INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Acer Aspire 3 Laptop (Model A325-42). Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the performance and lifespan of your device.

The Acer Aspire 3 features an AMD Ryzen 7 7730U 8-Core Processor, AMD Radeon Graphics, a 15.6-inch Full HD display, 32GB DDR4 RAM, and a 4TB NVMe SSD, running on Windows 10 Pro. It is designed for efficient performance and versatile use.

SETUP

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the following items are present:

- Acer Aspire 3 Laptop
- 65W AC Adapter
- 1 x 32GB USB Drive

Inspect the laptop for any physical damage. If any damage is found, contact your retailer immediately.

2. Connecting the Power Adapter

Connect the 65W AC adapter to the laptop's power input port and then plug it into a power outlet. It is recommended to fully charge the battery before initial use.

3. Initial Power On and Windows Setup

Press the power button to turn on the laptop. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 10 Pro setup process. This includes selecting your region, language, creating a user account, and connecting to a Wi-Fi network.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Your Laptop

- For the keyboard and chassis, use a slightly damp cloth. Ensure no liquid enters the device.
- Regularly clean the ventilation openings to prevent dust buildup, which can affect performance.

2. Software Updates

Keep your Windows 10 Pro operating system and drivers updated to ensure optimal performance and security. Check for updates regularly through Windows Update.

3. Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures and do not leave the laptop plugged in at 100% charge for extended periods. For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50-60%.

4. Storage Management

Periodically review and delete unnecessary files to maintain sufficient free space on your 4TB SSD, which contributes to system performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Acer Aspire 3 laptop, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **Display Issues:** If the screen is blank, try connecting an external monitor to check if the issue is with the laptop's display or graphics card. Adjust brightness settings.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity:** Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows settings. Restart your router and the laptop. Ensure drivers are updated.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check for malware. Ensure sufficient free storage space and update your operating system.
- **Peripheral Not Detected:** Try connecting the peripheral to a different USB port. Ensure drivers for the peripheral are installed.
