- Avoid direct eye exposure to the projector lens when the lamp is on.
- Use only attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Operate the projector in a dark environment for optimal image quality.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The wowlink W210 is a portable mini projector featuring WiFi 6, Bluetooth 5.4, and built-in streaming applications. It supports 4K video playback with a native 720P resolution and offers 180° rotation for versatile projection.

Key Features:

- **Air Remote Function:** Gyroscope-based remote for intuitive screen control.
- **Built-in Applications:** Pre-installed Netflix, Prime Video, YouTube, and D+.
- **Display:** Native 720P resolution, supports 4K HDR video, 200 ANSI lumens, 10000:1 contrast ratio.
- **Connectivity:** Dual-band WiFi 6 (2.4GHz/5GHz) and Bluetooth 5.4.
- **Audio:** Built-in immersive base-type stereo speaker.
- **Versatility:** 180° rotatable design for wall or ceiling projection, 0.25-inch screw hole for tripod/mount.
- **Auto Keystone:** Automatic image correction.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Power Connection

1. Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port.
2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet. The projector will power on or enter standby mode.

2. Placement and Projection Angle

The W210 projector features a 180° rotatable design, allowing flexible placement and projection onto walls or ceilings.

- Place the projector on a stable surface.
- Adjust the projector's angle by rotating its body to direct the image onto your desired surface (wall, screen, or ceiling).

- For ceiling or wall mounting, use the 0.25-inch screw hole at the bottom with a compatible tripod or mount (sold separately).

3. Auto Keystone Correction

The projector automatically corrects trapezoidal distortion to ensure a rectangular image.

- After positioning the projector, the auto keystone function will activate to square the image.
- If manual adjustment is needed, navigate to the settings menu using the remote control.

4. Remote Control Pairing (Air Remote)

The remote control features an Air Remote function for intuitive navigation.

1. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on the projector (usually enabled by default).
2. Press and hold the Left and Right arrow buttons on the remote simultaneously until the projector beeps.
3. Press the "mouse" icon button on the remote to activate Air Mouse mode.
4. Shake your wrist to move the cursor on the screen. Press the "OK" button to select.

5. Network Connection (WiFi 6)

Connect your projector to a wireless network for internet access and streaming.

- Navigate to the "Settings" menu on the projector.
- Select "Network" or "Wi-Fi Settings".
- Choose your desired Wi-Fi network from the list.
- Enter the password if prompted and confirm the connection.

6. Bluetooth Connection

Connect external Bluetooth devices like speakers or headphones.

- Go to "Settings" and select "Bluetooth".
- Ensure Bluetooth is turned on.
- Put your Bluetooth device into pairing mode.
- Select your device from the list of available devices on the projector screen to pair.

7. External Device Connection

The projector supports HDMI and USB connections.

- **HDMI:** Connect laptops, PCs, TV sticks, or gaming consoles using an HDMI cable. Select the HDMI input source from the projector's menu.
- **USB:** Insert USB drives for media playback. Select the USB input source from the projector's menu.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Navigating the Interface

- Use the directional buttons on the remote control to move between menu items.
- Press the "OK" button to select an item.
- Use the "Back" button to return to the previous screen.
- Activate the Air Remote function for a mouse-like cursor experience.

2. Using Built-in Applications

The projector comes with pre-installed streaming apps like Netflix, Prime Video, YouTube, and D+.

- Ensure the projector is connected to Wi-Fi.
- From the home screen, select the desired application icon.
- Log in with your account credentials if required by the application.
- Browse and play content directly.

3. Screen Mirroring (Wireless Projection)

Wirelessly project content from your smartphone, tablet, or computer.

- Ensure both the projector and your device are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- On the projector, select the "Screen Mirroring" or "Wireless Projection" option.
- On your mobile device (Android/iOS) or computer (Windows/macOS), activate its screen mirroring feature (e.g., Miracast, AirPlay, or equivalent).
- Select the projector from the list of available devices.

4. Adjusting Settings

Access the settings menu to customize image, sound, and system preferences.

- **Image Settings:** Adjust brightness, contrast, color, and aspect ratio.
- **Sound Settings:** Control volume, audio output (internal speaker or Bluetooth), and sound modes.
- **System Settings:** Manage network connections, language, date/time, and software updates.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Lens

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses.
- Gently wipe the lens in a circular motion. Do not use abrasive cleaners or excessive force.

2. General Care

- Keep the projector in a clean, dry environment.
- Avoid placing the projector near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Ensure ventilation openings are clear of obstructions to prevent overheating.
- When not in use, cover the lens with its cap to protect it from dust.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
No image or blurry image	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the power cable is securely connected.• Check if the lens cap is removed.• Verify the input source is correctly selected (HDMI, USB, or built-in apps).• Allow auto keystone correction to complete. If needed, manually adjust focus in settings.• Ensure the projection surface is flat and clear.
No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase the volume on the projector and the source device.• Check if the projector is connected to external Bluetooth speakers. If so, ensure they are powered on and paired correctly.• If using HDMI, ensure the audio output from the source device is enabled.
Wi-Fi connection issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the projector is within range of your Wi-Fi router.• Verify the Wi-Fi password is entered correctly.• Restart the projector and your Wi-Fi router.• Check for any network interference.

Problem	Possible Solution
Remote control not responding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure the remote control has fresh batteries. • Re-pair the remote control following the "Remote Control Pairing" instructions in the Setup Guide. • Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the projector.



