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› Merax Metal Queen Size Canopy Bed Instruction Manual

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Model: Metal Queen Size Canopy Bed

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before beginning assembly. Do not use if any parts are missing or broken.
- Assemble the bed on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Tighten all fasteners securely, but do not overtighten. Periodically check and retighten fasteners as needed.
- Do not allow children to climb on the bed frame during assembly or use.
- This bed frame is designed for use with a box spring and mattress. Refer to the specifications for recommended mattress and box spring height.
- Maximum weight recommendation for this bed frame is 800 pounds. Do not exceed this limit.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components listed below are included in your package. If any parts are missing, please contact customer support.

- Headboard (Linen Upholstered)
- Canopy Frame Posts (4)
- Side Rails
- Cross Bars/Slats Support
- Center Support Legs
- Hardware Pack (bolts, washers, nuts, Allen wrench)
- Assembly Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps for proper assembly of your Merax Metal Queen Size Canopy Bed. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface. Refer to the included parts list and diagrams to identify each piece.
2. **Attach Headboard to Side Rails:** Connect the upholstered headboard to the side rails using the provided hardware. Ensure the connections are secure.
3. **Attach Footboard to Side Rails:** Connect the footboard to the other end of the side rails.
4. **Install Center Support:** Place the center support bar(s) and legs into position and secure them to the frame.
5. **Place Slats:** Position the bed slats across the frame. Secure them if the design requires it.
6. **Assemble Canopy Posts:** Attach the four canopy posts to the corners of the bed frame. Then, connect the top canopy bars to complete the canopy structure.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all parts are assembled, go back and ensure all bolts and screws are firmly tightened. Do not overtighten.

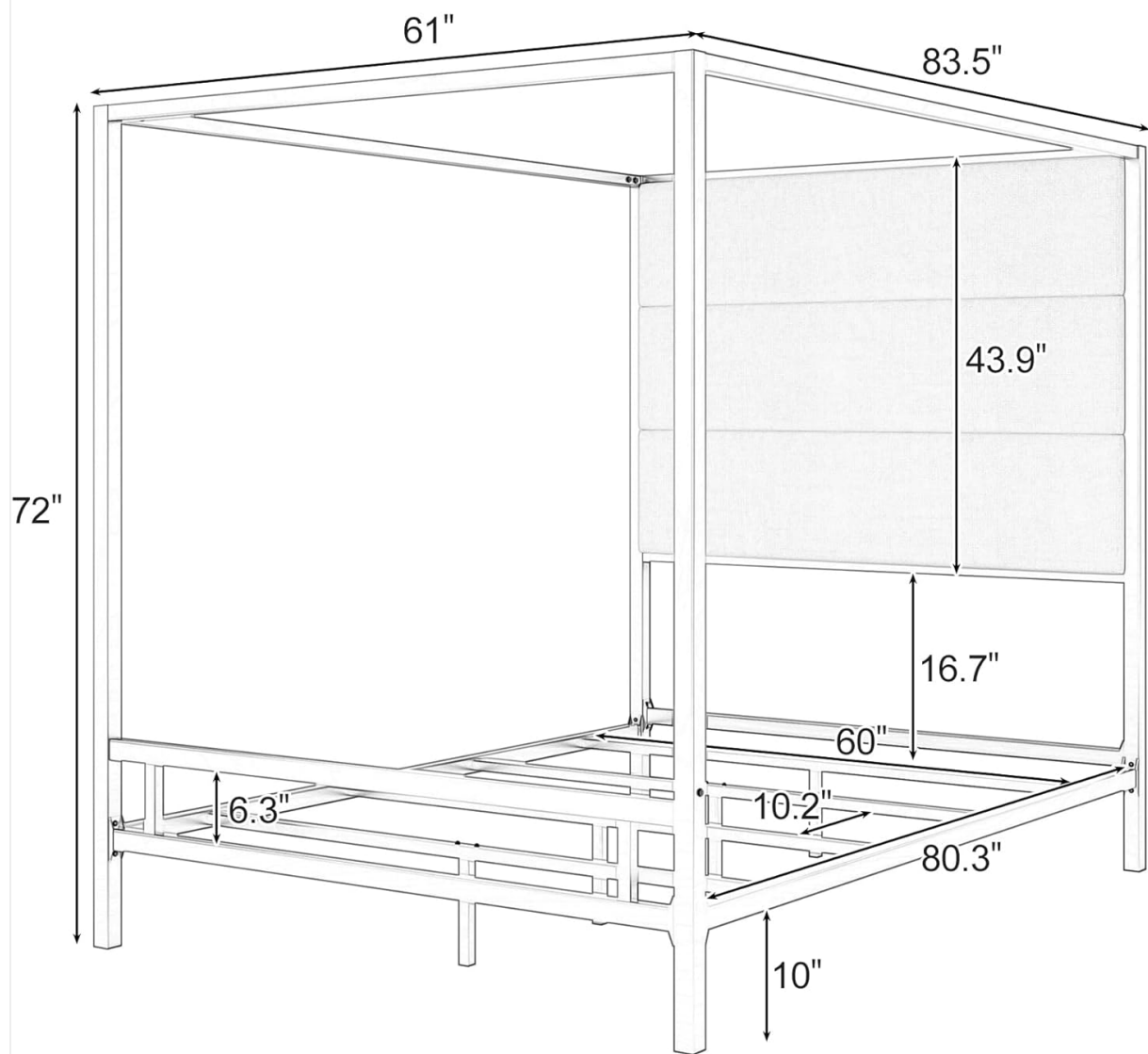


Image: Detailed dimension diagram for the Queen size canopy bed, showing length, width, and height measurements.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This Merax canopy bed is designed for standard use as a sleeping surface. No complex operation is required.

- Place your box spring and mattress on the assembled bed frame.
- Ensure the combined height of your mattress and box spring is approximately 17 inches for optimal aesthetic and comfort.
- The canopy frame can be used to hang lightweight decorative fabrics or curtains, but avoid hanging heavy objects that could compromise stability.
- Do not jump on the bed or subject it to excessive force, as this may damage the frame.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your bed frame.

- **Cleaning Metal Parts:** Wipe metal surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.

- **Cleaning Upholstered Headboard:** For the linen upholstered headboard, spot clean with a mild fabric cleaner as needed. Test on an inconspicuous area first. Do not saturate the fabric.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically (every 3-6 months) check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to prevent wobbling or squeaking.
- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight may cause the upholstered fabric to fade over time.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bed frame, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Wobbling or Instability:** Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Check that the bed is on a level surface.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking often indicates loose connections. Retighten all fasteners. Applying a small amount of lubricant (e.g., silicone spray) to metal-on-metal contact points can also help.
- **Missing Parts:** If you find parts missing during assembly, do not proceed. Contact Merax customer support immediately for assistance.
- **Damaged Parts:** If any part is damaged, do not attempt to assemble or use the bed. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
