| Battery drains quickly | High screen brightness, many background processes, outdated drivers | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reduce screen brightness. • Adjust power settings to a balanced or power-saver mode. • Close power-intensive applications. • Ensure all drivers are updated. |
