INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the INFANS Licensed Mercedes Benz 3-in-1 Push Car. This versatile ride-on toy is designed to adapt to your child's growth, offering three modes: a baby push car, a walking car, and a sliding ride-on car. It features a licensed Mercedes-Benz design, a parent control handle, a horn, music, underneath storage, and a rotatable canopy for comfort and safety. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper operation and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Adult Supervision Required:** Always supervise children when they are using the push car.
- **Age Range:** Suitable for children aged 18-36 months.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 55 lbs (25 kg).
- **Assembly:** Adult assembly is required. Ensure all parts are correctly installed and secured before use.
- **Hazard Prevention:** Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.
- **Usage Environment:** Use on flat, smooth surfaces. Avoid slopes, stairs, busy roads, or uneven terrain.
- **Protective Gear:** Consider using protective gear such as helmets and knee pads, especially when the child is using it as a walking or sliding car.
- **Detachable Parts:** Ensure the safety guardrail and footrest are properly attached when needed.
- **Anti-Tipping Device:** The car is equipped with an anti-tipping device for enhanced stability.
- **Material Safety:** Made of non-toxic materials, free from BPA, PVC, Phthalates, Lead, Latex, and Formaldehyde. No sharp points or edges.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your INFANS Mercedes Benz Push Car. Refer to the assembly video for visual guidance.

This video demonstrates the step-by-step assembly process for the INFANS Licensed Mercedes Benz Push Car. It shows how to attach the push handle, safety bar, and other components.

1. **Attach the Steering Wheel:** Secure the steering wheel to the main body of the car. Ensure it clicks into place or is fastened according to the specific instructions provided in the included manual.
2. **Install the Push Handle:** Insert the push handle into the designated slot at the rear of the car. Ensure it is firmly locked. This handle allows parents to control the direction.
3. **Attach the Safety Guardrail:** If using the push car mode for younger children, attach the safety guardrail around the seat. Ensure both sides are securely fastened.
4. **Install the Canopy:** Position the canopy support into its slot and attach the canopy fabric. Adjust its angle as needed to provide shade.
5. **Retractable Footrest:** The footrest can be extended for younger children to rest their feet or retracted for older children to use the foot-to-floor sliding motion.
6. **Check All Connections:** Before first use, double-check that all screws, pins, and detachable parts are securely attached and tightened.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The INFANS Mercedes Benz Push Car offers three modes of use to grow with your child.

1. Baby Push Car Mode (with Parent Handle and optional Canopy/Guardrail)

This mode is ideal for younger toddlers (18-24 months) who need full parental assistance and protection. It includes variations with or without the canopy and safety guardrail.

- Ensure the push handle is attached. For maximum safety, attach the safety guardrail and extend the footrest.
- Place your child securely in the seat, ensuring the safety guardrail is closed (if used).
- Use the parent control handle to steer and push the car. The parent handle has priority over the child's steering wheel for safety.
- If desired, attach and adjust the 360° rotatable canopy to shield your child from direct sunlight.

2. Walking Car Mode

As your child grows (approx. 25-36 months) and gains more confidence, the canopy and safety guardrail can be removed, while the parent handle remains for assistance.

- Remove the canopy and safety guardrail. The push handle can remain attached.
- Your child can begin to use their feet to propel the car while still benefiting from the parent's steering assistance.
- This mode helps develop leg muscle strength and balance.

3. Sliding Ride-on Car Mode (Foot-to-Floor)

For older toddlers (approx. 37-60 months) who are ready for independent play.

- Remove the push handle, safety guardrail, and canopy.
- Retract the footrest.
- Your child can now use their feet to push off the ground and steer the car independently.

- The steering wheel features a horn and built-in music for interactive play.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Storage:** Store the push car in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight when not in use to prevent material degradation.
- **Wheel Inspection:** Periodically check the wheels for wear and tear. Ensure they rotate freely and are free of debris.
- **Fastener Check:** Regularly inspect all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten if necessary.
- **Moving Parts:** Ensure all moving parts, such as the steering mechanism and retractable footrest, operate smoothly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car does not move smoothly.	Wheels are dirty or obstructed.	Clean wheels and remove any debris. Ensure wheels are properly attached.
Steering is difficult or unresponsive.	Steering mechanism obstructed or loose.	Check for obstructions. Ensure the steering wheel and parent handle connections are secure.
Horn/music not working.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly installed.	Replace batteries in the steering wheel (if applicable). Ensure they are inserted with correct polarity.
Parts feel loose after assembly.	Fasteners not fully tightened.	Re-check all screws, pins, and connections. Tighten securely.
