1. Product Overview

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your DNYN Stairway Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed with Slide. This bunk bed features a house-shaped design, two twin-sized sleeping areas, a built-in staircase with storage, and a slide for recreational use. It is constructed from pine wood and MDF for stability and durability.

2. Safety Information

Read all instructions before assembling and using the bunk bed. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** The upper bunk is designed to support a maximum weight of 250 lbs. Do not exceed this limit.
- **Mattress Requirements:**
 - Upper Bed Recommended Mattress Thickness: 6 inches.
 - Lower Bed Recommended Mattress Thickness: 8-10 inches.
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk is equipped with full-length guardrails. Ensure they are always securely in place to prevent falls.
- **Fall Hazard:** Children under 6 years of age should not use the upper bunk.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all connections are tight before use. Periodically check and tighten hardware.
- **Slide Safety:** Use the slide feet first, one person at a time. Ensure the area around the slide exit is

clear.

- **Ventilation:** Do not attach or hang items on any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

3. Setup and Assembly

Assembly is required for this product. It is recommended that two adults assemble the bed. All necessary parts and tools are typically included in the packaging. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide that accompanies your product.

3.1 Key Features for Assembly:

- **Reversible Staircase and Slide:** The staircase and slide can be installed on either the left or right side of the bed frame to best suit your room layout. Decide on the preferred orientation before beginning assembly.
- **Integrated Storage:** The staircase features built-in storage compartments. Ensure these are assembled correctly for stability and functionality.




Figure 2: An illustration detailing the overall dimensions and key measurements of the DNYN Stairway Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed. This diagram is essential for planning room placement and understanding the bed's structural components during assembly.

3.2 General Assembly Steps (Refer to separate guide for specifics):

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list.
2. Assemble the main bed frames (upper and lower) according to the diagrams.
3. Attach the support slats for both beds.

4. Assemble and attach the staircase, ensuring storage compartments are correctly fitted.
5. Attach the slide to the designated opening.
6. Install all safety guardrails on the upper bunk.
7. Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened.

4. Operating Instructions

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and recreational use of the slide and staircase. Adhere to all safety guidelines during use.

- **Accessing the Upper Bunk:** Use the integrated staircase for safe and easy access to the upper bunk. The steps also provide convenient storage.
- **Using the Slide:** The slide is intended for supervised play. Ensure children slide down feet first and that the landing area is clear.
- **Storage:** Utilize the compartments within the staircase for storing small items, keeping the bedroom tidy.

5. Maintenance

Regular maintenance will prolong the life and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., monthly) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Structural Inspection:** Check for any signs of wear, damage, or loose components. Address any issues immediately.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood finish from excessive moisture and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking often indicates loose hardware. Re-tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
- **Instability/Wobbling:** Check that all connections are fully tightened and that the bed is assembled correctly according to the instructions. Verify the bed is placed on a flat, stable floor.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts were missing upon delivery, contact customer support immediately with your purchase information.
- **Damaged Components:** Do not use the bed if any structural components are damaged. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
