

MAINTENANCE

Cooling System

The laptop incorporates a built-in bottom fan for efficient heat dissipation. To ensure optimal performance and prevent overheating, regularly check that the cooling vents are clear of obstructions.

General Care

- Clean the laptop's surfaces with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals
- Protect the screen from scratches by using a screen protector or placing a soft cloth between the screen and keyboard when closed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Power Issues

- Laptop does not turn on: Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet. Try a different outlet if necessary.
- **Battery not charging:** Check the power adapter and charging port for any visible damage. Ensure the adapter is the original one provided with the laptop.

Display Issues

- **Screen is blank:** Try adjusting the screen brightness using the keyboard function keys. Connect an external monitor via HDMI to determine if the laptop is functioning but the internal display is not.
- Touchscreen unresponsive: Restart the device. If the issue persists, check for driver updates in Windows Device Manager.

Performance Issues

- Laptop is slow: Close any unnecessary applications running in the background. Check for and install any pending Windows updates.
- Overheating: Ensure the cooling vents are not blocked. Consider using the laptop on a hard, flat surface to allow for proper airflow.



