5. SETUP

5.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the flashlight. Open the USB-C port cover and connect the included USB-C cable to the flashlight and a power source (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter).

- The charging indicator will glow **red** during charging.
- The indicator will turn **green** when charging is complete.

USB-C RECHARGEABLE

5.2 Attaching Accessories

The flashlight comes with a keychain ring and a two-way pocket clip for various carrying options.

- **Keychain:** Attach the included keychain ring to the designated loop at the tail of the flashlight.
- **Pocket Clip:** The two-way clip can be used to secure the flashlight to a pocket, belt, or the brim of a hat. It can be reversed for different carrying preferences.

PERFECT EDC COMPANION

Clip it to your keychain or pocket using the included keyring and clip.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Basic Operation

- **Turn On/Off:** Double-click the side switch to turn the light ON. Press and hold the switch to turn it OFF.
- **Change Modes:** When the light is ON, single-click the switch to cycle through Firefly, Low, Medium, and High modes. The light will remember the last used mode (except Strobe).
- **Momentary High:** From OFF, press and hold the switch to activate the highest mode (650 lumens) temporarily. Release the switch to turn OFF.
- **Strobe Mode:** Triple-click the switch from any state (ON or OFF) to activate Strobe mode. Single-click to return to the previously used mode.

6.3 Hands-Free Operation

The magnetic tailcap allows the flashlight to be securely attached to most metal surfaces, providing convenient hands-free illumination. This is ideal for tasks requiring both hands, such as vehicle maintenance or working in dimly lit areas.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly clean the flashlight body with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **USB-C Port:** Ensure the USB-C charging port cover is properly sealed when not charging to maintain its waterproof rating. If the cover is damaged or lost, use the provided spare.
- **Storage:** Store the flashlight in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

8.1 Light Not Turning On

- **Battery Charge:** Ensure the battery is sufficiently charged. Connect the flashlight to a USB-C power source and check the charging indicator.
- **Operation Sequence:** Confirm you are using the correct operation sequence: double-click to turn ON, press and hold to turn OFF.

8.2 Charging Issues

- **Cable Connection:** Verify the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the flashlight and the power source.
- **Port Condition:** Check the USB-C port for any debris or damage. Clean gently if necessary.
- **Power Source:** Try a different USB power source or cable to rule out issues with the charging equipment.
