1. INTRODUCTION

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow these basic safety precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliances.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Place appliances on a firm, level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use, before cleaning, or before moving.
- Do not block air vents or exhaust openings.
- Supervise children when appliances are in use.
- Use only clean, cool tap water in the humidifier. Do not add essential oils or other additives to the humidifier water tank unless specifically designed for it.
- Ensure the dehumidifier's water tank is correctly installed before operation.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4.1. Lacidoll 4.2Gal/16L Large Humidifier

This humidifier is designed for large rooms, offering a substantial 4.2-gallon (16-liter) water capacity. It features a smart humidistat for automatic humidity control and operates quietly, making it suitable for bedrooms.

4.2. Lacidoll 118oz Small Dehumidifier

This compact dehumidifier is designed to efficiently remove moisture from smaller spaces, featuring a 118oz (3.5L) water tank. It offers two operating modes and flexible drainage options.

5. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Humidifier Setup

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the humidifier from its packaging.
2. **Placement:** Place the humidifier on a flat, stable, and water-resistant surface at least 6 inches (15 cm) away from walls and furniture. Ensure it is not placed directly on carpet or near heat sources.
3. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the water tank from the base. Unscrew the tank cap, fill the tank with clean, cool tap water. Do not overfill. Securely replace the cap and place the tank back onto the base.
4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the humidifier and then into a standard electrical outlet.

5.2. Dehumidifier Setup

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the dehumidifier from its packaging.
2. **Placement:** Place the dehumidifier on a flat, stable surface in the area where moisture removal is desired. Ensure there is at least 8 inches (20 cm) of space around the air inlets and outlets for proper airflow.
3. **Water Tank:** Ensure the water tank is correctly inserted into the dehumidifier.
4. **Continuous Drainage (Optional):** If you prefer continuous drainage, remove the rubber stopper from the drainage port on the back of the unit. Connect the provided 5ft drain hose firmly to the port and route the other

end to a suitable drain or larger container, ensuring a downward slope for gravity drainage.

5. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the dehumidifier and then into a standard electrical outlet.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Humidifier Operation

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the Power button to turn the humidifier on or off.
2. **Mist Level Adjustment:** Use the Mist Level button to cycle through different mist output settings (e.g., Low, Medium, High).
3. **Humidity Setting (Humidistat):** Press the Humidity button to set your desired humidity level (e.g., 40% to 90%). The unit will automatically adjust mist output to maintain this level.
4. **Timer Function:** Press the Timer button to set an operating duration (e.g., 1-12 hours). The humidifier will automatically turn off after the set time.
5. **Sleep Mode:** Activate Sleep Mode for quieter operation and dimmed display lights, ideal for nighttime use.
6. **Waterless Auto-Off:** The humidifier will automatically shut off when the water tank is empty and indicate a low water warning. Refill the tank to resume operation.

6.2. Dehumidifier Operation

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the Power button to turn the dehumidifier on or off.
2. **Mode Selection:** Press the Mode button to switch between:
 - **Turbo Mode:** For maximum moisture removal. The fan operates at a higher speed.
 - **Sleep Mode:** For quieter operation and dimmed display lights, suitable for bedrooms.
3. **Timer Function:** Press the Timer button to set an operating duration (e.g., 8, 16, or 24 hours). The dehumidifier will automatically turn off after the set time.
4. **7-Color Night Light:** Press the Light button to cycle through the 7-color night light options or turn it off.
5. **Full Water Tank Indicator:** The dehumidifier will stop operating and an indicator light will illuminate when the water tank is full. Empty the tank to resume operation.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance ensure optimal performance and longevity of your appliances.

7.1. Humidifier Maintenance

1. **Daily:** Empty and rinse the water tank and water basin with fresh water.
2. **Weekly:** Clean the water tank and basin thoroughly. Use a soft brush or cloth to remove any mineral deposits or buildup. For stubborn deposits, a solution of white vinegar and water (1:1 ratio) can be used. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning.
3. **Storage:** If storing for an extended period, ensure the unit is completely dry. Clean all components, empty the water tank, and store in a cool, dry place.

7.2. Dehumidifier Maintenance

1. **Emptying Water Tank:** When the 'Full Tank' indicator lights up, carefully pull out the water tank. Dispose of the collected water. Rinse the tank with clean water and reinsert it firmly until it clicks into place.
2. **Cleaning Air Filter (Monthly):** The dehumidifier has an air filter to prevent dust from entering. Gently pull out the filter from its slot. Clean it with a vacuum cleaner or wash it with warm, soapy water. Ensure the filter is completely dry before reinserting.
3. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
4. **Storage:** If storing for an extended period, ensure the water tank is empty and the unit is dry. Clean the air filter and store the dehumidifier in a cool, dry place.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following common issues and solutions:

8.1. Humidifier Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No mist output	No water in tank; Tank not properly seated; Power not connected.	Refill water tank; Re-seat tank correctly; Check power connection.
Unusual odor	Stagnant water; Mineral buildup.	Clean tank and basin thoroughly; Use fresh water daily.
White dust around unit	Hard water.	Use distilled or demineralized water.

8.2. Dehumidifier Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dehumidifier not turning on	No power; Water tank full or not properly inserted.	Check power connection; Empty and re-insert water tank correctly.
Little to no water collected	Room humidity too low; Air filter clogged; Room temperature too low.	Dehumidifier may not be needed; Clean air filter; Ensure room temperature is above 41°F (5°C).
Unit is noisy	Unit not on a level surface; Air filter clogged.	Place on a level surface; Clean air filter.
