INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Initial Power On

- 1. Connect Power: Plug the AC adapter into the laptop's power port and then into a wall outlet.
- 2. Open Laptop: Carefully open the laptop lid.
- 3. **Power On:** Press the power button, typically located on the top right of the keyboard deck. The power indicator light will illuminate.

2. Windows 11 Pro Setup

Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial Windows 11 Pro setup. This includes:

- Selecting your region and keyboard layout.
- Connecting to a Wi-Fi network.
- · Accepting the license agreement.
- Creating or logging in with a Microsoft account.
- Setting up your PIN, fingerprint, or facial recognition (IR Camera).

3. Connecting Peripherals

You can connect external devices such as mice, keyboards, external monitors, and USB drives to the available ports as shown in Figure 2.

OPERATING

1. Basic Usage

- **Keyboard:** Use the integrated backlit keyboard for typing. Function keys (F1-F12) often have secondary functions accessible via the 'Fn' key.
- Touchpad: The precision touchpad supports multi-touch gestures for navigation.
- Touchscreen: Interact directly with the 14-inch WQXGA display using touch gestures.

2. Security Features

- Fingerprint Reader: Enroll your fingerprints through Windows Settings > Accounts > Sign-in options for quick and secure login.
- IR Camera: Utilize Windows Hello facial recognition for convenient and secure access. Set this up in Windows Settings > Accounts > Sign-in options.

3. Power Management

- Sleep Mode: Close the lid or press the power button briefly to put the laptop to sleep.
- Shut Down: Go to Start > Power > Shut down to turn off the laptop completely.
- Restart: Go to Start > Power > Restart to reboot the system.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

- Screen: Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Keyboard and Chassis:** Use a soft cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, ensuring no liquid enters openings.
- Ports: Use compressed air to gently clear dust from ports.

2. Software Updates

Regularly update your Windows operating system and device drivers to ensure optimal performance, security, and compatibility. Access updates via Windows Settings > Windows Update.

3. Battery Care

- · Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not fully discharge the battery frequently.
- For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50-60%.

Troubleshooting

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

1. Laptop Does Not Power On

- Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet.
- Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- If the battery is completely drained, allow it to charge for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on.

2. Display Issues

- No Display: Connect an external monitor to the HDMI port to check if the issue is with the laptop's internal display.
- Flickering/Distorted Display: Update your graphics drivers. Adjust display resolution and refresh rate in Windows Settings > System > Display.

3. Wi-Fi Connectivity Problems

- Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi.
- · Restart your router and modem.
- Run the Windows Network Troubleshooter.

4. Slow Performance

- Close unnecessary applications running in the background.
- Check Task Manager (Ctrl+Shift+Esc) for resource-intensive processes.
- Ensure your system is up to date and free from malware.
