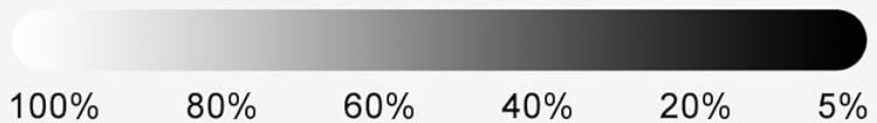

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your ceiling fan.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the fan blades and motor housing. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Blade Inspection:** Periodically check that all blade screws are tight. Loose screws can cause wobbling and noise.
- **Light Cover:** Clean the light cover with a soft cloth to maintain light output.
- **Electrical Connections:** Annually inspect all electrical connections for tightness.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before attempting any repairs, ensure the power is turned off at the circuit breaker.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not start	No power to the fan; Loose wire connections; Remote control battery low or not paired.	Check circuit breaker; Verify all wire connections; Replace remote battery or re-pair remote.
Fan wobbles	Loose blade screws; Unbalanced blades; Loose mounting bracket.	Tighten all blade screws; Use balancing kit (if included) to balance blades; Ensure mounting bracket is secure.
Light does not work	Loose wire connection in light kit; LED driver failure.	Check light kit wiring; Contact customer service if LED driver is suspected.
Remote control not working	Battery low or dead; Remote not paired with fan; Obstruction between remote and receiver.	Replace battery; Re-pair remote (refer to full manual); Ensure clear line of sight.
