# Introduction

The Evenflo LiteMax 30 Infant Car Seat is designed to provide safety and comfort for infants weighing between 3 and 30 pounds. This manual provides essential information for proper installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure the safe use of your car seat.

# **Setup and Installation**

## **Installing the Car Seat Base:**

- 1. Place the car seat base on the vehicle seat in a rear-facing position. Ensure it is level.
- 2. Route the vehicle's lap belt or LATCH system through the designated belt path on the base.
- 3. Engage the vehicle belt lock-off mechanism to secure the base tightly. The base should not move more than one inch side-to-side or front-to-back at the belt path.

4. Verify the recline angle using the built-in recline indicator on the base. The indicator should be within the acceptable range for your infant's weight.

### **Attaching the Infant Carrier to the Base:**

- 1. Align the infant carrier with the base.
- 2. Lower the carrier onto the base until it clicks securely into place.
- 3. Always check that the carrier is firmly attached to the base by lifting it slightly.

# **Operating the Car Seat**

### Placing Your Child in the Car Seat:

- 1. Unbuckle the harness and loosen the shoulder straps.
- 2. Place your infant in the car seat with their back flat against the seat back.
- 3. Bring the harness straps over your child's shoulders and between their legs.
- 4. Buckle the crotch buckle, then connect the chest clip. The chest clip should be positioned at armpit level.
- 5. Tighten the harness straps until they are snug against your child's body. You should not be able to pinch any excess

# **Adjusting the Canopy:**

The full-coverage canopy can be adjusted by pulling it forward or pushing it back to shield your child from the elements.

## **Maintenance and Care**

### **Cleaning Instructions:**

- **Fabric Pads:** The fabric pads are removable and machine washable. Use cold water and a gentle cycle. Tumble dry on low heat or air dry. Do not use bleach.
- Harness Straps: Wipe harness straps with a damp cloth. Do not machine wash or submerge harness straps in water, as this can weaken the webbing.
- Plastic and Metal Parts: Wipe plastic and metal parts with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

# Storage:

Store the car seat in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use for extended periods.

# **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car seat base is loose after installation.	Vehicle belt not tight enough or lock-off not engaged.	Re-read installation instructions. Ensure vehicle belt is pulled taut and the lock-off is fully engaged. Apply pressure to the base while tightening.
Harness straps are difficult to tighten or loosen.	Straps may be twisted or obstructed.	Check for twists in the harness straps. Ensure no fabric or clothing is obstructing the harness mechanism.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Infant carrier does not click securely into the base.	Misalignment or obstruction.	Ensure the carrier is properly aligned with the base's connection points. Check for any debris obstructing the connection.
