INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your cinnkeyi C5206 Computer Speakers. These 2.0 PC speakers are designed to deliver clear and authentic stereo sound for various devices, including desktops, laptops, and other compatible systems, through multiple connectivity options.

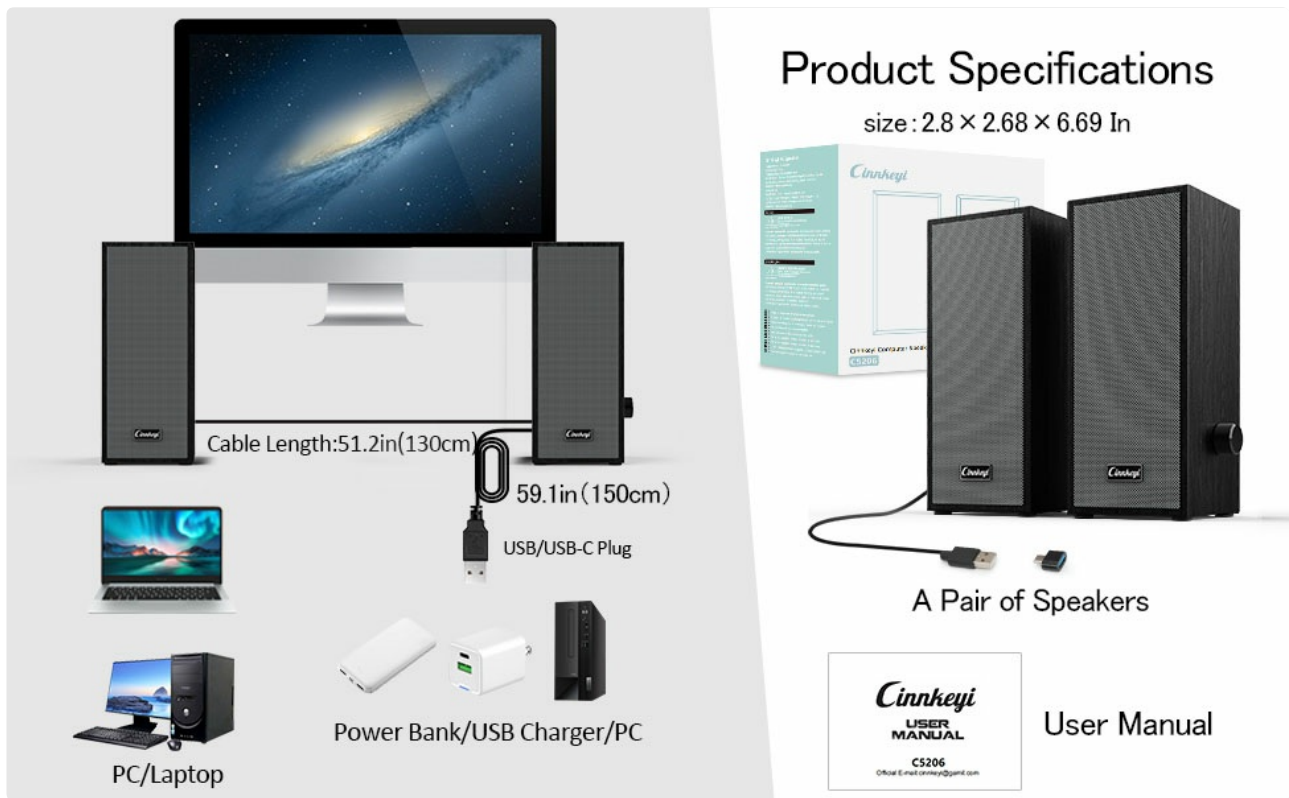


Figure 1: Package contents and connectivity overview. This image displays the two speakers, the integrated USB/USB-C power and audio cable, and the included user manual. It also illustrates various power sources like a power bank, USB charger, or PC.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Speaker Placement:** Position the two speakers on either side of your computer monitor or laptop for optimal stereo sound. Ensure they are on a stable, flat surface.
- 2. Power and Audio Connection:**
 - Connect the integrated USB cable from the main speaker to an available USB port on your computer or a USB power adapter (5V).
 - If your device uses a USB-C port, utilize the provided Type-C adapter to connect the speakers.
 - For stable voltage and consistent performance, it is recommended to plug the USB cable into a rear USB port on your computer.
- 3. Initial Power On:** Once connected, the speakers will power on automatically. No additional drivers are required for basic functionality.

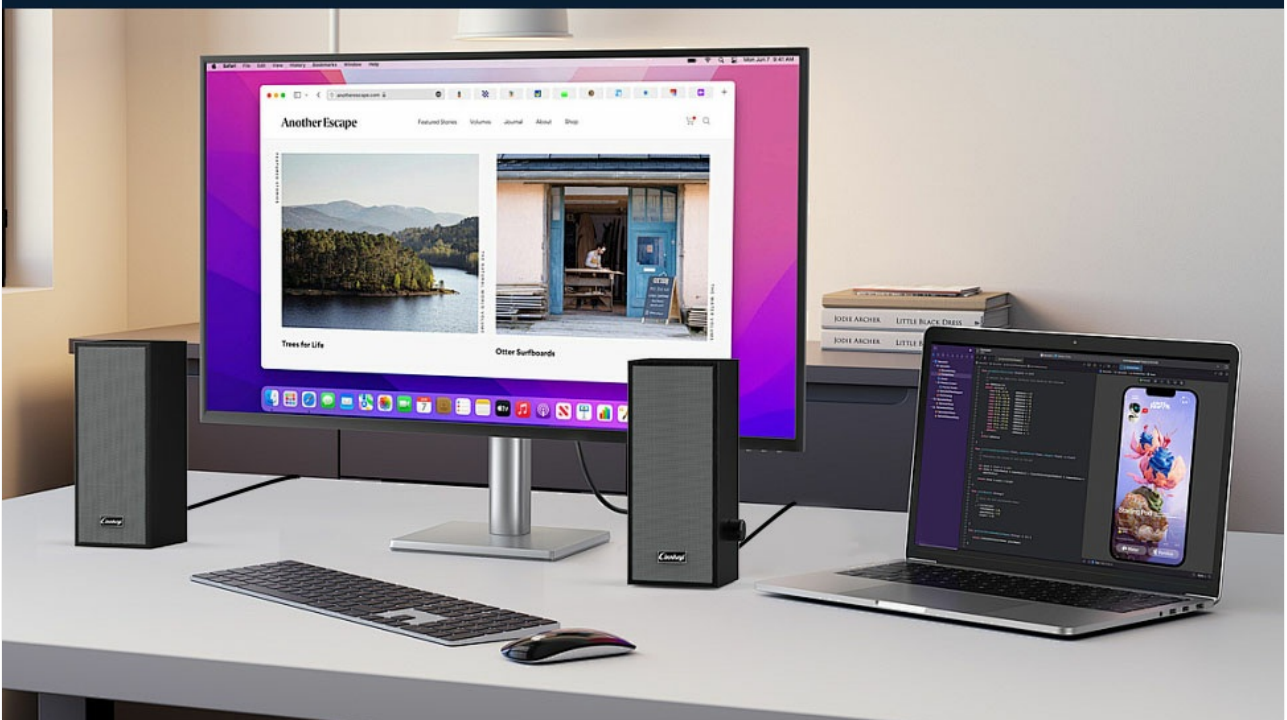


Figure 3: Speakers in a typical desktop setup. This image shows the speakers positioned for an immersive audio experience during gaming or general computer use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Volume Control

The speakers feature an independent rotary volume knob located on one of the speaker units. This knob controls both the power and volume:

- Turn the knob clockwise to increase the volume.
- Turn the knob counter-clockwise to decrease the volume.
- The knob also functions as a mode selector, switching between USB and Bluetooth input modes.

Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your speakers via Bluetooth:

1. Ensure the speakers are powered on.
2. On your device (e.g., smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "C5206" from the list of discovered devices to initiate pairing.
4. Once paired, the speakers will play audio wirelessly from your device.

The speakers are equipped with two 2-inch speaker units, delivering 5W × 2 output power for clear stereo sound.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your speakers, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the speaker surfaces. Avoid using liquid cleaners, aerosols, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the finish or internal components.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the speakers in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the speakers or subjecting them to strong impacts. Do not attempt to disassemble the speaker units, as this will void any potential warranty and may cause damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your cinnkeyi C5206 speakers, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speakers	Speakers not powered on. Volume too low. Incorrect input mode selected. Loose cable connection. Audio source issue.	Ensure USB cable is securely connected to a powered USB port. Turn the volume knob clockwise to increase volume. Rotate the volume knob to switch between USB and Bluetooth modes. Check all cable connections. Verify audio output settings on your computer/device.
Bluetooth pairing failure	Speakers not in pairing mode. Device Bluetooth is off. Speakers too far from device.	Ensure speakers are powered on and the volume knob is set to Bluetooth mode. Enable Bluetooth on your device. Move speakers closer to the Bluetooth device (within 10 meters). Forget "C5206" on your device and attempt to re-pair.
Distorted or poor sound quality	Volume too high (on speakers or source). Low quality audio source. Interference (for Bluetooth).	Reduce volume on both speakers and the audio source. Try a different audio file or streaming service. Move away from other electronic devices that may cause interference.
Speakers turn off and on intermittently	Unstable power supply. Internal fault.	Ensure the USB cable is connected to a stable power source, preferably a rear USB port on your computer or a dedicated USB wall adapter. If the issue persists, contact customer support.

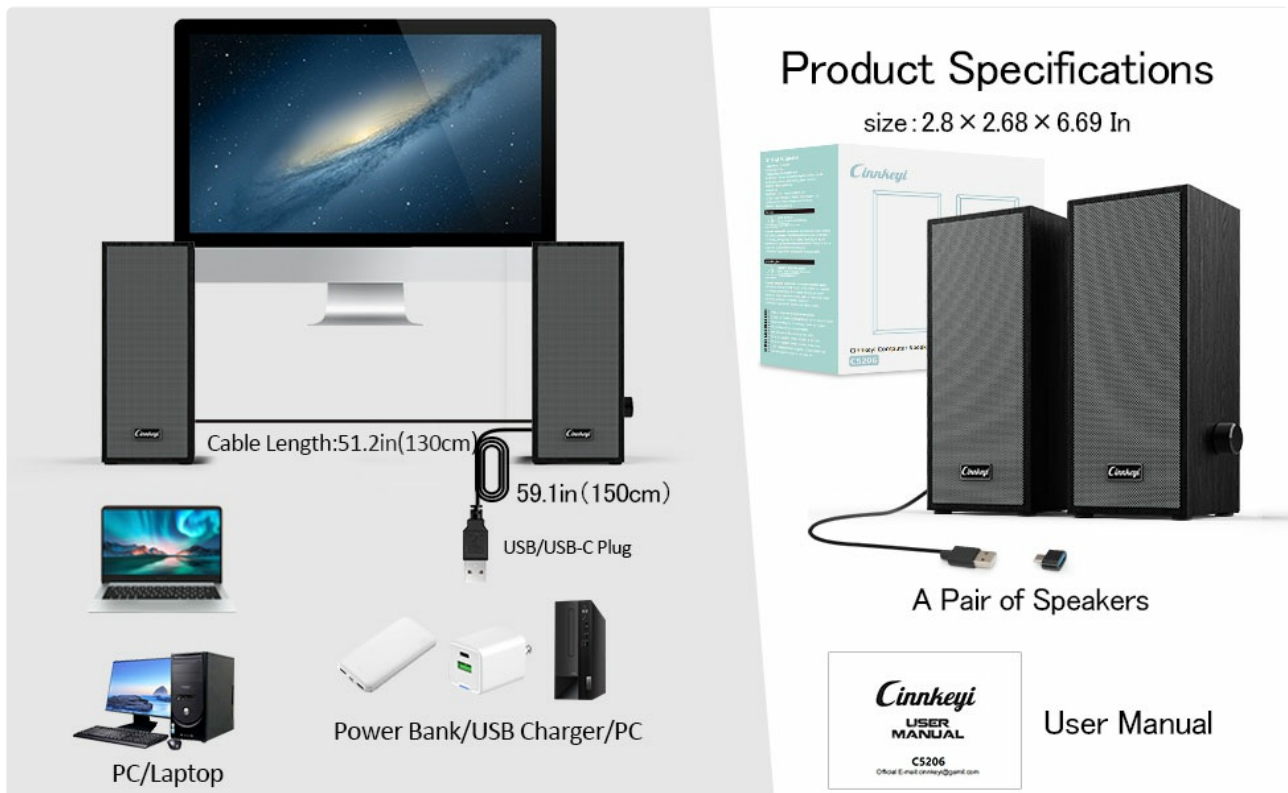


Figure 6: Speaker dimensions and cable lengths. This image provides a visual reference for the physical size of the speakers and the reach of their integrated cables.
