PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND CONTROLS

Familiarize yourself with the speaker's physical features and control buttons.

Control Functions:

- **Power Button ()**: Press and hold to turn the speaker on or off. Short press to switch between input modes (Bluetooth, AUX, TF Card).
- **Play/Pause Button (►)**: Press to play or pause audio. During a call, press to answer or end a call. Press and hold to reject an incoming call.
- **Volume Down / Previous Track Button (◀◀)**: Short press to decrease volume. Press and hold to go to the previous track.
- **Volume Up / Next Track Button (▶▶)**: Short press to increase volume. Press and hold to go to the next track.

Input Ports:

- **USB-C Port**: For charging the speaker.
- **AUX-IN Port**: For wired audio connection using the provided 3.5mm AUX cable.
- **TF Card Slot**: For playing audio directly from a MicroSD/TF card.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the speaker's USB-C port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The charging indicator light will show the charging status.

2. Powering On/Off

Press and hold the Power button () for approximately 3 seconds to turn the speaker on or off. A sound prompt will indicate the power status.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

The Monster S290 speaker features Bluetooth 6.0 for stable and efficient wireless connection.

1. Turn on the speaker. It will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode, indicated by a flashing LED light.
2. Enable Bluetooth on your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop).
3. Search for "Monster S290" in the list of available Bluetooth devices.
4. Select "Monster S290" to connect. Once connected, the LED light will become solid, and a sound prompt will confirm the connection.

4. TWS (True Wireless Stereo) Pairing

For an enhanced stereo experience, you can pair two Monster S290 speakers together.

TWS CONNECTIVITY

Pair 2 Monster portable speakers to get 60W powerful stereo surround sound.

1. Ensure both Monster S290 speakers are powered on and not connected to any other Bluetooth device.
2. On one speaker (this will be the primary speaker), press and hold the Play/Pause button for 3 seconds until you hear a prompt indicating TWS pairing mode.
3. The two speakers will automatically search for and connect to each other. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation sound.
4. Now, connect your device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described in step 3. Audio will play through both speakers in stereo.

5. Connecting via AUX/TF Card

The speaker supports multiple input options for versatility.

- **AUX-IN:** Connect one end of the 3.5mm AUX cable to your audio device's headphone jack and the other end to the speaker's AUX-IN port. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode, or you can manually switch using the Power button.
- **TF Card:** Insert a MicroSD/TF card (up to 32GB, FAT32 format) with audio files into the TF card slot. The speaker will automatically switch to TF card mode and begin playback, or you can manually switch using the Power button.

OPERATING

Basic Audio Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Play/Pause button.
- **Volume Adjustment:** Short press the Volume Up (▶▶) or Volume Down (◀◀) buttons.
- **Next/Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up (▶▶) for next track or Volume Down (◀◀) for previous track.

Hands-Free Calling

When connected via Bluetooth to a smartphone, the speaker can be used for hands-free calls.

- **Answer Call:** Press the Play/Pause button once.
- **End Call:** Press the Play/Pause button once during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Play/Pause button for 2 seconds.

Mode Switching

Short press the Power button () to cycle through available input modes: Bluetooth, AUX, and TF Card.

MAINTENANCE

IPX6 Waterproof Rating

The Monster S290 speaker is IPX6 waterproof, meaning it is protected against high-pressure water jets from any direction. This makes it suitable for outdoor use and resistant to splashes, rain, and spills. **Do not submerge the speaker in water.** Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed before exposing the speaker to water.

IPX6 WATERPROOF

Keep listening without worrying about water splashes.

Cleaning

Wipe the speaker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the surface or internal components.

Storage

Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to approximately 50% every few months to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not turn on	Low battery	Charge the speaker using the USB-C cable.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot pair via Bluetooth	Speaker not in pairing mode; Device Bluetooth off; Speaker already connected to another device	Ensure speaker is in pairing mode (flashing LED). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Disconnect from other devices. Try restarting both speaker and device.
No sound	Volume too low; Incorrect input mode; Device not playing audio	Increase speaker and device volume. Press Power button to cycle through modes (Bluetooth, AUX, TF Card). Ensure audio is playing on your connected device.
Poor sound quality/distortion	Speaker too far from device; Obstructions; Low battery	Move speaker closer to the device. Remove obstructions. Charge the speaker.
TWS pairing fails	Speakers too far apart; One speaker already connected to a device	Ensure both speakers are close to each other. Disconnect both speakers from any other Bluetooth devices before initiating TWS pairing.
