Split Screen Multitask with ease

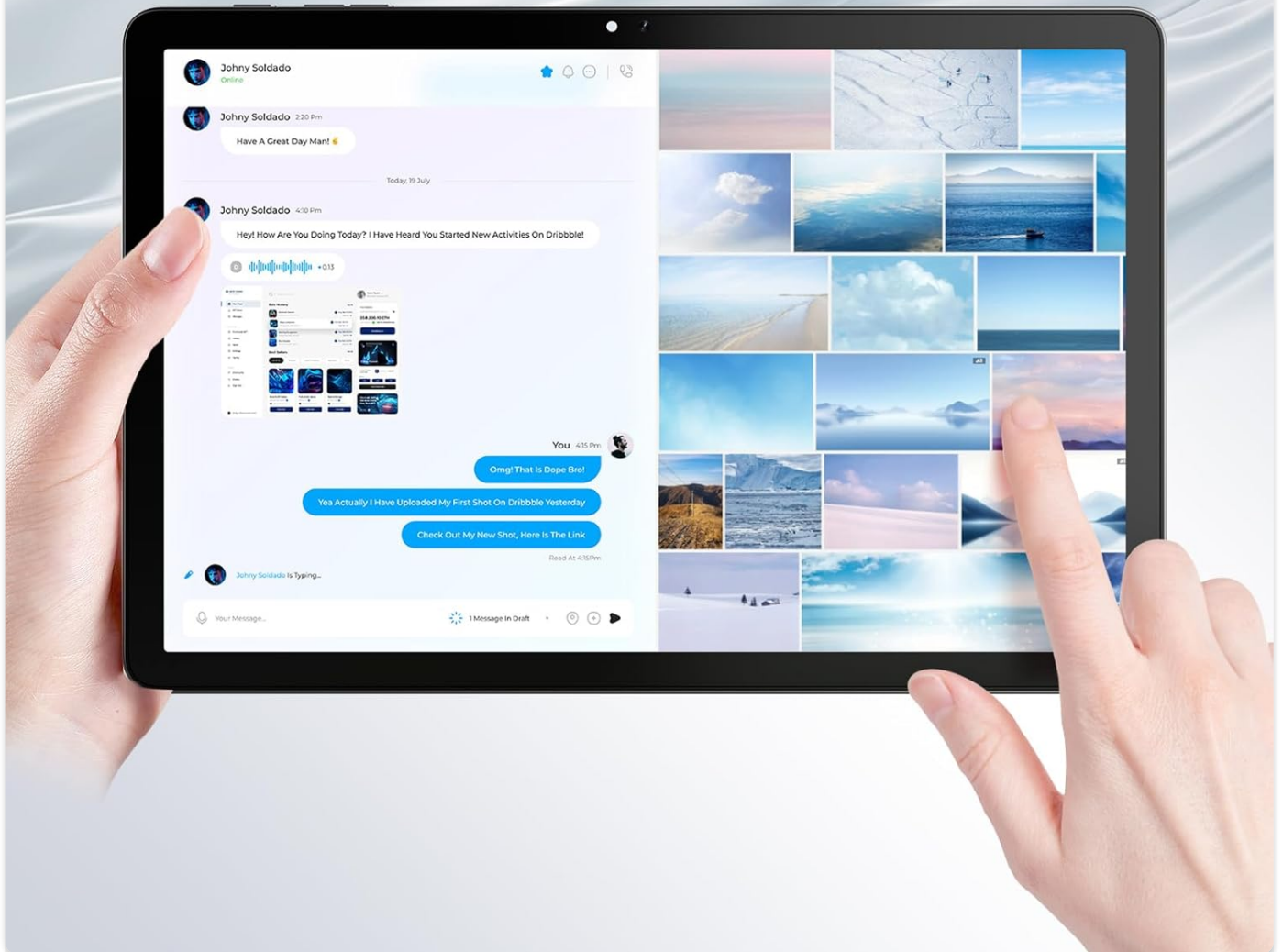


Figure 8: Split-screen multitasking in action.

SETUP

Initial Power On and Setup

1. **Charge the Tablet:** Before first use, fully charge the tablet using the provided USB cable and power adapter. Connect the Type-C end of the cable to the tablet's charging port and the USB end to the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.
2. **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button located on the side of the tablet until the DigiLand logo appears on the screen.
3. **Initial Configuration:** Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup. This typically includes selecting your language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, setting up your Google account, and configuring basic security settings.

4. **Insert TF Card (Optional):** If you wish to expand storage, carefully insert a TF (microSD) card into the designated memory card slot. Ensure the tablet is powered off before inserting or removing the card.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Navigation

- **Touchscreen Gestures:** Navigate the tablet using standard Android gestures: tap to select, swipe to scroll, pinch to zoom, and long-press for contextual menus.
- **Home Screen:** The main interface where you can access apps, widgets, and notifications.
- **Notification Panel:** Swipe down from the top of the screen to access quick settings and notifications.
- **App Drawer:** Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to view all installed applications.

Connecting to Wi-Fi and Bluetooth

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to *Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi* Turn on Wi-Fi, select your desired network, and enter the password if required. The tablet supports ultra-fast WiFi 6.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to *Settings > Connected devices > Connection preferences > Bluetooth* Turn on Bluetooth, then select "Pair new device" to connect to Bluetooth headphones, speakers, or other compatible devices. The tablet features energy-efficient Bluetooth 5.0.

Using Cameras

Access the Camera app from your home screen or app drawer. You can switch between the 8MP front camera and the 13MP rear camera within the app. Tap the screen to focus and press the shutter button to capture photos or start/stop video recording.

Multitasking with Split Screen

To use the split-screen feature, open an application, then swipe up from the bottom of the screen and hold to reveal the recent apps overview. Tap the app icon at the top of the app's card and select "Split screen." Choose a second app from the recent apps or app drawer to open it alongside the first. Adjust the size of each app by dragging the divider in the middle of the screen.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures. It is recommended to keep the battery charge between 20% and 80% for optimal longevity.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install system updates to ensure your tablet has the latest security patches and performance improvements. Go to *Settings > System > System update*
- **Storage Management:** Periodically clear unnecessary files and uninstall unused apps to free up storage space and maintain optimal performance.
- **Protection:** Use the provided leather case to protect your tablet from scratches and minor impacts.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your tablet. If you experience problems not covered here, please contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tablet does not power on.	Low battery; system crash.	Charge the tablet for at least 30 minutes. If still unresponsive, press and hold the power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.
Wi-Fi connection issues.	Incorrect password; out of range; router issue.	Verify Wi-Fi password. Move closer to the router. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network and reconnect.
Apps are slow or crashing.	Too many apps running; low storage; outdated app.	Close background apps. Clear app cache (<i>Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache</i>). Free up storage space. Update the app from Google Play Store.
Screen is unresponsive.	Temporary software glitch.	Force restart the tablet by holding the power button.
Tablet not charging.	Faulty cable/adapter; dirty charging port.	Ensure cable and adapter are securely connected. Try a different compatible cable and adapter. Clean the charging port gently with a dry, soft brush.

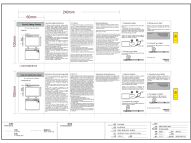
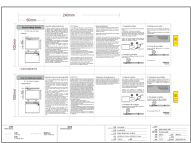
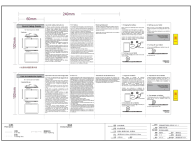

First boot up guide

Boot up guide will help you to select system language, time zone, Wi-Fi network, user name and device information during first boot up.

Button functions

Power button

When device is off, keep pressing power button for 5 sec to turn on the device.

When device is on, short press power button to turn screen on/off.

When device is on, keep pressing power button for 5 sec to access to power off interface. Keep pressing for 10 sec to forcibly power off the device.

Volume+ button (Short press) to increase the volume.

Volume- button (Short press) to decrease the volume.

Virtual button bar

HOME button

click to return to main screen

Back button

click to return to previous screen

Background button

click to view self and other background apps

Home button

click to go to home

Search button

click to view search list of current screen

Volume +

Volume -

increase volume

decrease volume

Pull down notification bar

1. User

click to switch local user accounts

2. Settings

click to access to system settings

3. Battery

click to access to battery settings

Wi-Fi connection

1. Turn on Wi-Fi

2. In "Wi-Fi" menu, click search, select the available network and connect it by entering network password.

Mobile network connection

1. Insert SIM card (not device power on option)

2. Click settings icon to access to settings screen

3. Switch on mobile data toggle

*Above functions are only applicable for the supported devices.

Bluetooth connection

1. Click settings icon to access to Bluetooth menu

2. Switch on Bluetooth and system will automatically search the Bluetooth devices nearby

3. Click on the connectable Bluetooth device then select "connect"

4. Wait for the Bluetooth device to confirm the connection

5. Tap on the menu

*Above functions are only applicable for the supported devices

Screen settings

Click settings to access to "Display" menu

1. Brightness: Scroll the bar to control the screen brightness

2. Wallpaper: set the wallpaper content

3. Sleep: set the screen time-out

4. Font size: set the size of font

5. Auto-rotation: lock the screen direction in 90° device to automatically rotate screen based on the direction

Audio settings

Click settings to access to "Sound" menu

1. Volume: Scroll the bar to adjust the volume of media, alarm and ringtones.

Notification sound: select notification sound

3. Ringtone: select incoming call ringtone

4. Other sounds: Turn on/off screen lock & touch sound effects

HDMI settings

Turn on TV and set the input source to HDMI, connect device to TV via HDMI cable.

1. Mode: adjust the output screen resolution

2. Zoom & scale: zoom in/out and adjust the screen ratio

3. Screen adjustment compensation: Fine tuning the output screen ratio

Battery status

Click settings to access to "Battery" menu, battery usage can be viewed in here.

Power display: switch on/off the toggle to turn on/off power remain percentage display

Connect to PC

Device can be connected with PC via USB cable to perform copy/delete actions.

1. Operating system including Windows 7 and above version will automatically install MTP drivers when device connecting to PC at first time.

2. For Windows XP, Windows Media Player 11 must be installed before connecting device to PC.

Application management

Click "Settings" to access to application menu to perform actions including on-installation, clean default action, clear cache & data and force close application.

1. Third party application: Un-installable

2. System application: cannot be un-install

Users

Click settings icon to access to "Users" menu

1. System supports multi-user login

2. Each user can set to personal applications and contents

Location

1. Click settings icon to access to "Location" menu

2. Click "mode" to select the accuracy

Security

Click settings icon to access to "Security" menu

1. Screen lock mode can select between the setup, Pattern, Pin and password modes

2. Unknown source: to allow/turn the app installation from unknown sources

Language and input

Click settings to access to "Language & input" menu

1. Language: select system language

2. Input: choose the default system input method and its relative settings

Accounts management

Click settings to access to "Accounts" menu

1. Add accounts for installed applications

2. Manage the account data sync

Factory reset

1. Choose "Factory data reset" to restore the system

2. Factory reset will clear all personal data, please do backup before taking the action

Date & time

Click settings to access to "Date & time" menu

1. Select "Automatic date & time" to let system to sync the local time when connecting to internet. You can manually adjust the time by turning off this function.

2. Select "Automatic time zone" to let system to sync the local time zone when connecting to internet. You can manually adjust the time zone by turning off this function.

3. 24-hour format: choose the 12-hour or 24-hour display format
