1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your new FTYHFEFH Carburetor, designed as a direct replacement for the Craftsman CMXGWFN061255 3100 PSI 2.4 GPM Pressure Washer. This carburetor is manufactured to original equipment manufacturer (OEM) standards to ensure optimal performance and compatibility.

Please read this manual thoroughly before attempting any installation or maintenance procedures to ensure safe and correct usage.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND PACKAGE CONTENTS

The FTYHFEFH Carburetor kit includes all necessary components for a direct replacement. The package is designed to provide exactly what is pictured, ensuring you have the correct parts for your pressure washer.

2.1 Key Features:

- Direct replacement for Craftsman CMXGWFN061255 3100 PSI 2.4 GPM Pressure Washer.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This carburetor is designed for simple, direct replacement. While no special tools are required, basic mechanical knowledge and safety precautions are recommended.

3.1 Safety Precautions:

- Ensure the pressure washer engine is cool and turned off.
- Disconnect the spark plug wire to prevent accidental starting.
- Work in a well-ventilated area.
- Have a fire extinguisher nearby when working with fuel.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), such as gloves and eye protection.

3.2 Installation Steps:

1. **Drain Fuel:** Before beginning, ensure the fuel tank is empty or the fuel line is clamped to prevent spills.
2. **Remove Air Filter Assembly:** Carefully detach the air filter housing and any associated components to gain access to the existing carburetor.
3. **Disconnect Fuel Line and Linkages:** Disconnect the fuel line from the old carburetor. Note the position and connection of all throttle and choke linkages before detaching them.
4. **Remove Old Carburetor:** Unbolt the old carburetor from the engine. Be mindful of any gaskets between the carburetor and the engine/intake manifold.
5. **Clean Mounting Surface:** Ensure the mounting surface on the engine is clean and free of old gasket material.

6. **Install New Gaskets:** Place the new gaskets in their correct positions. Refer to Figure 2.1 for gasket types.
7. **Mount New Carburetor:** Carefully position the new carburetor and secure it with the original bolts. Do not overtighten.
8. **Connect Fuel Line and Linkages:** Reconnect the fuel line, ensuring it is secure and free of kinks. Attach the throttle and choke linkages to the new carburetor in the same manner as they were on the old unit. Replace the fuel filter if necessary, using the new one provided.
9. **Reassemble Air Filter Assembly:** Reattach the air filter housing and any other components removed earlier.
10. **Refill Fuel and Test:** Refill the fuel tank with fresh, appropriate fuel. Reconnect the spark plug wire. Start the pressure washer and check for proper operation and any fuel leaks.

4. OPERATING PRINCIPLES (CARBURETOR)

The carburetor's primary function is to mix air and fuel in the correct ratio for combustion within the engine. It atomizes fuel and mixes it with air, then regulates the flow of this mixture into the engine's combustion chamber. The choke and throttle mechanisms control the air-fuel mixture and engine speed, respectively.

Once installed, the new carburetor should allow your pressure washer engine to start smoothly and run efficiently, maintaining consistent power output as designed by the OEM specifications.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance of your carburetor and associated fuel system components is crucial for the longevity and optimal performance of your pressure washer. While the carburetor itself is a sealed unit, regular checks of related parts are recommended.

5.1 General Maintenance Tips:

- **Fuel Quality:** Always use fresh, clean fuel. Stale or contaminated fuel is a common cause of carburetor issues. Consider using a fuel stabilizer if the pressure washer will be stored for extended periods.
- **Fuel Filter:** Regularly inspect and replace the fuel filter (a new one is included with this kit) to prevent debris from reaching the carburetor.
- **Air Filter:** Ensure the air filter is clean and properly installed. A dirty air filter can restrict airflow and affect carburetor performance.
- **Storage:** Before long-term storage, it is advisable to drain the fuel system or run the engine until it runs out of fuel to prevent gumming and varnish buildup in the carburetor.
- **Inspections:** Periodically check fuel lines for cracks or leaks and ensure all connections are secure.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing the new carburetor, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine won't start or starts hard.	No fuel, stale fuel, clogged fuel filter, incorrect choke position, spark plug issue.	Check fuel level and freshness. Replace fuel filter. Ensure choke is set correctly for starting. Check spark plug.
Engine runs rough or stalls.	Dirty air filter, fuel quality issues, vacuum leak (improperly seated gaskets).	Clean/replace air filter. Use fresh fuel. Recheck carburetor mounting and gasket seating.
Fuel leaks from carburetor.	Improperly seated gaskets, loose fuel line connection, float needle issue (less likely with new unit).	Ensure all connections are tight. Verify gaskets are correctly installed and not pinched.
Loss of power.	Dirty air filter, fuel restriction, engine issues unrelated to carburetor.	Check air filter and fuel flow. Consult pressure washer's main manual for engine-specific troubleshooting.

If problems persist after following these steps, it is recommended to consult a qualified service technician or refer to the original pressure washer's service manual.

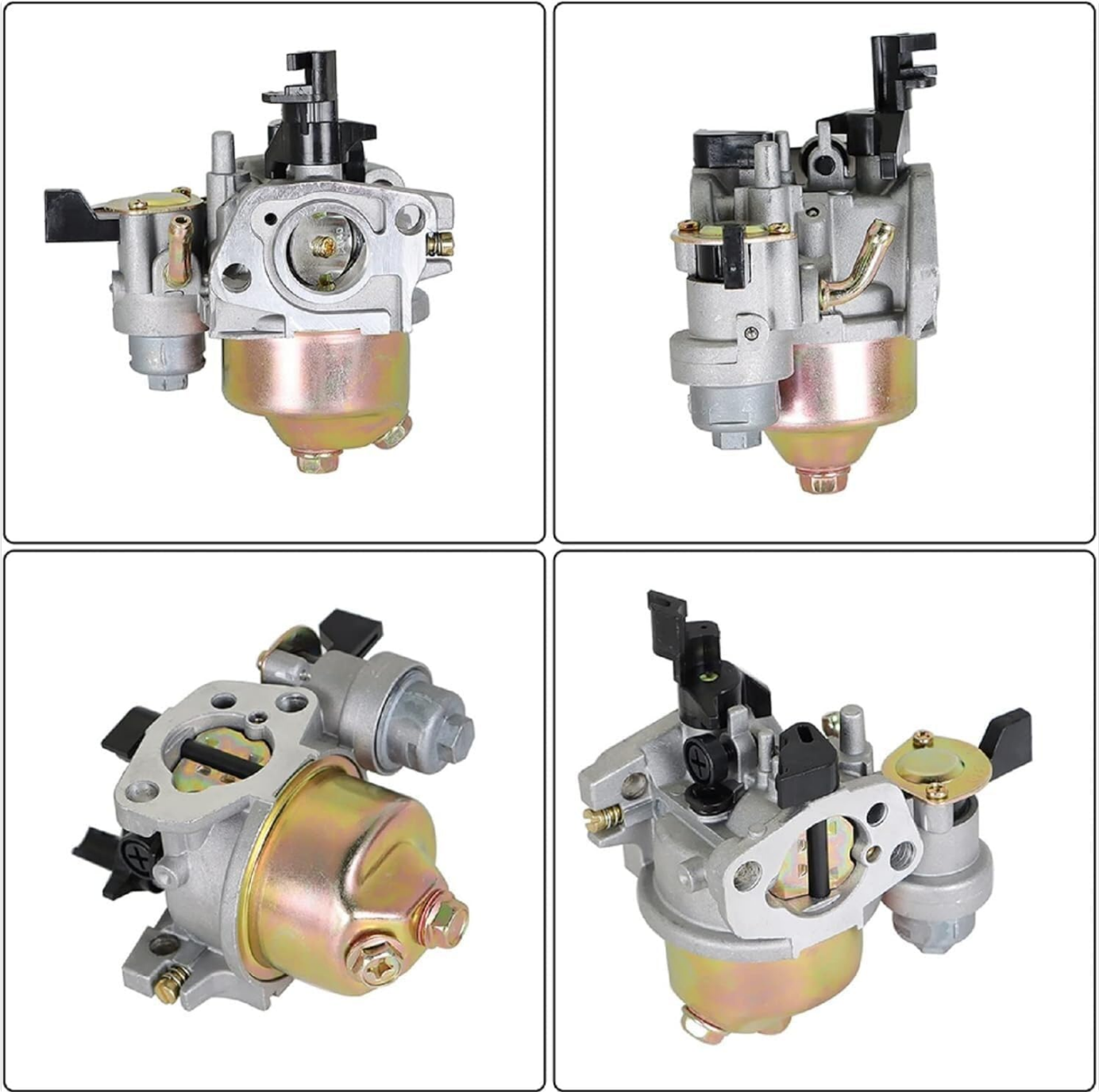


Figure 7.1: Carburetor Dimensions. This image provides key measurements of the carburetor, useful for verifying compatibility or understanding its physical size.
