1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure the safe operation of the Gotrax RT1 Electric ATV, please read and adhere to all safety warnings and instructions. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury.

- Adult Supervision Required: This product is intended for use by toddlers aged 1.5-4 years. Constant adult supervision is mandatory during operation.
- Operating Environment: Never use this vehicle in roadways, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, or near swimming pools or other bodies of water. Operate only on flat, level surfaces.
- **Protective Gear:** Always ensure the rider wears appropriate footwear. Helmets and other protective gear are highly recommended.
- Rider Capacity: This vehicle is designed for a single rider only. Never allow more than one rider at a time.
- Weight Limit: Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 44 lbs (20 kg).
- **Battery Safety:** Only use the provided charger and battery. Do not attempt to modify the electrical system. Keep the battery away from children.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Gotrax RT1 Electric ATV is designed to provide a safe and enjoyable riding experience for young children. It features a robust design with intuitive controls suitable for toddlers.

- **Power System:** Equipped with a 12V 4.5Ah rechargeable lead-acid battery, providing up to 80 minutes of continuous play on a full charge.
- Wheels and Speed: Features 8-inch tires for smooth operation on paved surfaces. A powerful motor ensures a maximum speed of 1.5 MPH, designed for toddler safety.
- Safety Design: Engineered with anti-rollover stability features to minimize tipping risks on uneven
- **Controls:** Simple push-button accelerator with distinct forward and reverse driving modes, aiding in confidence building for young riders.

• Comfort: Wide seat and platform provide ample space for comfortable riding.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Gotrax RT1 ATV requires minimal assembly. Please follow these steps carefully before initial use.

3.1. What's in the Box:

- Gotrax RT1 ATV (main body)
- Charger
- Instruction Manual
- Necessary assembly tools (if applicable, refer to specific packaging)

3.2. Initial Assembly:

- 1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- 2. Attach the handlebars to the main body. Ensure they are securely fastened according to the diagrams in the included assembly guide.
- 3. Connect any loose wiring as instructed in the assembly guide.
- 4. Ensure all wheels are properly attached and secured.

3.3. Initial Battery Charging:

Before the first use, the battery must be fully charged. This typically takes 8-12 hours. Do not overcharge the battery.

- 1. Locate the charging port on the ATV.
- 2. Plug the charger into a standard wall outlet.
- 3. Connect the charger to the ATV's charging port.
- 4. Monitor the charging indicator light on the charger (refer to charger instructions for specific light indications).
- 5. Disconnect the charger once charging is complete.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating the Gotrax RT1 ATV is designed to be straightforward for toddlers. Always ensure the child is supervised.

4.1. Controls:

- Power Button: Located on the dashboard (if applicable, refer to specific model for exact location).
 Press to turn the ATV on/off.
- Forward/Reverse Switch: A button or switch on the dashboard allows selection between forward, stop, and reverse modes.

• **Throttle Button:** Typically located on the handlebar, this push-button accelerator controls the speed. Press to move, release to stop.

4.2. Riding the ATV:

- 1. Ensure the child is seated comfortably and securely on the ATV.
- 2. Turn on the ATV using the power button.
- 3. Select the desired direction (forward or reverse) using the switch.
- 4. Instruct the child to gently press the throttle button to begin moving.
- 5. To stop, the child should release the throttle button.
- 6. Always supervise the child to ensure they maintain control and avoid obstacles.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and safe operation of your Gotrax RT1 ATV.

5.1. Battery Care:

- Charge the battery fully after each use.
- If the ATV will not be used for an extended period, charge the battery at least once a month to maintain its health.
- Do not store the battery in extreme temperatures.
- Replace the battery when it no longer holds a charge effectively. The battery is designed for easy replacement with a lock and unlock button.

5.2. Cleaning:

- Wipe the ATV with a damp cloth after use.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- · Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.

- Inspect the wheels and tires for wear or damage.
- Ensure the steering mechanism operates smoothly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
ATV does not move	Battery is low or not charged Loose battery connection Power switch is off	Charge the battery fully Check battery terminals and connections Ensure power switch is in the "ON" position

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
ATV moves slowly	Battery is low Overloaded (exceeds weight limit) Operating on an unsuitable surface	Recharge the battery Ensure only one rider and within weight limit Operate on flat, paved surfaces
Charger indicator light not working	Charger not properly plugged in Faulty charger or outlet	Try a different outlet; contact customer support if charger is faulty Check all connections
