INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Blink Video Doorbell and Blink Outdoor 4 camera system. These devices offer advanced wireless smart security features, including head-to-toe HD view, two-year battery life, and two-way audio, designed to enhance your home security and peace of mind.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Download the Blink Home Monitor App

Before beginning installation, download the Blink Home Monitor app from your device's app store (iOS, Android, or Fire OS). Create an account or log in if you already have one.

2. Set Up the Sync Module Core

The Sync Module Core is essential for your Blink system to function.

- 1. Plug the Sync Module Core into a power outlet using the provided power adapter and USB-C cable.
- 2. Place it centrally within your home, ensuring it's within Wi-Fi range and can communicate with both the Video Doorbell and Outdoor 4 camera.
- 3. Follow the in-app instructions to connect the Sync Module Core to your 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network.

3. Install the Blink Video Doorbell

The Blink Video Doorbell can be installed wirelessly or wired to an existing chime.

- 1. Insert the three AA lithium batteries into the Video Doorbell.
- 2. Choose your mounting location. Use the drill template and mounting kit to secure the wall plate.
- 3. If wiring, connect the doorbell wires to the terminals on the wall plate using the wire extenders if necessary. Ensure power is off before connecting.
- 4. Snap the Video Doorbell onto the wall plate.
- 5. Follow the in-app instructions to add the Video Doorbell to your Sync Module system.

4. Install the Blink Outdoor 4 Camera

The Outdoor 4 camera is designed for outdoor use and is completely wireless.

- 1. Insert the two AA lithium batteries into the Outdoor 4 camera.
- 2. Select an optimal outdoor location for the camera, ensuring it has a clear view and is within range of the Sync Module Core.
- 3. Use the provided mounting kit to securely attach the camera to a wall or surface.
- 4. Follow the in-app instructions to add the Outdoor 4 camera to your Sync Module system.

OPERATING YOUR BLINK SYSTEM

Using the Blink Home Monitor App

The Blink app is your central control hub for managing your security system.

- Live View: Access real-time video streams from your Video Doorbell (head-to-toe HD) and Outdoor 4 camera (1080p HD).
- Two-Way Audio: Speak and listen to visitors or deter intruders using the built-in microphone and speaker on both devices.
- Motion Detection: Configure motion detection zones and sensitivity for both devices. Receive instant alerts on your smartphone when motion is detected. Outdoor 4 features enhanced dual-zone motion detection.
- Night Vision: Both devices feature infrared night vision for clear viewing in low-light conditions.
- Arm/Disarm System: Easily arm or disarm your entire system or individual cameras through the app.

- Video Storage: With a Blink Subscription Plan (sold separately), securely store video clips in the cloud for up to 60 days. A free 30-day trial is typically included.
- Smart Notifications: Receive intelligent alerts, including person detection (with a Blink Subscription Plan), directly on your phone.






Image: A family viewing a live feed from their Blink camera on an Alexa-compatible smart display, demonstrating the two-way communication feature.




Image: A smartphone screen displaying smart notifications from the Blink app, including alerts for motion detection and person detection.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Replacement

Both the Video Doorbell and Outdoor 4 camera are designed for up to two years of battery life under typical usage. The Blink app will notify you when battery levels are low.

- Video Doorbell: Use the provided doorbell removal tool to detach the doorbell from its wall plate. Replace the three AA 1.5V lithium metal batteries.
- Outdoor 4 Camera: Open the battery compartment on the back of the camera. Replace the two AA 1.5V lithium metal batteries.
- Always use non-rechargeable lithium metal batteries for optimal performance and battery life.

Cleaning Your Devices

Periodically clean the camera lenses and device surfaces to ensure clear video quality and proper functionality.

- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the lens and body of the devices.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the device.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Connectivity Issues

- No Live View/Offline Device: Ensure your Sync Module Core is powered on and connected to your Wi-Fi network. Check your home Wi-Fi signal strength.
- Poor Video Quality: Check your Wi-Fi signal strength at the camera's location. Ensure the camera lens is clean
 and free from obstructions.

Motion Detection Problems

- Too Many/Few Alerts: Adjust motion detection sensitivity and activity zones within the Blink app. Consider the camera's placement relative to high-traffic areas or environmental factors (e.g., moving branches).
- False Alerts: Refine activity zones to exclude areas with frequent, non-relevant motion.

Battery Life Concerns

Shorter Than Expected Battery Life: Frequent Live View access, high motion detection sensitivity, and extreme
temperatures can reduce battery life. Review your settings in the Blink app. Ensure you are using recommended
lithium metal batteries.
