INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and effective use of your Purra Run Bone Conduction Sport Headphones. These open-ear Bluetooth headphones are designed for active lifestyles, featuring IP67 waterproofing, deep bass, and voice control for various activities such as running, cycling, and general workouts. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- Mojawa Purra Run Bone Conduction Headphones
- User Manual (this document)
- Protective Case
- Charging Cable

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Connect the provided charging cable to the charging port on the

headphones and a compatible USB power source. The LED indicator will show charging status. A full charge provides approximately 15 hours of playback at 50% volume. A quick 5-minute charge can provide up to 2.5 hours of playback.

15-Hour All-Day Battery Life

Quick charge for 5 minutes = 2.5 hours of listening

2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the Multi-function Button until the LED indicator flashes red and blue, indicating pairing mode.

3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Purra Run" from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will turn solid blue.

The Purra Run headphones support Bluetooth 5.3 for stable connectivity and can be paired with two devices simultaneously for effortless multitasking.




Image: Illustration showing the Purra Run headphones wirelessly connected to both a smartphone and a tablet, demonstrating dual device switching capability.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Multi-function Button for 2 seconds.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Multi-function Button for 3 seconds.

2. Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function Button once.
- **Next Track:** Double-press the Multi-function Button.
- **Previous Track:** Triple-press the Multi-function Button.
- **Volume Up:** Press the Volume Up button.
- **Volume Down:** Press the Volume Down button.

3. Call Management

The headphones feature Pro ENC AI Noise Cancellation for clear calls, even in noisy environments.

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function Button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function Button for 2 seconds.



4. AI Voice Control

Activate voice control by saying "Hi Purra" or "Hi Mojawa". You can then issue commands such as playing music or switching EQ modes.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

Wipe the headphones with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. Ensure the charging

port is dry before charging.

2. Water Resistance

The Purra Run headphones are IP67 rated, meaning they are protected against dust and can withstand immersion in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes. They are sweatproof and suitable for use in rain, but not recommended for swimming or prolonged submersion.

3. Storage

Store the headphones in the provided protective case when not in use to prevent damage. Avoid extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure the headphones are fully charged.
- **Cannot Pair:** Ensure the headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red and blue LED). Turn off and on your device's Bluetooth, then try pairing again.
- **No Sound:** Check the volume level on both the headphones and your connected device. Ensure the headphones are properly connected via Bluetooth.
- **Poor Sound Quality:** Ensure there are no obstructions between the headphones and your device. Move closer to your device.
- **Voice Control Not Responding:** Ensure you are saying the activation phrase "Hi Purra" or "Hi Mojawa" clearly.
