1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your JYX H1T Sound Bar. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your listening experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3.1 Front Panel and Top Controls

The front panel features a digital display showing current mode, time, and other indicators. The top panel includes essential control buttons.



- **MODE:** Switches between input sources (Bluetooth, USB, AUX, HDMI ARC, Coaxial, FM).
- **Previous Song (<<):** Skips to the previous track (in Bluetooth/USB mode).
- **Play/Pause (► II):** Plays or pauses audio (in Bluetooth/USB mode).
- **Next Song (>>):** Skips to the next track (in Bluetooth/USB mode).
- **Clock:** Sets the time.
- **Alarm:** Sets an alarm.

3.2 Rear Connection Ports

- **HDMI (ARC):** Connects to a TV's HDMI ARC port for audio input.
- **Coaxial:** Connects to a device's coaxial audio output.
- **USB:** For USB drive playback.
- **AUX:** 3.5mm audio input for external devices.
- **AC 220V 50Hz:** Power input.
- **Power Switch:** Turns the soundbar on/off.

4. SETUP

4.1 Placement

Place the soundbar on a stable, flat surface directly in front of your TV or on a desktop. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for proper ventilation.



Image 4.1: The soundbar's dimensions are 40cm (15.7in) length, 9cm (3.54in) depth, and 14.2cm (5.59in) height. It supports Bluetooth, USB, AUX, HDMI (ARC), and Coaxial connections, compatible with phones, tablets, TVs, PCs, and laptops.

4.2 Power Connection

1. Connect the included power cord to the AC 220V 50Hz port on the back of the soundbar.
2. Plug the other end of the power cord into a wall outlet.
3. Flip the Power Switch on the rear panel to the "ON" position. The soundbar will power on.

4.3 Audio Connection (Choose one method)

Select the appropriate connection method based on your TV or audio source.

- **HDMI ARC:**

- a. Connect an HDMI cable (not included) from the HDMI (ARC) port on the soundbar to the HDMI ARC port on your TV.
- b. Ensure your TV's audio output is set to HDMI ARC or external speakers.

- **Coaxial:**

- a. Connect the included coaxial cable from the Coaxial port on the soundbar to the Coaxial audio output port on your TV or device.
- b. Ensure your TV's audio output is set to Coaxial.

- **AUX (3.5mm Audio):**

- a. Connect the included 3.5mm audio cable from the AUX port on the soundbar to the 3.5mm audio output (headphone jack) on your TV, PC, or other audio device.

- **Bluetooth:**

- a. Power on the soundbar and switch to Bluetooth mode using the MODE button on the soundbar or remote. The display will show "BT".
- b. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and search for "JYX H1T".
- c. Select "JYX H1T" to pair. Once connected, the soundbar will indicate successful pairing.

- **USB:**

- a. Insert a USB flash drive containing MP3 audio files into the USB port on the rear of the soundbar.
- b. Switch to USB mode using the MODE button on the soundbar or remote. The soundbar will automatically begin playing audio from the USB drive.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Use the power switch on the rear or the power button on the remote control.
- **Volume Control:** Use the Volume Up (+) and Volume Down (-) buttons on the soundbar or remote.
- **Input Mode Selection:** Press the MODE button on the soundbar or remote to cycle through input sources (BT, USB, AUX, HDMI ARC, COAX, FM).
- **Treble/Bass Adjustment:** Use the dedicated Treble and Bass buttons on the remote control to fine-tune audio output.

5.2 Wireless Microphones

The JYX H1T Sound Bar includes two wireless microphones for karaoke functionality.

1. **Powering On:** Insert batteries (not included) into each microphone. Press and hold the power button on each microphone to turn them on.
2. **Automatic Pairing:** The microphones will automatically pair with the soundbar when both are powered on.
3. **Microphone Volume:** Use the volume controls on the microphones themselves to adjust their individual volume levels.
4. **Anti-slip Rings:** Place the included anti-slip rings on the microphones to prevent them from rolling and provide extra grip.

5.3 Remote Control Functions

The full-function remote control allows for convenient operation from a distance.

- **Power:** Turns the soundbar on or off.
- **Mute:** Mutes or unmutes the sound.
- **Input Source Buttons:** Direct access to BT, USB, AUX, HDMI, COAX, FM modes.
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts master volume.
- **Treble +/-:** Adjusts treble levels.
- **Bass +/-:** Adjusts bass levels.
- **EQ Modes:** Cycles through preset equalizer settings (e.g., Music, Movie, News).
- **Play/Pause, Previous/Next:** Controls media playback in Bluetooth and USB modes.
- **Clock/Alarm:** For setting time and alarms.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surface of the soundbar. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- **Storage:** If storing the soundbar for an extended period, disconnect it from power and store it in a cool, dry place.
- **Microphone Care:** Remove batteries from microphones if they will not be used for a long time to prevent leakage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; Power switch off; Wall outlet not working.	Ensure power cord is securely connected. Turn on the power switch. Test the outlet with another device.
No sound	Incorrect input mode; Volume too low; Cables not connected properly; TV audio output settings incorrect.	Select the correct input mode. Increase volume. Check all audio cable connections. Adjust TV audio output to external speakers or the correct digital output.
Bluetooth pairing failed	Soundbar not in BT mode; Device too far; Interference.	Ensure soundbar is in BT mode. Move device closer. Avoid sources of interference.
Microphones not working	Microphones not powered on; Batteries low/dead; Not paired.	Ensure microphones are powered on. Replace batteries. Microphones should pair automatically; if not, power cycle both the soundbar and microphones.
Remote control not working	Batteries low/dead; Obstruction; Remote not pointed at sensor.	Replace remote batteries. Remove any obstructions. Point the remote directly at the soundbar's sensor.


