


Image 1: Front cover of the user guide for Microsoft Surface Pro (2025).

1. SETUP AND PERSONALIZATION

2.2 Using Surface Accessories

Surface Pen

- **Pairing:** Ensure your Surface Pen is charged. Go to Settings > Bluetooth & devices > Add deviceand select "Bluetooth." Hold the top button of the pen until the LED flashes to pair.
- Writing and Drawing: Use the pen for natural writing and drawing in compatible applications like Microsoft

OneNote or Whiteboard.

• **Customizing Buttons:** Customize the top button's actions (e.g., launch OneNote, take a screenshot) in *Settings* > *Bluetooth & devices* > *Pen & Windows Ink.*

Detachable Keyboard (Type Cover)

- Attaching: Align the magnetic connector of the keyboard with the bottom edge of your Surface Pro until it clicks into place.
- Using the Trackpad: The integrated trackpad supports multi-touch gestures for navigation.
- Backlighting: Adjust keyboard backlighting using the dedicated function keys (if available).

3. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Surface Pro.

3.1 Cleaning Your Device

- Screen: Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or an approved screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Casing: Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth.
- Ports: Gently remove dust from ports using compressed air, holding the can upright.

3.2 Software Updates

- Windows Updates: Regularly check for and install Windows updates via Settings > Windows Update to ensure security and performance improvements.
- **Driver Updates:** Surface drivers are typically updated through Windows Update. For specific accessory drivers, check the Microsoft support website.

3.3 Battery Care

- · Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not let the battery fully discharge frequently.
- For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50%.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section addresses common problems you might encounter with your Surface Pro and provides solutions.

4.1 Device Not Responding

- Force Restart: Press and hold the power button for about 30 seconds until the device turns off and then restarts.
- Check Power: Ensure the device is charged or connected to a power source.

4.2 Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues

- Toggle Wi-Fi: Turn Wi-Fi off and on again from the Action Center.
- Restart Router: Power cycle your Wi-Fi router.
- Update Drivers: Ensure your network adapter drivers are up to date via Device Manager.

4.3 Surface Pen Not Working

- Check Battery: Replace the battery in the Surface Pen if it's low.
- Re-pair Pen: Go to Settings > Bluetooth & devices and remove then re-pair the Surface Pen.
- Update Firmware: Check for Surface Pen firmware updates through Windows Update.
