Kidilo Baby Stroller 6600 Instruction Manual

Model: 6600

INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and proper use, assembly, and maintenance of your Kidilo Baby Stroller Model 6600. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the stroller and retain it for future reference. The Kidilo 6600 stroller is designed for comfort, safety, and convenience, featuring a lightweight aluminum frame, reversible handle, and compact fold.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always use the 5-point safety harness to secure your child in the stroller.
- Never leave your child unattended in the stroller.
- Ensure all locking devices are engaged before placing a child in the stroller.
- Do not overload the storage basket or hang bags on the handle, as this may cause the stroller to become unstable.
- The stroller is suitable for children up to 22 kilograms.
- Do not use accessories or replacement parts other than those approved by the manufacturer.
- Keep children clear of moving parts during adjustment.
- Engage the brakes when parking the stroller.

COMPONENTS OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your Kidilo 6600 Stroller:

- **Main Frame:** Lightweight aluminum construction.
- **Seat Unit:** Orthopedic seat with adjustable recline.
- **Canopy:** Adjustable sun canopy.
- **Handlebar:** Reversible and adjustable for parent comfort.
- **Wheels:** Front swivel wheels with lock, rear wheels with brake system.
- **Safety Harness:** 5-point harness system.

- **Storage Basket:** Under-seat storage.
- **Bumper Bar:** Removable front bar.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Unfolding the Frame:**
 - a. Place the folded stroller on a flat surface.
 - b. Release the folding latch, usually located on the side of the frame.
 - c. Lift the handlebar upwards until the frame locks into its open position. Listen for a click to confirm it is securely locked.
3. **Attaching Wheels:**
 - a. Insert the front wheels into their respective slots until they click into place.
 - b. Attach the rear wheels by pushing them onto the axle until they lock securely.
4. **Attaching the Bumper Bar:** Align the bumper bar with the attachment points on the seat unit and push until it clicks into place.
5. **Final Check:** Before first use, ensure all parts are securely attached and locked.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Folding the Stroller

1. Ensure the seat is in an upright position and the canopy is retracted.
2. Locate the folding mechanism (often a button or lever on the handlebar or frame).
3. Follow the specific folding steps for your model, usually involving pressing a button and pushing the handlebar

forward or downward.

- Secure the folding latch to keep the stroller in its compact folded state.

Adjusting the Reversible Handle

- To reverse the handle, locate the release buttons or levers on both sides of the handlebar.
- Press the buttons/levers and swing the handlebar over the canopy to the opposite side.
- Ensure it locks securely into place in the new position.

Adjusting the Seat Recline

- Locate the recline adjustment mechanism, typically a lever or strap at the back of the seat.
- To recline, squeeze the lever or loosen the strap and gently push the seat back.
- To sit upright, pull the seat forward while adjusting the mechanism until the desired position is achieved.

Using the 5-Point Safety Harness

- Place your child in the seat.
- Bring the shoulder straps over your child's shoulders and the waist straps around their waist.
- Insert the buckle tongues into the buckle housing until they click.
- Adjust the straps to ensure a snug, secure fit without being too tight.
- To release, press the button on the buckle housing.

Brake System

- The brake pedal is located on the rear axle.
- To engage the brakes, press down firmly on the pedal until the stroller stops moving.
- To release the brakes, lift the pedal upwards.
- Always engage the brakes when the stroller is stationary.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Cleaning:** Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Fabric Parts:** Refer to care labels for specific cleaning instructions. Hand wash or spot clean as recommended.
- Wheels:** Regularly check wheels for debris and ensure they rotate freely. Lubricate axles if necessary.
- Frame:** Periodically check all fasteners, rivets, and joints for tightness and security.
- Storage:** Store the stroller in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading and material degradation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stroller does not fold/unfold smoothly.	Folding mechanism is jammed or not fully released.	Ensure all locking latches are disengaged. Check for obstructions.
Wheels squeak or do not turn freely.	Debris in wheel mechanism or lack of lubrication.	Clean wheels and axles. Apply a silicone-based lubricant if needed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Brakes are not engaging or releasing properly.	Debris in brake mechanism or misalignment.	Clear any obstructions. Ensure the brake pedal is fully pressed/lifted.
Handlebar does not reverse.	Release buttons not fully pressed or mechanism obstructed.	Ensure both release buttons are pressed simultaneously and check for obstructions.
