1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps carefully to install your new Fortdows Car Radio Head Unit. Professional installation is

recommended if you are unfamiliar with car audio systems.

3.1. Removing the Original Head Unit

1. Using the provided pry tool, carefully remove the plastic decorative strip around the original radio.
2. Disconnect any wiring harnesses attached to the removed panels.
3. Unscrew all retaining screws holding the original car radio in place.
4. Gently pull out the old radio and disconnect all wires from its rear.

3.2. Connecting the New Head Unit Wiring

1. Connect the main power cable harness to the corresponding port on the new head unit. Ensure to select the correct AMP connector (with or without amplifier) based on your vehicle's configuration.
2. Connect the GPS antenna cable to the GPS port on the head unit. Route the antenna to a suitable location, typically on the dashboard or A-pillar, for optimal signal reception.
3. Connect the radio antenna adapter cable to the head unit and the vehicle's existing radio antenna cable.
4. Connect the USB cables to the head unit. Route these cables to the passenger glove compartment or another accessible location.
5. Connect the external microphone to the head unit and route it to a desired location, such as near the rearview mirror or on the A-pillar.
6. For the backup camera, connect the reversing signal cable to the head unit. The red wire of the camera should be connected to the backup light's positive terminal, and the black wire to ground.
7. Connect the RCA cables for audio output, auxiliary input, or external video sources as needed.

2. Align the new head unit with the dashboard opening and gently push it into place until it clicks securely.
3. Reinstall any decorative panels and screws that were removed earlier.

- **Environmental Care:** Avoid exposing the unit to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, or excessive moisture.
- **Cable Connections:** Ensure all cables are securely connected. Loose connections can lead to intermittent functionality.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your car radio, please refer to the common problems and solutions below. For persistent problems, contact customer support.

- **No Power:** Check all power cable connections. Ensure the vehicle's ignition is on. Verify the fuse in the power cable.
- **No Sound:** Check speaker connections. Ensure volume is not muted or set to zero. Verify audio settings (DSP, EQ).
- **Bluetooth Connection Issues:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both the head unit and your smartphone. Delete previous pairings and try reconnecting.
- **GPS Signal Loss:** Ensure the GPS antenna is correctly installed and has a clear view of the sky.

- **Touchscreen Unresponsive:** Try restarting the unit. If the issue persists, a factory reset might be necessary (note: this will erase all custom settings).
- **Backup Camera Not Displaying:** Check the camera's power and video signal connections. Ensure the reversing wire is correctly connected to the vehicle's reverse light circuit.
