PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ORTLIEB Ultimate 6 Black Reflex Handlebar Bag is designed for bike touring, offering a compact and secure storage solution for your essentials. Its durable, waterproof, and dustproof construction ensures your belongings remain protected in various weather conditions. The bag features a transparent flap for easy access to smartphones or GPS devices, and a robust mounting system for secure attachment to your bike's handlebars.

KEY FEATURES

- Waterproof and Dustproof Material: Ensures contents remain dry and clean.
- Transparent Flap: Allows for smartphone or GPS map viewing and operation without removal.
- Secure Mounting System: Attaches firmly to handlebars with a dedicated bracket.
- Reflective Elements: Enhances visibility for increased safety during low-light conditions.
- Internal Storage: Roomy interior with a zippered pouch for organizing smaller items.
- Removable Design: Easily detaches from the bike for convenient carrying.
- Integrated Lock: Allows the bag to be locked to the bike for added security.
- Carrying Straps: Attachment points for optional carrying straps (sold separately).

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Attaching the Mounting Bracket

The handlebar bag requires a compatible ORTLIEB mounting bracket (sold separately) to be installed on your bicycle's handlebars. Follow the instructions provided with your specific bracket for proper installation. Ensure the bracket is securely fastened and stable before attaching the bag.

2. Attaching the Handlebar Bag

- 1. Align the bag's rear attachment point with the installed handlebar bracket.
- 2. Push the bag firmly onto the bracket until it clicks securely into place.
- 3. Verify that the bag is firmly attached by gently pulling on it. It should not wobble or detach easily.

3. Using the Integrated Lock (Optional)

For added security, the bag features an integrated key lock. Insert the key into the lock mechanism located on the side of the bag and turn to secure it to the handlebar bracket. Remember to remove the key and keep it with you.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Opening and Closing the Bag

To open the bag, release the top flap by disengaging the magnetic closure system. The flap will lift to reveal the main compartment. To close, simply lower the flap and ensure the magnetic closure engages firmly.

2. Utilizing the Transparent Flap

The transparent flap allows you to place a smartphone or GPS device inside for easy viewing and operation while riding. Ensure your device is securely placed within the transparent pocket to prevent movement during transit.

3. Detaching and Carrying the Bag

To detach the bag from the handlebar bracket, unlock it if the lock is engaged. Then, press the release mechanism on the bracket (if applicable) and slide the bag upwards or forwards to remove it. The bag can be carried using its integrated handle or by attaching optional carrying straps to the designated loops.

Maintenance and Care

- Cleaning: Wipe the bag with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Drying: Allow the bag to air dry completely before storing to prevent mildew.
- Storage: Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the mounting bracket and bag for any signs of wear or damage. Replace components as needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bag not attaching securely to bracket.	Incorrect alignment; debris in mechanism; damaged bracket/bag attachment.	Ensure proper alignment. Clean any debris. Inspect for damage and replace if necessary.
Water inside the bag.	Flap not properly closed; material damage.	Ensure flap is fully closed and magnetic closure is engaged. Inspect material for tears or punctures.
Difficulty operating transparent flap with device inside.	Device too thick; screen protector interference.	Ensure device fits within the designated area. Some screen protectors may reduce touch sensitivity.




Figure 4: Diagram illustrating the ORTLIEB Handlebar Bag mounted on a bicycle, confirming compatibility with bicycles featuring 28-inch wheels.


