INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Sakugi Clothes Rack. Designed for efficient organization, this rack features a hanging bar for garments, two tiers for shoes or folded items, and anti-slip stoppers for stability. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, please verify that all parts listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- **A:** Support Fabric (x2)
- **B:** Horizontal Tube ① (x4)
- **C:** Horizontal Tube ② (x4)
- **D:** Short Vertical Tube (x4)
- **E:** Bottom Tube (x4)
- **F:** Plastic Holder (x4)
- **G:** Leg Cover (x4)
- **H:** L-Shaped Tube ① (x1)
- **I:** L-Shaped Tube ② (x1)
- **J:** Y-Shaped Tube (x2)
- **K:** Long Vertical Tube (x2)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully for tool-free assembly. Refer to the provided video for visual guidance.

Step 1: Prepare Shelf Units

1. Connect one **B** (Horizontal Tube ①) and one **C** (Horizontal Tube ②) to form a long tube. Repeat this process 4 times to create four long tubes.
2. Insert two of these long tubes through the two side sleeves of one **A** (Support Fabric). Repeat this for the second **A**. You will now have two fabric shelf units.

Step 2: Attach Plastic Holders to Shelf Units

1. Connect two **F** (Plastic Holders) to the ends of one assembled fabric shelf unit. Ensure the smooth side of the **A** (Support Fabric) is facing upwards. Repeat this for the second fabric shelf unit.

Step 3: Assemble the Base Structure

1. Slot one end of each **E** (Bottom Tube) into a **G** (Leg Cover). Repeat for all four **E** tubes.
2. Slot the other end of each **E** (Bottom Tube) into the bottom of the **F** (Plastic Holders) on one of the shelf units.
3. Connect the two single-layer shelf units using the four **D** (Short Vertical Tubes). Insert the **D** tubes into the top of the lower shelf unit's **F** holders and the bottom of the upper shelf unit's **F** holders.

Step 4: Install Vertical Support Tubes

1. Attach the two **J** (Y-Shaped Tubes) to the top of the assembled rack, ensuring the snaps face inwards.
2. Attach the two **K** (Long Vertical Tubes) on top of the **J** tubes.

Step 5: Complete the Hanging Rail

1. Snap **H** (L-Shaped Tube ①) and **I** (L-Shaped Tube ②) together to form the top hanging rail. Ensure the two small dots on the tubes face upwards for proper alignment and anti-slip function.
2. Fix the assembled hanging rail onto the top of the **K** (Long Vertical Tubes).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sakugi Clothes Rack is designed for versatile storage in various environments.

- **Garment Hanging:** Use the top rail to hang clothes. The rail supports up to 70 lbs (approximately 30 garments). The integrated anti-slip stoppers prevent hangers from sliding off the ends.
- **Shoe and Item Storage:** The two fabric tiers are suitable for organizing shoes (each tier holds 10 lbs, accommodating 3-4 pairs), folded clothing, towels, scarves, or storage boxes.
- **Accessory Hooks:** The curved ends of the top rail can be used to hang bags, hats, or belts, keeping them easily accessible.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Sakugi Clothes Rack, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down metal parts with a soft, damp cloth. For the fabric shelves, use a mild soap solution and a soft cloth, then allow to air dry completely. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect all connections to ensure they remain secure. Re-snap any loose tubes to maintain stability.
- **Load Management:** Do not exceed the stated weight capacities (70 lbs for the hanging rod, 10 lbs per shoe tier) to prevent damage or collapse.

- **Placement:** Position the rack on a flat, stable surface. The floor-friendly feet are designed to protect floors, but avoid dragging the rack when heavily loaded.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your clothes rack, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rack is wobbly or unstable.	Connections are not fully secured; uneven surface; overloaded.	Ensure all tubes are fully snapped into place. Move the rack to a flat, level surface. Reduce the load if exceeding weight limits.
Hangers slide off the rail.	Anti-slip stoppers not properly installed or missing.	Verify that the L-shaped tubes (H and I) are correctly snapped together with the dots facing up, ensuring the stoppers are functional.
Parts do not fit together.	Incorrect part combination; manufacturing defect.	Double-check the part labels (A, B, C, etc.) against the assembly steps. If parts are genuinely incompatible, contact customer support.
Fabric shelves sag.	Overloaded shelves.	Reduce the weight on the shelves. Ensure weight does not exceed 10 lbs per tier.
