1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your LG 65-Inch NANO80 4K Smart TV (Model: 65NANO80AUA). Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this television to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury. Keep this manual handy for quick reference.

- Power Source: Connect the TV to an AC 120V, 60Hz power outlet. Do not overload power outlets.
- Ventilation: Ensure proper ventilation around the TV. Do not block ventilation openings.
- Water and Moisture: Do not expose the TV to rain or moisture. Do not place objects filled with liquids on the TV.
- Cleaning: Unplug the TV before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth. Avoid liquid cleaners.
- Placement: Place the TV on a stable, level surface or mount it securely to a wall. Keep out of reach of children.
- **Servicing:** Do not attempt to service this product yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the TV and all accessories from the packaging. Retain the packaging for future transport or service needs.

3.2 Stand Assembly (Table Mount)

If using the included stand for table mounting:

- 1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent damage.
- 2. Attach the stand components to the TV using the provided screws, ensuring they are securely fastened.
- 3. Carefully lift the TV and place it on a stable, level surface.

3.3 Connecting Peripherals

- Ethernet: For a wired internet connection.
- Bluetooth: For wireless connection to compatible headphones or speakers.
- Wi-Fi: For wireless internet access.

Al Voice ID recognizes each user's voice signature and offers personalized recommendations the moment you speak.




Image 4.2: Al Voice ID in action, providing personalized recommendations.




Image 4.5: The α 7 AI Processor 4K Gen 8, responsible for picture enhancements.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning Your TV

- **Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner (ensure it's TV-safe).
- Frame and Stand: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe dust.
- **Important:** Never spray cleaners directly onto the screen or frame. Always unplug the TV before cleaning.

5.2 Software Updates

Your LG TV supports the webOS Re:New Program, which provides software upgrades over five years. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive the latest updates for optimal performance and new features.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No power	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the TV and the wall outlet. Test the outlet with another device.
No picture, but sound is present	Ensure the correct input source is selected. Check cable connections to external devices.
No sound, but picture is present	Check the volume level and mute settings. Verify audio cable connections. If using external speakers, ensure they are powered on and correctly configured.
Remote control not working	Replace the batteries in the Magic Remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV. Re-pair the remote if necessary.

Problem	Possible Solution
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Restart your router and modem. Check Wi-Fi settings on the TV and ensure the password is correct. Move the TV closer to the router if possible.
