Using a flat tool, such as a plastic card or a trowel, smooth the applied filler so it is flush with the surrounding concrete, masonry, or asphalt surface. This helps create a seamless appearance.

MAINTENANCE

- **Reapplication:** If new cracks appear or existing repairs show signs of degradation due to extreme conditions or heavy traffic, reapply the product following the application instructions.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the repaired surface as you would the rest of your concrete, masonry, or asphalt. Avoid harsh chemicals that could degrade the filler.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Filler does not blend seamlessly with surface.	Color variation between filler and existing surface; insufficient smoothing.	The filler is gray. For a perfect color match, consider staining the entire surface after curing. Ensure thorough smoothing during application.
Filler washes out or does not hold.	Crack was not clean or dry; insufficient water application during curing; heavy rain before curing.	Ensure the crack is completely clean and dry before application. Follow the watering instructions precisely (every 15 minutes for 1 hour). Protect the area from heavy rain during the initial curing period.
Filler appears uneven or lumpy.	Inadequate smoothing after application.	Ensure a flat tool is used to firmly smooth the filler flush with the surface immediately after pouring.
