1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Hawkrown H05 Bathroom Exhaust Fan. This unit integrates a powerful exhaust fan with a humidity sensor, odor sensor, 3CCT LED light, 7 LED color options, and remote control functionality. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure safe and efficient operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always disconnect power at the circuit breaker before installing, servicing, or cleaning the unit.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician in accordance with all local and national electrical codes.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including gloves and eye protection, during installation.
- Ensure the unit is properly grounded to prevent electrical shock.
- Do not use this fan in areas where it may be exposed to water spray from a shower or bathtub unless specifically rated for such use.
- Keep children and pets away from the installation area.
- Do not insert fingers or foreign objects into the fan grille.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Standby: (Purification auto-starts when standby turn on)

Power On/Off

Remote Control Pairing Instructions (Remote control will only function properly after successful pairing): In 30s after powering on, long press the standby button for 3s. A long "Beep" indicates successful pairing.



Ventilator

Turn the ventilation on or off.



+/-

Long Press: Adjust brightness.



Purification


Short press: Turn purification mode ON/OFF

Long press : Cycle through humidity levels 30%→60%→80%



Lamp

Short press: Turn the lamp on/off. Long press: Customize the color temperature





Timer

Short Press: Turn Timer ON/OFF Long press: Cycle through 0H→1H→...→4H



RGB Lighting

Short Press: Turn RGB modes ON/OFF Long press: Switch between 3 RGB modes

5.1. Preparation

- Ensure power is off at the circuit breaker.
- Gather all necessary tools: measuring tape, utility knife, screwdriver, power drill, safety gloves, and eye protection.
- Unpack all components and verify against the package contents list.

5.2. Ceiling Opening

- Measure and cut an 11.22 x 11.22 inch hole in the ceiling. Use a ruler to ensure accuracy.
- Ensure there is at least 11 inches of roof-to-ceiling clearance for proper installation.

5.3. Ductwork Connection

- Slip the metal hoop over the flexible ventilation pipe.
- Expand the ventilation pipe and align it with the air outlet of the main unit, then slip it over the outlet.
- Tighten the metal hoop with power tools to secure the connection.
- For additional security, fix the air duct with adhesive tape and then use cable ties or hoops for fixation.

5.4. Electrical Wiring

- · Always unplug the power before connecting terminals.
- Connect the wires: Green to green (Ground), White to white (Neutral), Black to black (Live).

- The socket wire is a power cord and cannot be used as a control wire. Control is handled by the remote.
- The intermediate terminal block can be used as an intermediate medium. Pull it gently to ensure it is fully secured.

5.5. Mounting the Unit

- Insert one side of the ventilation pipe into the ceiling first. Insert it diagonally from the side.
- Push the air duct into the pre-reserved ventilation pipeline at home and wind it with adhesive tape to make sure there is no air leakage.
- Position the main unit correctly, connect the corresponding motherboard cables, press the spring clips on both sides, and sequentially press them into the pre-reserved spring slots of the main unit.
- If installing directly on attic or frame wooden beams, use long self-tapping screws and washers at the installation auxiliary feet. Install the four holes in sequence to ensure stable installation.
- Organize the cables, and the installation is complete.

5.6. Remote Control Pairing

- After powering on the unit, within 30 seconds, long-press the standby button (power button) on the remote for 3 seconds.
- A long "Beep" sound indicates successful pairing. If unsuccessful, unplug and retry.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Hawkrown H05 is controlled via the included wireless remote. The remote has a maximum range of 19 ft, with an ideal working distance within 6 ft.

6.1. Power On/Off

• Press the **Power On/Off** button to turn the unit on or off.

6.2. Ventilation (Fan) Control

- Press the Ventilator button to turn the fan on or off.
- The fan operates at 230 CFM with a quiet 1.0 Sone noise level.

6.3. Humidity and Odor Sensing (Purification)

- Short Press Purification Button: Turns purification mode (humidity/odor sensing) ON/OFF.
- Long Press Purification Button (≥2s): Cycles through humidity levels 30% → 60% → 80%.
- When the bathroom humidity reaches the selected level, the fan automatically turns on.
- The fan also automatically starts ventilation when unpleasant odors are detected.
- A green indicator light on the panel provides real-time feedback on the system's working status.
- Note: Ventilation and purification are two independent modes that cannot be activated simultaneously; only
 one can be switched on at a time.

6.4. Lighting Control

- Short Press Lamp Button: Turns the main LED lamp on/off.
- Long Press Lamp Button: Customizes the color temperature (3000K Warm, 4500K Natural, 6500K Cool).
- +/- Buttons (Long Press): Adjusts brightness (stepless dimming).
- The unit also features a nightlight mode (200lm).

6.5. RGB Lighting Control

- Short Press RGB Button: Turns RGB modes ON/OFF.
- Long Press RGB Button: Switches between 3 RGB dynamic lighting modes (Aurora, Breathing, Blinking) and 7 static LED colors.

6.6. Timer Function

- Short Press Timer Button: Turns the timer ON/OFF.
- Long Press Timer Button: Cycles through automatic shutoff times from 1 to 4 hours in 1-hour increments.
 This helps save energy.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your exhaust fan.

- Cleaning the Grille and Light Panel: Periodically wipe the exterior grille and light panel with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Cleaning the Fan Blades: If accessible, gently clean the fan blades with a soft brush or cloth to remove dust and debris. Ensure power is disconnected before attempting this.
- **Ductwork Inspection:** Annually inspect the ductwork for any blockages, kinks, or disconnections that could impede airflow.
- **Electrical Connections:** Periodically check electrical connections for tightness and signs of wear. Ensure power is disconnected before inspection.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the following common issues and solutions:

· Unit does not power on:

- Ensure all connectors are securely reattached. Match wire colors: Green to green, white to white, black to black.
- Replug the power cord.
- Check the circuit breaker for tripped circuits.

Fan not working:

- Check if the fan is in purification (auto) mode. It only activates when indoor humidity reaches the preset level (30%/60%/80%) or when odors are detected.
- In manual mode, press the ventilator button to turn ventilation on/off.

• Remote control is paired but not working:

- Try pressing the standby button first, then long-press any function button.
- Ensure the remote has fresh batteries.

• Insufficient airflow:

- Check for obstructions in the ductwork or fan grille.
- Ensure the ductwork is properly sealed and free of leaks.
