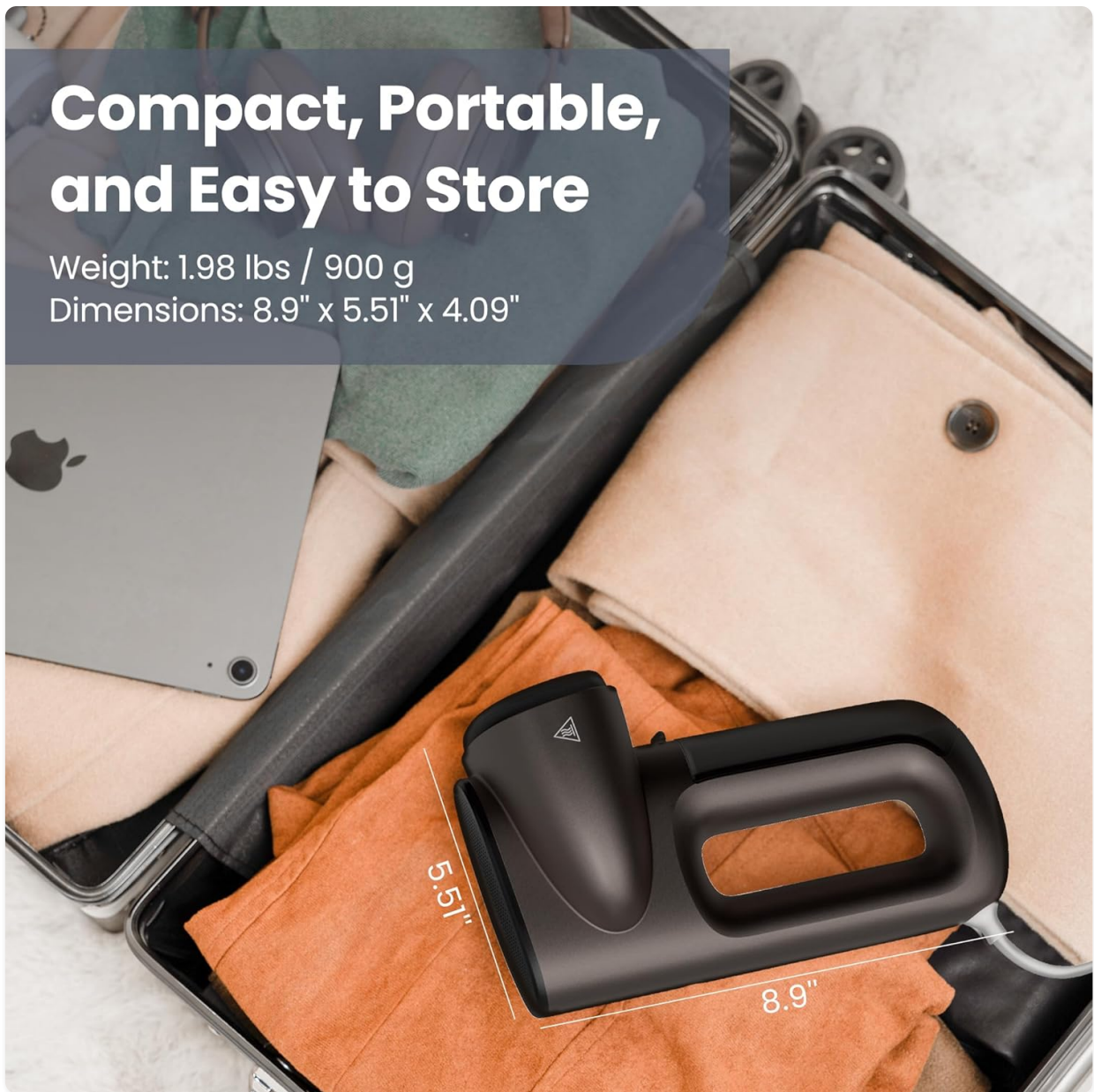

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- This product is designed for use in 110-120V regions (e.g., the U.S., Canada, and Mexico) with Type A/B plugs (two flat pins).
- It is not compatible with 220V-230V regions (e.g., most of Europe).
- Using a voltage converter or adapter is not recommended, as it may affect performance and safety.
- Always use distilled or purified water to prevent mineral buildup and ensure optimal performance.
- Ensure the device is unplugged before filling or emptying the water tank.
- Do not touch the hot steam plate during operation or immediately after use.
- Keep out of reach of children.

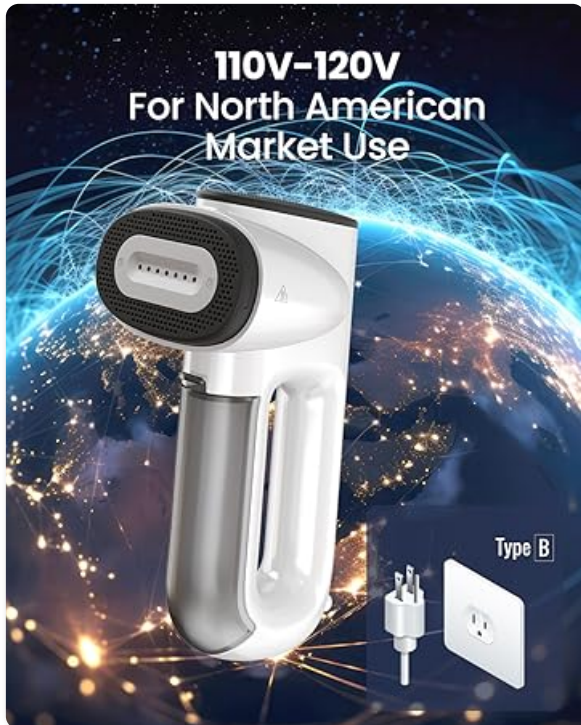

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Neakasa Magic 1 Vacuum Steamer consists of the main unit with a handle, a detachable water tank, and a steam plate with integrated vacuum suction. Control buttons for power, steam, and vacuum functions are located on the handle.

4. SETUP

1. Fill the Water Tank:

- Locate the detachable water tank at the bottom of the handle.
- Gently pull the tank downwards to remove it from the main unit.
- Open the rubber stopper and fill the tank with distilled or purified water. Do not overfill.
- Close the stopper securely and reattach the water tank to the main unit until it clicks into place.

2. Power On:

- Plug the steamer into a 110-120V power outlet.
- Press and hold the power button (usually indicated by a power symbol) for a few seconds until the indicator light illuminates.
- The indicator light will blink (red and green) during the 30-second heat-up period.
- Once the light becomes steady, the steamer is ready for use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Airlron Technology (Vacuum Steaming):

- For sturdy fabrics like T-shirts, shirts, and jeans, activate the Airlron mode.
- Press the fan/vacuum button (indicated by a fan symbol) to engage the 2300Pa suction.
- The steamer will automatically grip the fabric, allowing for easy one-handed steaming.
- Move the steamer in a downward motion over the fabric. The suction helps to flatten the material, delivering perfectly smooth clothes in one pass.

2. Dual Modes for All Fabrics (Traditional Steaming):

- For delicate fabrics like silk, or when using an ironing board, you can turn off the suction feature.
- Press the fan/vacuum button again to deactivate the suction. The steamer will then function like a traditional garment steamer.

- Gently glide the steamer over the fabric, ensuring not to press too hard on delicate materials.

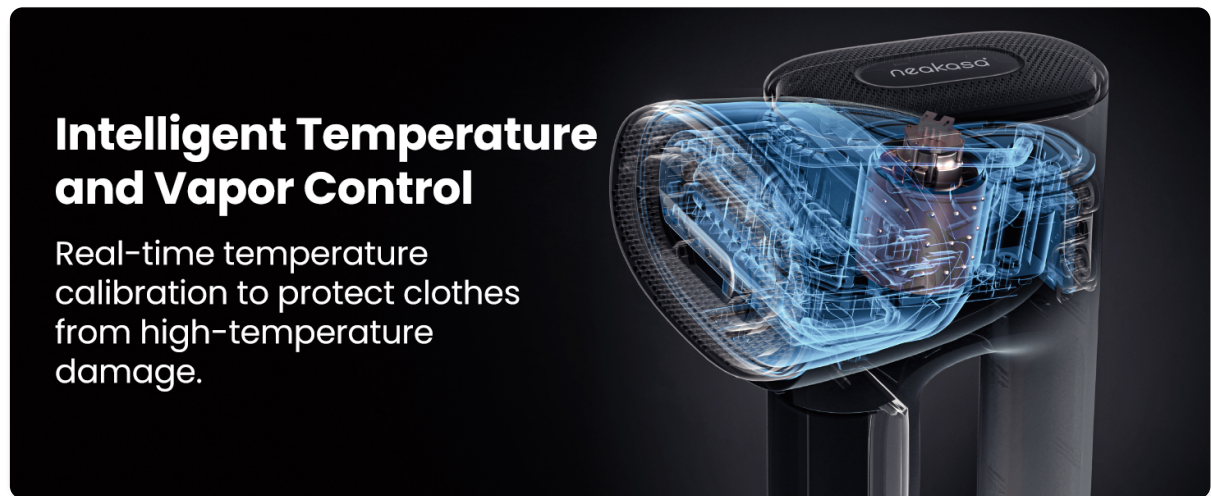

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Water Tank:** Empty any remaining water after each use to prevent stagnant water and mineral buildup.
- **Filter Cleaning:** The internal filter should be cleaned every 3-5 months to maintain optimal performance. Refer to the detailed instructions in the included user manual for specific cleaning steps.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the steamer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Steam/Weak Steam:**
 - Check if the water tank is filled correctly.
 - Ensure the steamer has fully preheated (indicator light is steady).
 - Clean the filter if it hasn't been cleaned recently.
- **Water Leakage/Spitting:**
 - Ensure the water tank stopper is securely closed and the tank is properly attached.

- Allow the steamer to fully preheat before use to prevent water spitting.
- Only use distilled or purified water.
- **Vacuum Function Not Working:**
 - Ensure the steamer is powered on and the steam function is active.
 - Press the fan/vacuum button to activate the suction.
 - Check for any obstructions in the suction vents.
