1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Electactic Countertop Ice Maker. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new ice maker. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent injury to yourself and others or damage to the appliance, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Always plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep the ice maker away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Maintain at least 6 inches of clearance from walls or other objects.
- Do not place hands or objects into the ice maker while it is operating.
- Unplug the ice maker before cleaning, maintenance, or when not in use for extended periods.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors.
- Supervise children to ensure they do not play with the appliance.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Electactic Countertop Ice Maker is designed for convenience and efficiency, offering several key features:

- **High-Efficiency Production:** Produces 8 bullet-shaped ice cubes in 6-13 minutes, with a daily capacity of up to 26.5 lbs.
- **Smart Self-Cleaning:** Features an automatic self-cleaning function to prevent mineral buildup and ensure hygienic ice production.
- **Dual Ice Size Control:** Allows selection between two ice cube sizes (Small/Large) to suit various beverage needs.
- **Ultra-Portable & Space-Saving:** Compact design (12" depth) with a built-in handle and 2.4L water tank, making it ideal for various settings.
- **Intuitive Touch Display:** User-friendly LED panel provides real-time status alerts for water shortage and full ice basket.




Figure 3.1: The ice maker produces two selectable ice cube sizes for versatility.

4. PARTS AND COMPONENTS

Your Electactic Countertop Ice Maker package includes the following items:

- Countertop Ice Maker Unit
- Ice Basket
- Ice Scoop
- Instruction Manual (this document)

5. SETUP AND FIRST USE

5.1 Unpacking and Placement

1. Carefully remove all packaging materials and inspect the ice maker for any damage.
2. Place the ice maker on a flat, stable, and level surface, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is at least 6 inches of space around the unit for proper ventilation.
3. Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2 hours before plugging it in, especially if it was transported horizontally. This allows the refrigerant to settle.

5.2 Initial Cleaning

1. Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Remove the ice basket and wash it with warm water and a

mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly.

2. Wipe the interior water reservoir with a soft cloth dampened with warm water and a small amount of vinegar or mild detergent. Rinse by wiping with a clean, damp cloth.
3. Ensure all parts are dry before proceeding.

5.3 First Ice Making Cycle

1. Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with clean, potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.
3. Close the lid.
4. Press the 'ON/OFF' button to start the ice making process. The unit will default to a medium ice size.
5. Discard the first 2-3 cycles of ice produced to ensure any manufacturing residues are flushed out.

6. OPERATION

6.1 Making Ice

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled with water.
2. Press the 'ON/OFF' button to power on the unit.
3. To select ice cube size, press the 'SELECT' button. The indicator light for 'S' (Small) or 'L' (Large) will illuminate.
4. The ice maker will begin producing ice. The first batch typically takes 6-13 minutes.
5. When the ice basket is full, the 'ICE FULL' indicator will light up, and the unit will pause operation. Remove ice from the basket to resume production.
6. If the water level is low, the 'ADD WATER' indicator will light up, and the unit will pause. Add water to the reservoir to resume.

6.2 Digital Touch Control Panel

The control panel features intuitive buttons and indicator lights:

- **ON/OFF Button:** Powers the unit on or off.
- **SELECT Button:** Toggles between Small (S) and Large (L) ice cube sizes.
- **CLEAN Button:** Initiates the self-cleaning cycle.
- **ADD WATER Indicator:** Illuminates when the water reservoir needs refilling.
- **ICE FULL Indicator:** Illuminates when the ice basket is full.

7. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ice maker.

7.1 Self-Cleaning Function

The self-cleaning function helps remove mineral buildup and maintain hygiene. It is recommended to run this cycle once a week or as needed.

1. Ensure the ice basket is empty.
2. Fill the water reservoir with clean water up to the MAX line. You may add a small amount of white vinegar (approx. 1:10 vinegar to water ratio) for enhanced cleaning.
3. Press and hold the 'CLEAN' button for 3-5 seconds to activate the self-cleaning cycle. The unit will circulate water internally.
4. The cleaning cycle typically lasts for a few minutes. Once complete, the unit will stop.
5. Unplug the unit and drain the water by removing the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit.
6. Rinse the interior thoroughly with clean water and drain again.

7.2 Regular Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth.

- Clean the ice scoop and ice basket regularly with warm, soapy water.
- For long-term storage, drain all water from the reservoir and dry the interior thoroughly. Store the unit in a cool, dry place.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not turning on.	No power; loose plug.	Ensure unit is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check circuit breaker.
'ADD WATER' indicator is on.	Water reservoir is empty or low.	Fill the water reservoir with clean water up to the MAX line.
'ICE FULL' indicator is on.	Ice basket is full.	Remove ice from the basket. Ensure ice is not blocking the sensor.
No ice production or very little ice.	Insufficient water; ambient temperature too high; air vent blocked.	Add water. Ensure room temperature is within operating range (50-90°F). Clear any obstructions from air vents.
Ice cubes are too small or clumpy.	Water temperature too high; mineral buildup.	Use colder water. Run the self-cleaning cycle to remove mineral deposits.
Unusual noise during operation.	Unit not level; internal component issue.	Ensure the unit is on a level surface. If noise persists, contact customer support.
