### IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow the assembly instructions carefully to ensure the bed frame's stability and safety. Do not exceed the weight capacity of each bed: upper bunk - 250 lbs, bottom bunk - 300 lbs, trundle bed - 175 lbs. Be cautious around the bed frame during and after assembly to avoid potential injury from sharp edges or pinch points.

- Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened during assembly and checked periodically.
- Only use mattresses of the recommended thickness: Upper bed: 6 inches, Bottom bed: 8 inches, Trundle bed: 6 inches.
- The upper bunk is designed for children over 6 years old.
- Do not allow children to play on or under the bunk bed without supervision.
- Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, or jump ropes.

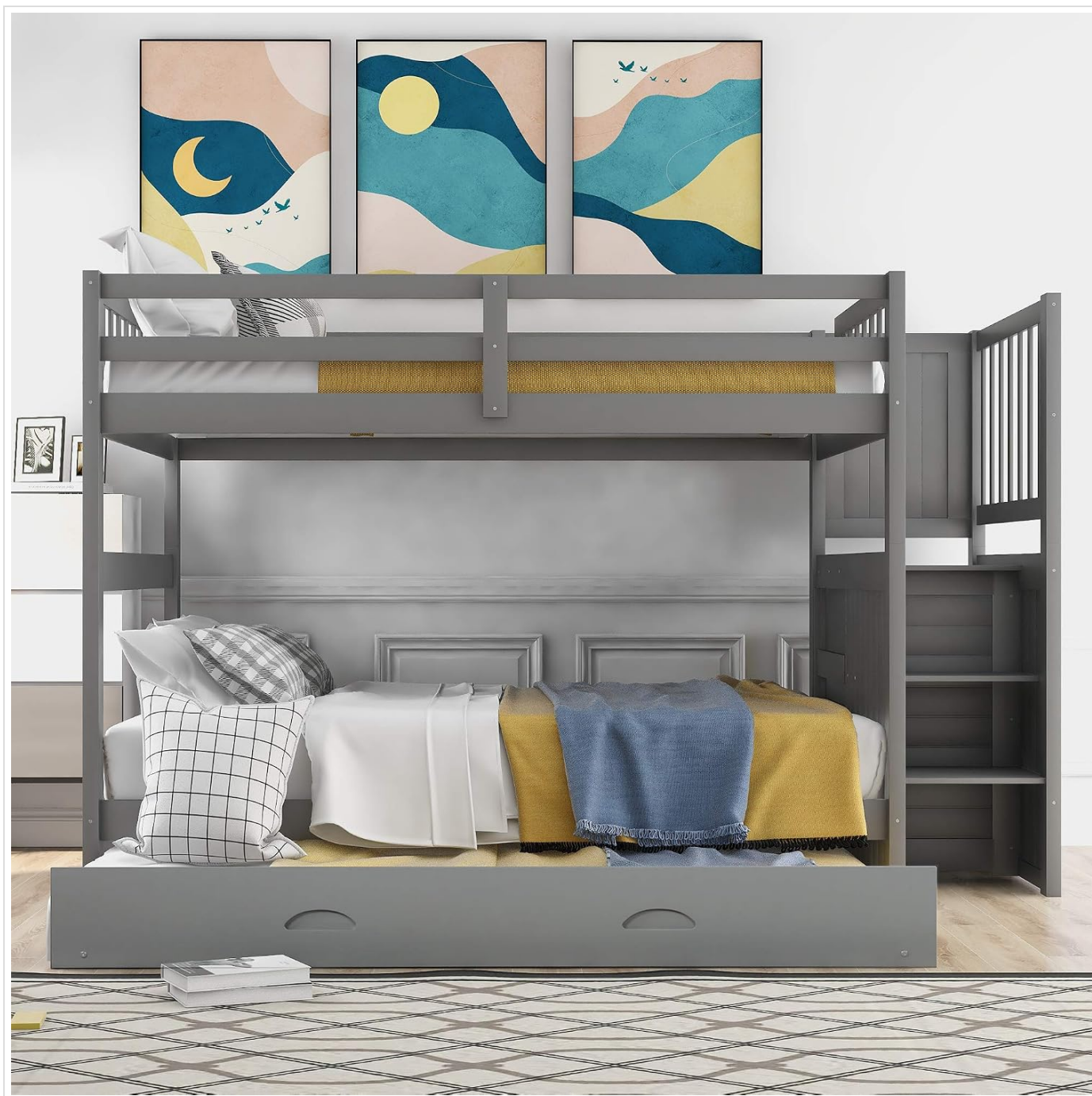

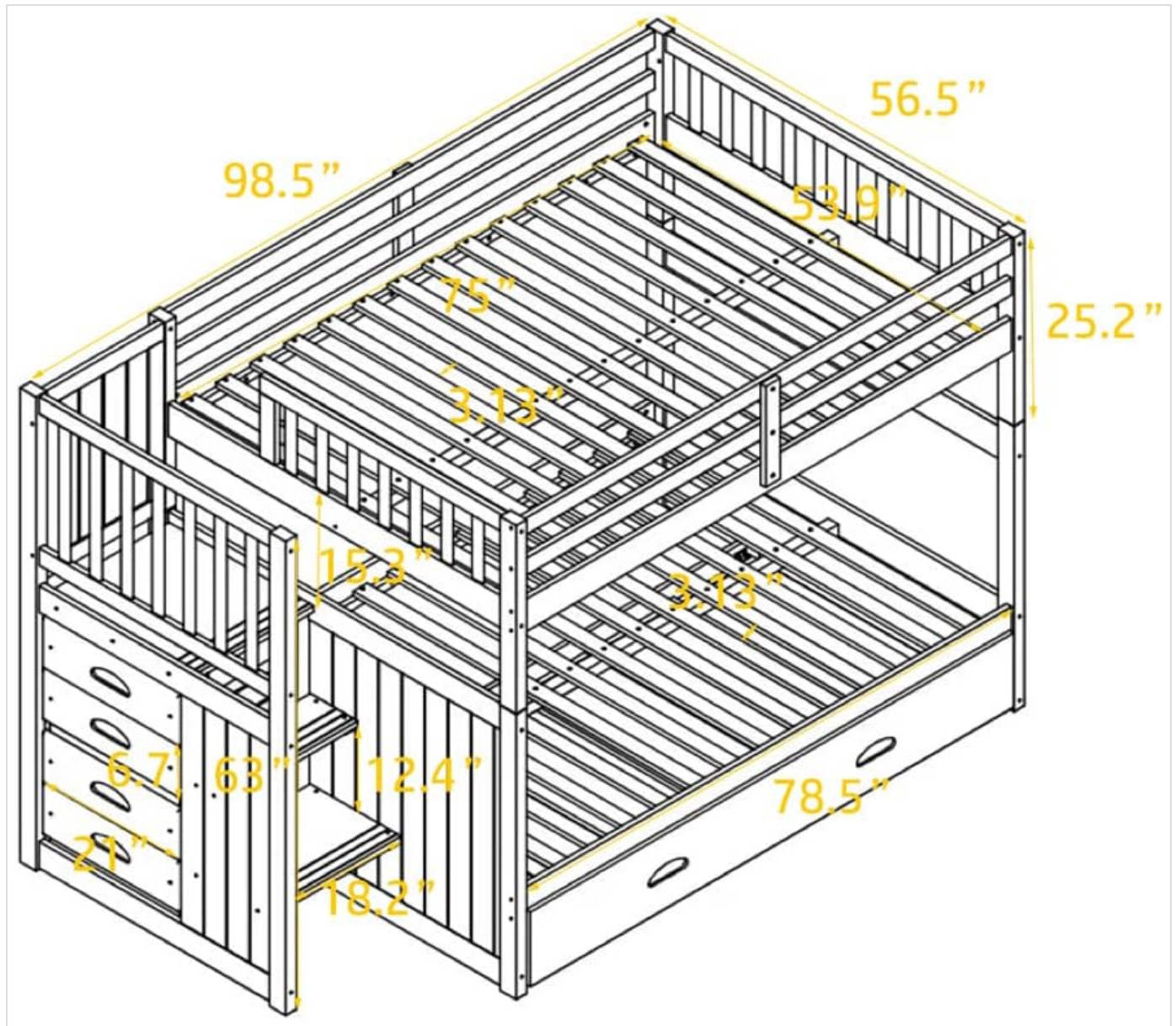

## OPERATING YOUR BUNK BED

### Using the Trundle Bed:

The twin-size trundle bed is located beneath the bottom bunk. To use it, simply pull the trundle frame out from under the bed. It is equipped with wheels for easy movement. To store, push it back into place. Ensure the trundle is fully extended and stable before use.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Protect the wood from excessive moisture and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.
- **Weight Limits:** Adhere strictly to the recommended weight capacities for each bed to prevent damage and ensure safety.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Squeaking Noises:** If the bed makes squeaking noises, check all connections and tighten any loose bolts or screws.
- **Difficulty with Trundle/Drawers:** Ensure there are no obstructions in the path of the trundle or drawers. Check that the tracks are clean and free of debris.
- **Wobbly Frame:** A wobbly frame usually indicates loose fasteners. Re-check and tighten all assembly hardware.
