INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your ZHRCLY General Accessory for the Wilo Recirculating Pump ST20/11. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure safe and efficient performance. Keep this manual for future reference. This accessory is designed to integrate seamlessly with the Wilo Recirculating Pump ST20/11, enhancing its functionality or replacing a component. Always refer to the original Wilo pump manual for pump-specific instructions.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Leakage around accessory	Loose connection, damaged seal/gasket, improper installation.	Tighten connections. Inspect and replace seals/gaskets if damaged. Reinstall accessory correctly.
Pump not operating correctly after accessory installation	Accessory blockage, incorrect electrical connection (if applicable), accessory incompatibility.	Check for obstructions. Verify electrical wiring. Ensure the accessory is the correct model for ST20/11.
Unusual noise/vibration from accessory area	Loose mounting, internal damage, foreign object.	Check mounting bolts. Disconnect power and inspect for foreign objects. If internal damage is suspected, replace the accessory.
