# Lindby Lelia Table Lamp Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for purchasing the Lindby Lelia Table Lamp. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new lamp. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and operation, and retain them for future reference.

## Safety Information

- Ensure the power supply is disconnected before installation, cleaning, or bulb replacement.
- This product is designed for indoor use only.
- Do not exceed the maximum wattage specified for the light bulb.
- Keep the lamp away from water and moisture.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Please check that all components are present and undamaged:

- 1 x Lindby Lelia Table Lamp (Glass Shade, Metal Base, Stem, and Cord with Switch)
- *Note: Light bulb is not included.*

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Place them on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Assemble Base and Stem:** The lamp typically comes with the metal base and stem pre-assembled. Ensure the stem is securely attached to the base.
3. **Install Light Bulb:** Insert an E27 light bulb (max 15W LED recommended) into the lamp holder. Turn clockwise until secure. Do not overtighten.
4. **Position Glass Shade:** Carefully place the glass shade over the lamp holder and onto the base.

Ensure it sits evenly and securely.

5. **Connect to Power:** Plug the power cord into a standard 230V electrical outlet.




Image: Close-up view of the lamp's brass-colored base and stem, showing the E27 bulb holder and the power cord connection point.



## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Lindby Lelia Table Lamp is equipped with an inline switch on the power cord for easy operation.

1. **To Turn On:** Locate the inline switch on the power cord. Press the 'I' side of the rocker switch.
2. **To Turn Off:** Press the 'O' side of the rocker switch.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Cleaning

- Always disconnect the lamp from the power supply before cleaning.
- Wipe the glass shade and metal base with a soft, dry, or slightly damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- Ensure the lamp is completely dry before reconnecting to power.

### Bulb Replacement

- Disconnect the lamp from the power supply and allow the bulb to cool completely.
- Carefully remove the glass shade.
- Unscrew the old E27 bulb counter-clockwise.
- Screw in a new E27 bulb (max 15W LED recommended) clockwise until secure.
- Replace the glass shade, ensuring it is seated correctly.
- Reconnect the lamp to the power supply.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lamp does not turn on.	No power to the outlet.	Check if the outlet is working by plugging in another device. Check circuit breaker.
	Bulb is loose or faulty.	Ensure the bulb is screwed in tightly. Replace the bulb with a new one.
	Switch is in the 'Off' position.	Press the 'I' side of the inline rocker switch.
Lamp flickers.	Loose bulb connection.	Tighten the bulb. If flickering persists, replace the bulb.
	Incompatible bulb.	Ensure the bulb is an E27 type and compatible with 230V.
