1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Heinner HDW-FSM45710AWD+++ Freestanding Dishwasher. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before using the dishwasher and keep them for future reference.

This dishwasher is designed for household use, offering a 10 place setting capacity, 7 wash programs, and features like Auto-Door Opening and an intuitive LED display. With an Energy Class D rating, it combines efficiency with powerful cleaning.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

General Safety:

- · Read all instructions before use.
- · Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not operate the dishwasher if it is damaged.
- Keep children away from the dishwasher, especially when it is operating or the door is open. This model includes a child lock for added safety.
- Only use detergents and rinse aids specifically designed for automatic dishwashers.
- Sharp items should be loaded with points down to prevent injury.

Water and Electrical Safety:

- The dishwasher is equipped with an AquaStop system to prevent water leaks and overflow. In case of a leak, the water supply will be automatically shut off.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Disconnect the power supply before cleaning or performing maintenance.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Heinner HDW-FSM45710AWD+++ is a freestanding dishwasher designed for convenience and efficiency.

Key Features:

- 10 Place Setting Capacity: Accommodates a full meal service for 4-6 people, ideal for daily use or small gatherings.
- 7 Wash Programs: Includes Eco, Intensive, Quick, Auto, Delicate, Pre-wash, and a special Glass program for versatile cleaning.
- **Auto-Door Opening:** The door automatically opens a few centimeters at the end of the cycle to allow steam to escape, promoting faster and more natural drying with reduced energy consumption.
- **LED Display with Electronic Control:** An illuminated panel shows program status, remaining time, and allows for easy selection and adjustment.
- AquaStop & Safety: Equipped with overflow and leakage protection to prevent water damage, plus a child lock.
- Quiet Operation: Operates at approximately 49 dB(A), comparable to a quiet conversation.
- Slim 45 cm Wide Design: Compact enough for smaller kitchens and apartments, yet spacious for a full load.

4. SETUP

4.1 Unpacking:

- · Carefully remove all packaging materials.
- Inspect the dishwasher for any transport damage. Report any damage immediately to your retailer.

4.2 Positioning:

- Place the dishwasher on a firm, level floor. Adjust the leveling feet to ensure stability and proper door alignment.
- Position the appliance near a water supply, drain, and electrical outlet.

4.3 Water Connection:

- Connect the water inlet hose to a cold water tap with a 3/4-inch thread. Ensure the connection is tight to prevent leaks.
- Insert the drain hose into a drain pipe or sink, ensuring it is securely fastened and positioned to prevent

4.4 Electrical Connection:

- Connect the power cord to a properly grounded electrical outlet.
- Ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the rating plate of the dishwasher.

4.5 First Use Preparations:

- Adding Dishwasher Salt: Fill the salt dispenser with dishwasher salt to soften hard water, preventing limescale buildup. Refer to the water hardness test strip (if included) to determine the correct setting.
- Adding Rinse Aid: Fill the rinse aid dispenser. Rinse aid helps with drying and prevents water spots.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel:

The control panel (Figure 2) features an LED display and various buttons for program selection and settings. Familiarize yourself with the icons and their functions.

5.2 Selecting a Wash Program:

Your dishwasher offers 7 wash programs to suit different types of loads and soil levels:

- Eco: Energy-efficient program for normally soiled dishes.
- Intensive: For heavily soiled dishes, pots, and pans.
- Quick: A shorter program for lightly soiled dishes without drying.
- Auto: Automatically adjusts wash cycle based on soil level detected by sensors.
- Delicate: Gentle wash for fragile items like glassware.
- **Pre-wash:** A short rinse cycle to prevent food from drying onto dishes if you're not running a full wash immediately.
- Glass: Specifically designed for delicate glassware, ensuring sparkling results.

Use the program selection buttons on the control panel to choose your desired program. The LED display will show the selected program and estimated remaining time.

5.3 Starting a Cycle:

- Load the dishwasher (see Section 6).
- · Add detergent to the dispenser.
- Select the desired program.
- Close the dishwasher door firmly.
- Press the Start button to begin the cycle.

5.4 Auto-Door Opening Feature:

At the end of most wash cycles, the dishwasher door will automatically open slightly. This feature facilitates natural air drying, reducing energy consumption and improving drying performance. Do not force the door closed immediately after it opens, as this may interrupt the drying process.

6. LOADING THE DISHWASHER

Proper loading is crucial for optimal cleaning and drying results. The Heinner HDW-FSM45710AWD+++ has a capacity for 10 place settings.

General Loading Tips:

- Scrape off large food particles before loading.
- Place larger, more heavily soiled items in the lower rack.
- Place delicate items, glasses, and cups in the upper rack.
- Ensure items do not block the spray arms (Figure 4).
- Load cutlery into the cutlery basket with handles down for forks and spoons, and handles up for knives to ensure safety and better cleaning.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your dishwasher.

7.1 Cleaning Filters:

- The filter system prevents larger food particles from reaching the pump. Check and clean the filters regularly (e.g., weekly).
- Twist and remove the coarse filter, then separate the fine filter. Rinse them under running water to remove any debris.
- · Reassemble and replace the filters securely.

7.2 Cleaning Spray Arms:

- · Periodically check the spray arm nozzles for blockages.
- If necessary, remove the spray arms and clear any clogged holes with a thin object like a toothpick.

7.3 Exterior and Interior Cleaning:

- Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Clean the interior with a dishwasher cleaner or a mixture of vinegar and baking soda to remove odors and mineral deposits.

7.4 Winterization (if applicable):

• If the dishwasher is to be left in an unheated area during winter, drain all water from the appliance to prevent freezing and damage.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please refer to the following common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishwasher does not start	Power cord not plugged in; door not closed properly; fuse blown.	Check power connection; ensure door is latched; check household fuse/circuit breaker.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor cleaning results	Improper loading; clogged spray arms; insufficient detergent; incorrect program.	Reload dishes correctly; clean spray arm nozzles; add more detergent; select appropriate program.
Water not draining	Clogged filter; kinked drain hose; blocked drain pump.	Clean filters; straighten drain hose; check for obstructions in the drain pump area.
Dishwasher leaks	Loose hose connections; damaged door seal; too much detergent.	Check and tighten hose connections; inspect and clean door seal; use correct amount of detergent.
Dishes not drying	No rinse aid; rinse aid dispenser empty; Auto-Door Opening feature interrupted.	Refill rinse aid dispenser; ensure Auto-Door Opening is not obstructed.
