1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the NEREIDS NET 49cc 4-Stroke Mini Dirt Bike. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new dirt bike. Key Components

- **Key Start:** For ignition and turning the engine on/off.
- **Friction Handle:** Controls braking.
- **Fuel Tank:** Holds gasoline.
- **Damping Spring:** Provides rear suspension for a smoother ride.
- **Exhaust Pipe:** Directs engine exhaust gases.
- **Tires:** Inflatable rubber tires designed for various off-road conditions.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

2. **Handlebar Installation:** Attach the handlebars to the steering column, ensuring they are centered and tightened securely.
3. **Wheel Installation (if necessary):** If wheels are not pre-installed, attach them according to the instructions, ensuring all fasteners are tight.
4. **Tire Inflation:** Inflate tires to the recommended pressure, typically found on the tire sidewall.
5. **Fueling:** Fill the fuel tank with appropriate gasoline (refer to specifications for fuel type). Do not overfill.
6. **Oil Check:** Verify engine oil level. Add oil if necessary, using the recommended type.
7. **Brake Adjustment:** Ensure brakes are properly adjusted and functioning correctly.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to safely start and operate your NEREIDS NET Mini Dirt Bike.

Starting the Engine

1. **Turn Key:** Insert the key into the ignition and turn it to the 'ON' position.
2. **Choke (if applicable):** If starting a cold engine, engage the choke. Disengage once the engine warms up.
3. **Pull Start:** Firmly pull the starter cord until the engine starts. Do not yank the cord to its full extension.
4. **Warm-up:** Allow the engine to warm up for a few minutes before riding.

Riding

- **Throttle Control:** Gently twist the throttle to accelerate. Practice smooth acceleration and deceleration.
- **Braking:** Use both front and rear brakes smoothly and simultaneously to slow down or stop. Avoid sudden braking, especially on loose surfaces.
- **Steering:** Lean into turns and use the handlebars for steering control.
- **Terrain:** This bike is suitable for various off-road conditions including snow, mountain, sand, and city roads (private property only).

Stopping the Engine

- **Throttle Off:** Release the throttle completely.
- **Brake:** Apply brakes to come to a complete stop.
- **Turn Key:** Turn the ignition key to the 'OFF' position.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your dirt bike.

- **Chain Lubrication:** Lubricate the drive chain every few rides or after riding in wet/dusty conditions.
- **Tire Pressure:** Check tire pressure before each ride. Maintain recommended pressure for optimal performance and safety.
- **Oil Change:** Refer to the engine manufacturer's guidelines for oil change intervals and recommended oil type.
- **Brake Inspection:** Regularly inspect brake pads and cables for wear. Adjust or replace as needed.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and fasteners for tightness.
- **Air Filter:** Clean or replace the air filter regularly, especially when riding in dusty environments.
- **Spark Plug:** Inspect and clean the spark plug periodically. Replace if worn.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine won't start	No fuel, key off, choke not engaged (cold), fouled spark plug	Check fuel level, turn key ON, engage choke, clean/replace spark plug
Loss of power	Low fuel, dirty air filter, improper fuel mixture	Refuel, clean air filter, check carburetor settings
Brakes not effective	Worn brake pads, loose cable, air in hydraulic system (if applicable)	Inspect/replace pads, adjust cable tension, bleed brakes (professional service recommended)
Excessive vibration	Loose fasteners, unbalanced wheels, engine issue	Check all fasteners, inspect wheels, consult a mechanic for engine issues
