INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your TTfone TT890 4G Senior Phone. This device is designed for ease of use, featuring large buttons, a clear display, and essential functions for reliable communication. It includes 4G connectivity for faster and more stable network performance, an emergency SOS button for peace of mind, and convenient USB-C charging. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper operation and to get the most out of your new phone.

1. SETUP

1.1 Installing the SIM Card and Battery

1. **Remove the Back Cover:** Gently pry open the back cover of the phone using the notch provided.
2. **Insert SIM Card:** Locate the SIM card slot. The TT890 uses a **Nano SIM** card. Insert the SIM card with the gold contacts facing down and the cut corner aligned as shown in the diagram (if applicable).
3. **Insert Battery:** Place the battery into the battery compartment, ensuring the gold contacts on the battery align with the contacts in the phone.
4. **Replace Back Cover:** Carefully align and press the back cover until it clicks securely into place.

1.2 Charging the Phone

The TT890 uses a modern USB-C port for charging.

1. **Connect Charger:** Insert the USB-C end of the charging cable into the phone's charging port.
2. **Connect to Power:** Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not always included) or a computer's USB port.

3. **Charging Indicator:** The phone's screen will display a charging indicator. A full charge typically takes approximately 4 hours.

1.3 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the **Green Call button** until the screen lights up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the **Red End Call button** until the power-off options appear, then confirm.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Making and Receiving Calls

- **To Make a Call:** Dial the number using the large keypad buttons, then press the **Green Call button**.
- **To Answer a Call:** When the phone rings, press the **Green Call button**.
- **To End a Call:** Press the **Red End Call button**.

2.2 Sending and Receiving Messages (SMS)

- **Access Messages:** Navigate to the 'Messages' menu using the navigation buttons and the 'Menu' option on the screen.
- **Compose New Message:** Select 'Write Message' or 'New SMS'. Enter your message using the keypad.
- **Send Message:** Enter the recipient's number or select from contacts, then choose 'Send'.

2.3 Emergency SOS Button

The dedicated SOS button on the back of the phone allows for quick contact in emergencies.

- **Setup SOS Contacts:** In the phone's settings, you can configure up to 5 emergency contacts. These contacts will be called

sequentially when the SOS button is activated.

- **Activate SOS:** Press and hold the **SOS button** for a few seconds. The phone will automatically call your pre-set emergency contacts and send an emergency SMS message.

2.4 Camera Function

The TT890 includes a basic camera for quick photos.

- **Access Camera:** Navigate to the 'Camera' application from the main menu.
- **Take Photo:** Point the camera at your subject and press the central navigation button to capture an image.

2.5 Bluetooth Connectivity

Connect your TT890 to other Bluetooth-enabled devices like headsets or car kits.

- **Enable Bluetooth:** Go to 'Settings' > 'Bluetooth' and turn it 'On'.
- **Pair Device:** Select 'Search for devices' and choose your desired device from the list. Enter the pairing code if prompted.

2.6 Torch Function

The phone features a built-in torch for convenience.

- **Activate Torch:** The torch can often be activated by a dedicated side switch or by pressing and holding a specific key (refer to your phone's quick guide for exact method).

2.7 Phonebook

Store and manage your contacts easily.

- **Add Contact:** Go to 'Phonebook' > 'Add New Contact'. Enter the name and phone number.
- **Search Contact:** In the 'Phonebook', use the navigation buttons to scroll through contacts or use the search function.

2.8 Keypad Lock

To prevent accidental key presses, lock the keypad.

- **Lock:** Typically, press the left soft key (Menu) then the "*" key.
- **Unlock:** Repeat the same sequence.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning the Device

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the phone's surface.
- Avoid using liquid cleaners, aerosols, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the device.
- Keep the charging port free from dust and debris.

3.2 Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures, which can reduce battery life.
- Do not leave the phone charging for excessively long periods after it is fully charged.
- If the phone will not be used for an extended period, charge it to about 50% before storing.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Phone does not power on	Ensure the battery is correctly installed and charged. Connect the charger and try again.
Cannot make or receive calls	Check if the SIM card is properly inserted and activated. Ensure you have network signal. Contact your network provider if issues persist.
Battery not charging	Verify the USB-C cable and charger are working correctly. Try a different power source. Ensure the charging port is clean.

Problem	Possible Solution
SOS button not working	Ensure emergency contacts are correctly set up in the phone's settings. Test the function in a non-emergency situation.
Poor sound quality during calls	Check the volume settings. Ensure the speaker and microphone are not obstructed. Move to an area with better network coverage.
