INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Ausom L2 Max Electric Scooter. This manual provides essential information for the safe operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your scooter. Please read it thoroughly before your first ride to ensure optimal performance and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Always wear a helmet and appropriate protective gear (knee pads, elbow pads, gloves) when riding. Familiarize yourself with local laws and regulations regarding electric scooter use.

- Always check the scooter before each ride, including brakes, tires, and battery level.
- Do not ride in heavy rain, snow, or icy conditions.
- Avoid riding on slippery surfaces, loose gravel, or excessively bumpy terrain.
- Maintain a safe distance from other vehicles and pedestrians.
- Do not perform stunts or ride recklessly.

- Ensure all lights are functional, especially when riding at night.

SETUP

Unfolding the Scooter

1. Place the scooter on a flat surface.
2. Release the folding mechanism latch, typically located near the base of the handlebar stem.
3. Carefully lift the handlebar stem until it locks into the upright position. Ensure the locking mechanism is fully engaged.
4. Adjust the handlebar height if applicable and secure it.

Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the scooter's battery. The Ausom L2 Max features dual charging ports for faster charging.

- Locate the charging ports on the scooter's deck.
- Connect the charger(s) to the ports and then to a power outlet.
- The charging indicator on the charger will typically turn green when fully charged. A full charge takes approximately 7 hours with dual chargers.
- Disconnect the charger(s) once charging is complete.

OPERATING THE SCOOTER

Powering On/Off and Speed Modes

Press and hold the power button on the LCD display to turn the scooter on or off. The L2 Max offers 6 speed modes, allowing you to adjust your ride from a maximum of 31 Mph.

Acceleration and Braking

Use the thumb throttle to accelerate. The scooter is equipped with an Anti-Lock Braking System (E-ABS) and dual hydraulic disc brakes for responsive and safe stopping.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Care

- Charge the battery regularly, even if not in use, to maintain its health.
- Avoid completely draining the battery before recharging.
- Store the scooter in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Tire Maintenance

The L2 Max is equipped with 10-inch off-road tubeless tires.

- Regularly inspect tires for wear, punctures, or damage.
- Maintain recommended tire pressure for optimal performance and range.

Brake Inspection

- Check brake levers for proper tension and responsiveness.
- Inspect brake pads for wear and replace if necessary.

General Cleaning and Storage

- Clean the scooter with a damp cloth. Avoid using high-pressure water or harsh chemicals.
- Store the scooter in a dry, secure location when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scooter does not power on	Low battery; Loose connections; Faulty power button	Charge battery; Check all cable connections; Contact support if issue persists.
Acceleration disengages randomly	Overheating (motor/controller); Low battery voltage; Loose motor connection	Allow scooter to cool down; Ensure battery is fully charged; Check motor connections; Contact Ausom support for diagnosis.
Brakes feel weak or spongy	Worn brake pads; Air in hydraulic system; Misaligned calipers	Inspect and replace brake pads; Consult a professional for hydraulic system bleeding or caliper adjustment.
Lights not working	Loose wiring; Blown bulb/LED; Electrical fault	Check wiring connections; Contact support for electrical issues.
