1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Defy DAF3376DBS Stainless Steel Air Fryer. This appliance is designed to provide a convenient and efficient way to cook a variety of foods with less oil. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation. Keep this manual for future reference.

Important Safety Information

- Always place the air fryer on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls and other appliances to allow for proper ventilation.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Supervise children when the appliance is in use.
- Do not operate the appliance if the plug, power cord, or the appliance itself is damaged.
- Unplug the air fryer from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow it to cool down completely before handling.
- Do not block the air inlet or outlet vents during operation.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Defy DAF3376DBS Air Fryer features a sleek stainless steel design with a digital touch control panel for easy operation. It has a generous 7.6-liter capacity, suitable for family-sized meals.

Key Components:

- **Digital Touch Control Panel:** For selecting cooking functions, adjusting temperature, and setting timers.
- Air Fryer Basket: Removable, non-stick, and dishwasher-safe for easy cleaning.
- Handle: Ergonomically designed for safe removal of the hot basket.
- Air Inlet and Outlet Vents: Essential for proper air circulation during cooking.

3. SETUP

Before using your Defy Air Fryer for the first time, follow these steps:

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials, stickers, and labels from the appliance.
- 2. **Initial Cleaning:** Wash the air fryer basket and fry pan thoroughly with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse and dry completely. Wipe the interior and exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is at least 10 cm (4 inches) of free space around the back and sides of the appliance, and above it, for adequate air circulation.
- 4. Power Connection: Plug the power cord into a grounded wall outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Defy DAF3376DBS Air Fryer offers intuitive digital controls and pre-programmed functions for various cooking needs.

Basic Operation:

- 1. **Preparation:** Place ingredients into the air fryer basket. Do not overfill the basket to ensure even cooking.
- 2. **Power On:** Plug in the appliance. The power indicator will light up. Press the power button on the digital control panel to turn on the display.
- 3. **Temperature and Time Setting:** Use the temperature and timer controls to set your desired cooking temperature and time. The temperature range is typically from 80°C to 200°C (175°F to 400°F), and the timer can be set up to 60 minutes.
- 4. **Start Cooking:** Press the start/pause button to begin the cooking cycle. The air fryer will automatically preheat and then start cooking.
- 5. Shaking Ingredients: For some recipes, it is recommended to shake the basket halfway

- through the cooking time to ensure even browning. Carefully pull out the basket, shake the contents, and reinsert it. The air fryer will resume cooking automatically.
- 6. **Completion:** Once the timer reaches zero, the air fryer will beep, indicating that cooking is complete. Carefully remove the basket and transfer the food to a serving dish.

The Defy DAF3376DBS features 13 pre-set menus for common dishes, simplifying the cooking process. Simply select the desired icon on the control panel, and the air fryer will automatically set the optimal temperature and time.




Figure 4.2: The digital control panel displaying the 13 pre-set menu options for various food types.




Figure 4.3: An example of a whole chicken and potatoes being cooked within the air fryer basket, demonstrating its capacity.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Defy Air Fryer.

- 1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the air fryer and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.
- Cleaning the Basket and Fry Pan: The non-stick air fryer basket and fry pan are
 dishwasher-safe. Alternatively, wash them with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive
 sponge. Avoid using metal utensils or abrasive cleaning materials that can damage the nonstick coating.
- 3. **Cleaning the Interior:** Wipe the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth. For stubborn food residue, use a mild detergent and a soft brush. Ensure the interior is completely dry before next use.
- 4. **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scourers.
- 5. **Storage:** Once clean and dry, store the air fryer in a cool, dry place.




Figure 5.1: The air fryer with its non-stick coated single basket and fry pan removed, illustrating ease of cleaning.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Defy Air Fryer, consult the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; appliance fault.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the circuit breaker. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Food is not cooked evenly.	Basket overloaded; food not shaken; incorrect temperature/time.	Do not overload the basket. Shake ingredients halfway through cooking. Adjust temperature and time as per recipe recommendations.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
White smoke coming from the appliance.	Grease residue from previous use; high-fat food.	Clean the basket and interior thoroughly after each use. For high-fat foods, drain excess fat from the basket during cooking.	
Food is not crispy.	Basket overloaded; insufficient oil (for some foods); incorrect temperature/time.	Cook in smaller batches. Lightly brush or spray food with oil. Increase cooking time or temperature slightly.
