Paramount Locked DVD Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your **Locked DVD**. The movie features a suspenseful thriller where a petty thief finds himself trapped inside a high-tech SUV, controlled remotely by its vengeful owner. This DVD is presented in widescreen format with English 5.1 Dolby Digital audio and English SDH subtitles. The film has a runtime of 2 hours and 5 minutes.




Image 1.2: Promotional artwork for the movie Locked.

2. SETUP

To begin watching your Locked DVD, follow these steps:

1. **Connect your DVD player:** Ensure your DVD player is properly connected to your television or display device using appropriate cables (e.g., HDMI, composite, component). Refer to your DVD player's manual for specific connection instructions.
2. **Power on devices:** Turn on your television and your DVD player.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your DVD will ensure its longevity and optimal playback quality.

- **Handling:** Always hold the DVD by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface to prevent fingerprints and scratches.
- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty or smudged, gently wipe the playback surface with a soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., microfiber cloth). Wipe from the center of the disc outwards in a straight line, not in a circular motion. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** Store the DVD in its original case when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. Avoid placing heavy objects on the disc case.
- **Scratches:** Minor scratches may not affect playback, but deep scratches can cause skipping or playback errors. Handle discs with care to prevent damage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing your Locked DVD, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Disc does not play or load.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the disc is inserted correctly (label side up).• Check if the DVD player is powered on and connected to the correct TV input.• Clean the disc surface with a soft, lint-free cloth.• Try playing another DVD to confirm the player is functioning correctly.
Video or audio skipping/freezing.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean the disc surface for smudges or dust.• Inspect the disc for deep scratches. If severely scratched, replacement may be necessary.• Ensure the DVD player is on a stable surface to prevent vibrations.
No audio.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check the volume level on your TV and DVD player.• Verify that audio cables are securely connected.• Ensure the correct audio track is selected in the DVD menu.

Problem	Possible Solution
No video.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Confirm the TV is set to the correct input source. Check video cables for secure connection. Try playing another DVD to isolate if the issue is with the disc or the player/TV.
