Seeday Shoe Storage Cabinet Model XG-MDF-0003-1 Instruction Manual

Comprehensive Guide for Assembly, Operation, and Maintenance

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Seeday Shoe Storage Cabinet with 3 Flip Drawers, Model XG-MDF-0003-1. This cabinet is designed to provide an organized and space-saving solution for your footwear in entryways, hallways, or living rooms. This manual contains important information regarding the assembly, safe operation, and maintenance of your new shoe cabinet. Please read it thoroughly before assembly and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Anti-Tipping Device:** This shoe cabinet includes an anti-tipping device. It is crucial to fix the cabinet to the wall using this device to prevent accidental tipping, especially in households with children or pets. Failure to do so may result in serious injury.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum weight limit of 60 pounds for the entire cabinet. Distribute weight evenly.
- **Assembly:** Assemble the unit on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Ensure all parts are correctly aligned and fasteners are tightened securely before use.
- **Placement:** Place the cabinet on a flat, stable surface. Avoid placing it in areas with high humidity or direct sunlight to prevent material damage.
- **Children:** Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children during assembly. Do not allow children to climb on or play with the cabinet.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, please verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- 1 x Seeday Shoe Storage Cabinet (disassembled components)
- 1 x Installation Manual (this document)
- Hardware Pack (screws, dowels, anti-tipping device, etc.)

Note: The hardware pack may contain screws of similar appearance but different lengths. Carefully identify each screw type using

the provided diagrams in the assembly instructions to ensure correct usage.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Seeday Shoe Storage Cabinet requires careful attention to detail. It is recommended to have two people for assembly to ensure stability and ease of handling. Please follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate installation guide included in your package.

Key Assembly Points:

- **Identify Parts:** Before starting, lay out all components and hardware. Match them with the diagrams in the installation guide.
- **Screw Identification:** Pay close attention to the length and type of screws. Some screws may look similar but are intended for specific steps. Using the wrong screw can damage the material.
- **Anti-Tipping Device:** Install the anti-tipping device as instructed. This is a critical safety step.
- **Metal Legs:** Ensure the metal legs are securely attached to provide a stable base and allow for easy cleaning underneath.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Opening and Closing Drawers

Each of the three drawers operates with a flip-down mechanism. Gently pull the gold handle to open the drawer. The drawer will tilt

forward, allowing access to the shoe compartments. To close, push the drawer upwards until it securely latches into place.

5.2 Adjusting and Removing Shelves

Each flip drawer contains a removable divider, creating two tiers for shoe storage. This divider can be adjusted to three different positions or removed entirely to accommodate various shoe sizes and styles, such as high heels or boots.

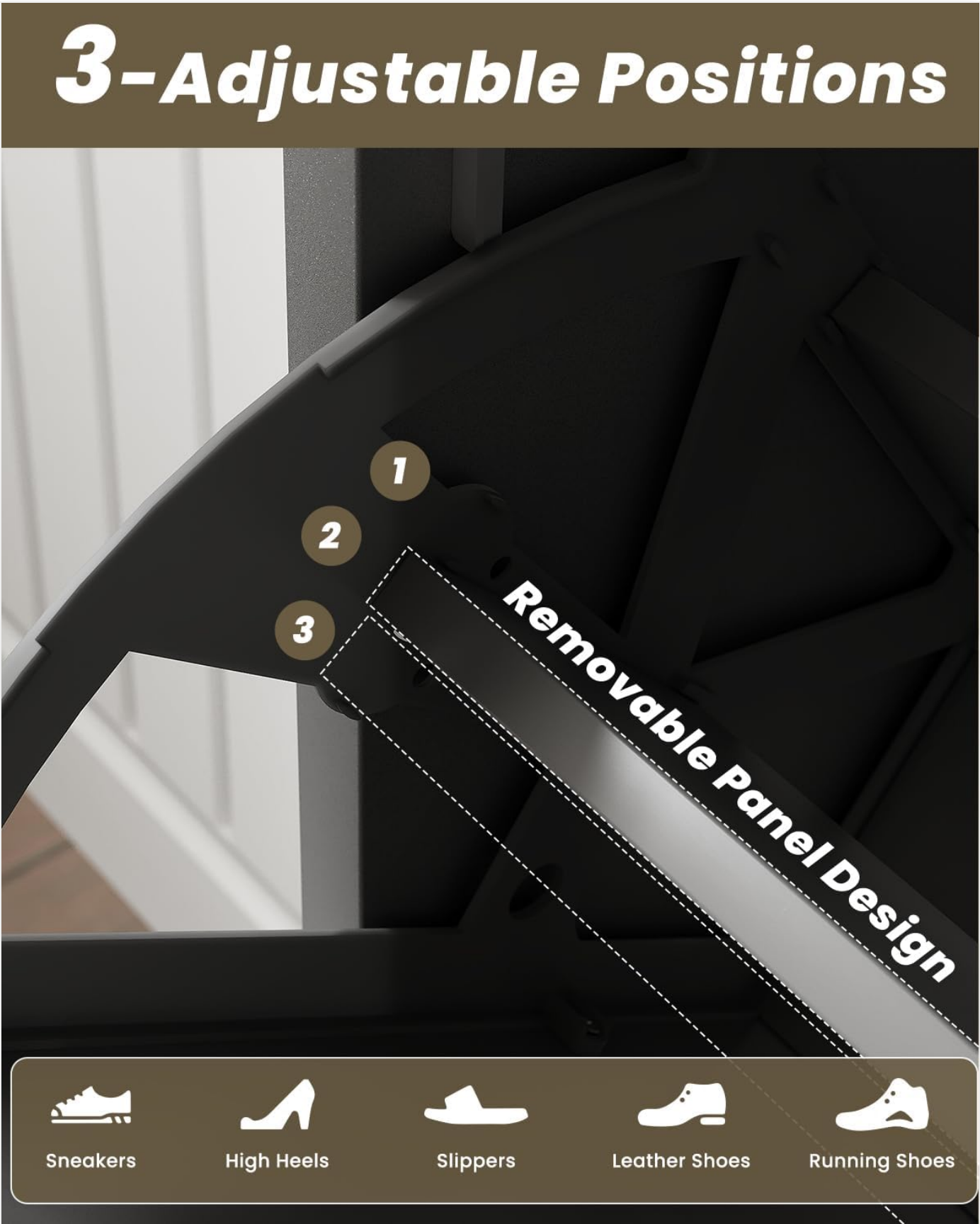


Figure 5.1: The removable panel design within each drawer allows for flexible storage configurations to fit different shoe types.

- **To Adjust:** Gently lift the divider and reposition it into one of the available slots. Ensure it is securely seated.
- **To Remove:** Lift the divider completely out of its slots. This creates a single, larger compartment.

5.3 Shoe Capacity

The cabinet features 3 flip drawers, each with 2 tiers (when the divider is in place). The total capacity depends on shoe size and style. For optimal closure, ensure shoes do not protrude excessively when placed in the upper tier, especially for larger shoe sizes. If shoes are too large for the upper tier, consider removing the divider or placing them in the lower tier.

5.4 Top Surface and Bottom Space

The stable top surface can be used for decorative items, keys, or other small essentials. The elevated design with metal legs provides ample space underneath, suitable for storing slippers or allowing easy access for cleaning devices like robot vacuums.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the cabinet surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the finish.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the cabinet to prevent buildup.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining or damage to the engineered wood.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawers do not close properly.	Shoes are too large or positioned incorrectly. Drawer mechanism is obstructed. Assembly error.	Adjust or remove the internal divider. Ensure shoes are fully inside the compartment. For larger shoe sizes (e.g., women's size 8.5 and above), the upper tier may not accommodate shoes with significant height or length; consider using only the lower tier or removing the divider. Check for any foreign objects obstructing the drawer's path. Review assembly instructions to ensure all parts are correctly installed and tightened.
Cabinet feels unstable or wobbly.	Not placed on a level surface. Fasteners are loose. Anti-tipping device not installed.	Move the cabinet to a level surface or use shims to stabilize. Retighten all assembly screws. Install the anti-tipping device securely to a wall stud.
Missing or damaged parts upon arrival.	Shipping damage or packaging error.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Seeday customer support immediately for replacement parts.
