Introduction

Setup and Installation

This keyboard is designed as a replacement part for specific Dream Machines laptop models. Professional installation is recommended due to the intricate nature of laptop component replacement.

- 1. Preparation:** Ensure your laptop is powered off and disconnected from all power sources. Remove

the battery if possible.

2. **Disassembly:** Carefully follow your laptop's service manual or a reputable online guide for disassembling the laptop to access the existing keyboard. This typically involves removing screws, prying open clips, and disconnecting ribbon cables.
3. **Old Keyboard Removal:** Disconnect the ribbon cable(s) connecting the old keyboard to the motherboard. Gently remove the old keyboard from its housing.
4. **New Keyboard Installation:** Position the new keyboard into the laptop's keyboard housing. Ensure it sits flush and all mounting points align.
5. **Cable Connection:** Carefully connect the new keyboard's ribbon cable(s) to the corresponding connectors on the motherboard. Ensure the cables are fully seated and the locking mechanisms (if present) are secured.
6. **Reassembly:** Reassemble your laptop by reversing the disassembly steps. Ensure all screws are tightened appropriately and no components are left loose.
7. **Testing:** Power on your laptop and test all keys, including function keys and the numeric keypad, to ensure proper functionality before fully closing the laptop chassis.

Note: If you have disassembled pictures of your original keyboard or laptop, please compare them with the new product to ensure compatibility before proceeding with installation.

Operating Instructions

The keyboard functions as a standard English US layout keyboard. Below are some common operating features:

- **Standard Typing:** Use the alphanumeric keys for text input.
- **Function Keys (F1-F12):** These keys often have secondary functions (e.g., volume control, brightness adjustment, Wi-Fi toggle) when pressed in combination with the **Fn** key, usually located near the left Ctrl key. Refer to your laptop's specific documentation for detailed Fn key functionalities.
- **Numeric Keypad:** The dedicated numeric keypad on the right provides quick entry for numbers and mathematical operations. Ensure **Num Lock** is enabled for its primary function.
- **Navigation Keys:** Use the arrow keys, Home, End, PgUp, and PgDn for navigation within documents and web pages.

Maintenance and Care

 - Verify your operating system's keyboard language and layout settings. Ensure it is set to "English US".
