- Avoid submerging the speaker in water. The IPX4 rating protects against splashes, not submersion.
- Use only the provided charging cable and power adapter.
- Keep the speaker away from children and pets.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the speaker yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation when operating the speaker.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AKAI PM-160P is a powerful wireless portable party speaker designed for outdoor and indoor use. It features dual 8-inch woofers and a 2-inch tweeter for rich audio, a 5000mAh battery for extended playtime, and multiple connectivity options.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

- 1. Connect the provided charging cable to the speaker's charging port.
- 2. Plug the other end into a suitable power outlet.
- 3. The charging indicator will illuminate. Allow approximately [X hours not specified in data] for a full charge.
- 4. A fully charged battery provides up to 5 hours of playtime at 50% volume.

2. Initial Power On

- · Locate the power button on the speaker.
- Press and hold the power button for a few seconds until the display illuminates and the speaker powers on.

3. Connecting the Wireless Microphone

- Ensure the wireless microphone has fresh batteries (if applicable, the product description states "Rechargeable Wireless Mic").
- Turn on the microphone. It should automatically pair with the speaker.
- Adjust the microphone volume using the dedicated control on the speaker or remote.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Power on the AKAI PM-160P speaker.
- 2. The speaker will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode (indicated by a flashing Bluetooth icon or voice prompt).
- 3. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "AKAI PM-160P" from the list.
- 5. Once paired, the speaker will confirm the connection, and the Bluetooth indicator will become solid.
- 6. The Bluetooth 5.0 technology ensures stable connections up to 10 meters.

2. True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Function

To achieve an immersive stereo sound experience, you can connect two AKAI PM-160P speakers wirelessly:

- 1. Ensure both PM-160P speakers are powered on and not connected to any Bluetooth device.
- 2. On one speaker (this will be the primary speaker), long press the TWS button.
- 3. The speaker will search for another PM-160P speaker.
- 4. Once connected, both speakers will play audio in stereo.
- 5. Connect your mobile device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described above.




Figure 4: TWS Functionality. This diagram illustrates how two AKAI PM-160P speakers can be wirelessly linked to a single mobile device, enabling a True Wireless Stereo sound experience.

3. Using Other Connectivity Options (AUX, USB, TF Card, Guitar Input)

- AUX Input: Connect an external audio device using the provided 3.5mm AUX cable to the AUX port on the speaker. Select AUX mode using the mode button.
- **USB Playback:** Insert a USB flash drive containing MP3 audio files into the USB port. The speaker will automatically detect and play the files.
- TF Card Playback: Insert a TF (microSD) card containing MP3 audio files into the TF card slot. The speaker will automatically detect and play the files.
- Guitar Input: Connect your guitar to the dedicated guitar input port. Adjust the guitar volume as needed.




Figure 5: Multiple Connectivity Options. This image displays icons representing Bluetooth 5.0, Aux, USB, and TF Card inputs, along with a diagram explaining the TWS function, highlighting the speaker's versatile connection capabilities.

4. Karaoke Function

With the included wireless microphone, you can enjoy karaoke:

- Ensure the wireless microphone is connected (see Setup section).
- Play your desired music track through any input source (Bluetooth, USB, AUX).
- Adjust the microphone volume and echo effects using the controls on the speaker or remote for optimal vocal performance.




Figure 6: Karaoke and Guitar Input. This image depicts individuals singing with the wireless microphone and playing a guitar, showcasing the speaker's suitability for karaoke parties and musical performances.

5. Equalizer Settings

Customize your audio experience with multiple equalizer presets. Use the "EQ" button on the speaker or remote control to cycle through available sound modes (e.g., Pop, Rock, Jazz, Classic, Flat).

6. Dynamic LED Lights

The speaker features dynamic multicolor LED lights that enhance the party atmosphere. Use the dedicated light button on the speaker or remote to change light modes or turn them off.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker's exterior. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use for extended periods.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, fully charge the speaker before long-term storage and recharge it every 3-6 months.
- Water Resistance: The IPX4 rating means it is splash-proof. Do not immerse the speaker in water or expose it to heavy rain. Ensure all port covers are securely closed when near water.




Figure 9: IPX4 Splash-Proof Rating. This image highlights the speaker's IPX4 water resistance, indicating protection against light splashes, along with its physical dimensions for reference.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Low battery; Power button not pressed correctly.	Charge the speaker; Press and hold the power button until it turns on.
No sound.	Volume too low; Incorrect input mode; Device not paired.	Increase volume; Select correct input mode; Repair Bluetooth device.
Bluetooth connection unstable.	Device too far; Obstructions; Interference.	Move device closer (within 10m); Remove obstructions; Avoid other wireless devices.
Microphone not working.	Microphone off; Low microphone battery; Volume too low.	Turn on microphone; Charge/replace microphone batteries; Increase microphone volume.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
TWS pairing fails.	Speakers already paired to another device; Incorrect TWS procedure.	Ensure both speakers are unpaired from other devices; Follow TWS pairing steps carefully.
