Pagani Design PD1795 Quartz Watch User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your Pagani Design PD1795 Quartz Watch. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece. The PD1795 features a precise Japan VX3H quartz movement, offering time, date, day, and moon phase functions within a durable stainless steel case and sapphire mirror.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Pagani Design PD1795 is a men's quartz watch designed for reliability and functionality. It incorporates a unique moon phase display, a date sub-dial, and a day-of-the-week sub-dial. The watch is equipped with a scratch-resistant synthetic sapphire mirror and offers 100 meters of water resistance.

3. SETUP AND ADJUSTMENTS

3.1 Crown Positions

- **Position 0 (Normal):** Crown pushed in completely.
- **Position 1 (First Click):** Crown pulled out one click. Used for quick adjustments of date/day/moon phase.
- **Position 2 (Second Click):** Crown pulled out two clicks. Used for setting the time.

3.2 Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown out to Position 2. The second hand will stop.
2. Turn the crown to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time. Ensure AM/PM is correctly set, especially when setting the date.
3. Push the crown back to Position 0 to start the watch.

3.3 Setting Date, Day, and Moon Phase

Important: To prevent damage to the movement, avoid adjusting the date, day, or moon phase between

9:00 PM and 3:00 AM (21:00 - 03:00). If adjustment is needed during this period, first set the time outside this range, make the adjustments, then reset the time.

1. Pull the crown out to Position 1.
2. Turn the crown clockwise to adjust the date.
3. Turn the crown counter-clockwise to adjust the day of the week.
4. Use the small pusher button (if present, typically on the side of the case) or further crown rotation (depending on movement) to advance the moon phase display to the correct phase. Refer to a moon phase calendar for accuracy.
5. Once all settings are correct, push the crown back to Position 0.

4. OPERATION AND WATER RESISTANCE

4.1 Wearing the Watch

Adjust the strap to fit comfortably on your wrist. The leather strap is designed for comfort and lightweight wear. If you have a stainless steel band, it includes removable links and a strap adjustment tool for resizing.

4.2 Water Resistance (100M)

Your Pagani Design PD1795 watch is water-resistant to 100 meters (10 ATM). This rating means it is suitable for everyday use, including hand washing, face washing, and swimming. However, it is **not** suitable for diving or prolonged submersion at significant depths.

- **Caution:** Do not press any buttons or operate the crown while the watch is wet or submerged.
- **Avoid:** Exposure to extremely hot or cold temperatures, such as hot showers, saunas, or very cold environments, as this can compromise the watch's seals and water resistance over time.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps preserve the appearance and functionality of your watch.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and strap regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For stainless steel, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by drying. For leather straps, avoid excessive moisture and harsh chemicals.
- **Battery Replacement:** As a quartz watch, it is powered by a battery. When the watch stops or the second hand begins to jump erratically (End-of-Life indicator), the battery needs replacement. This should be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store your watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and strong magnetic fields.
- **Avoid Impacts:** Protect the watch from strong shocks or impacts, which can damage the internal movement or external components.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** If the watch stops, the battery may need replacement. Contact a professional watch service for battery replacement.
- **Incorrect Time/Date/Day:** Refer to Section 3, "Setup and Adjustments," to correctly set the time, date, and day. Ensure adjustments are not made between 9:00 PM and 3:00 AM.
- **Condensation Inside Crystal:** If condensation appears under the sapphire mirror, it may indicate a breach in the water resistance. Have the watch inspected by a professional immediately.
